Dear Brother Priests,

We are quickly approaching the 10th National Eucharistic Revival in Indianapolis, Indiana this July 17-21, 2024. The Congress will be a momentous occasion for the life of the Church in the United States as tens of thousands of the faithful from around the country gather to encounter Our Lord present in the Most Blessed Sacrament. It is the hope that the attendees will return to their home dioceses and parishes to be “Eucharistic Missionaries” in the midst of their parish communities.

I send this note as a follow-up to my letter of July 21, 2023, encouraging you to consider sending a representation of parishioners to participate in the Congress. Whether it is one person to represent your parish or a group of parishioners, it would be great to have every one of our parishes represented at the Congress next year.
