Stewardship Reflection

"After John had been arrested, Jesus came to Galilee proclaiming the gospel of God..."
Mark 1:14

Have you ever thought about how difficult it must have been for Jesus to go to Galilee, knowing that John had just been arrested for teaching the same message that He was proclaiming. It took great love and trust for Jesus to do what the Father had sent Him here on earth to do. In the same way, living a stewardship lifestyle takes great love and trust from us. We must be willing to surrender completely to God, trusting that He will always give us all that we need to fulfill His plan for us.

JESUS IN THE DESERT

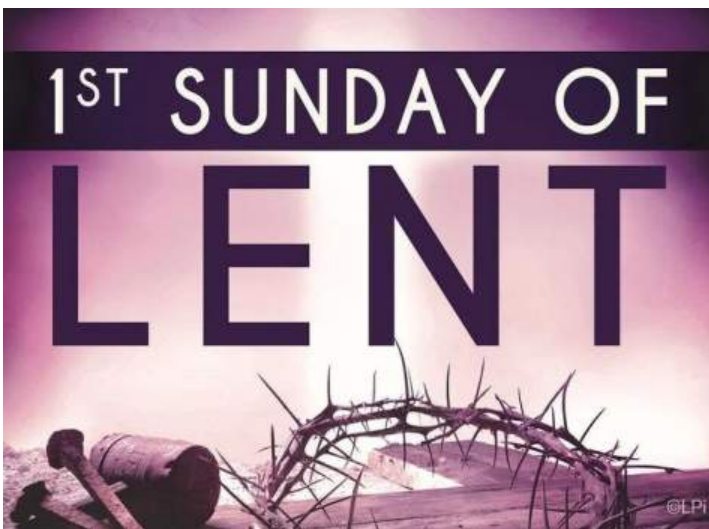


"The Spirit drove Jesus into the desert..." During Lent, the Holy Spirit leads us into the desert as well. To be sure, we cannot imitate Christ's superhuman fast. Nor can we directly confront Satan in the way that Jesus did. Your fasts and penances are not performed with Jesus' innocence. Nonetheless, we are Baptized into Christ and his mission to redeem the world. We are privileged to be called. Our meagre prayers, penances and fasts are nothing but our availability to Christ.

Jesus was in the desert "among wild beasts." We are among the "wild beasts" of pride, envy, wrath, greed, lust, gluttony, and sloth. These tendencies make us sluggish in joining Christ's mission. But Christ overcomes our gluttony, lust, and sloth by refusing Satan's offer to "turn these stones into bread." He overcomes our pride, greed, envy, and anger in rejecting Satan's offer for all the world's kingdoms and wealth. And he overcomes Satan himself in refusing to test God by throwing himself off the Temple's parapet. "Satan, begone!"

But unlike Christ, we have our weaknesses to contend with. But humbly persevere in prayer and hold your peace. Trust God completely. Resisting weakness requires Faith, not strength. The trial of human weakness falling upon body and soul is a penance in itself. All saints and holy souls pass through such trials. This experience is a fruitful stage of your spiritual growth, even if God seems absent and your weaknesses seem to prevail. Accept this in calm and humility. Satan will lose his match with you if you acknowledge your weakness and remember that you are flesh and blood, not an angel. It has been said, you are going to God on foot and not on angel's wings.

This is our wilderness. It is our desert of solitude with God. It is our fruitful and life-giving desert if we are willing to simply witness our weaknesses in prayer rather than chase after them, like phantoms. Let the Holy Spirit lead you into the desert of self-denial for forty days. My dear Christian, let the Spirit prepare you to see Jesus face-to-face and to see God in your neighbor.

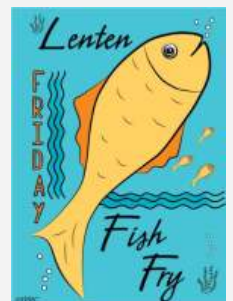

Jesús en el desierto

"El Espíritu llevó a Jesús al desierto..." Durante la Cuaresma, el Espíritu Santo también nos lleva al desierto. Ciertamente, no podemos imitar el ayuno sobrehumano que hizo Cristo en el desierto. Tampoco podemos confrontar directamente a Satanás de la manera en que lo hizo Jesús. Nuestros ayunos y penitencias no se realizan con la pura inocencia de Jesús. Sin embargo, somos bautizados en Cristo y en su misión de redimir al mundo. Tenemos el privilegio de ser llamados a su Reino. Nuestras limitadas oraciones, penitencias y ayunos no son otra cosa que nuestra disponibilidad a Cristo.

Jesús estuvo en el desierto "entre bestias salvajes". Nosotros estamos entre las "bestias salvajes" del orgullo, la envidia, la codicia, la ira, la lujuria, la gula y la pereza. Estas tendencias nos hacen lentos para unirnos a la misión de Cristo. Pero Cristo vence nuestra gula, lujuria y pereza al rechazar la oferta de Satanás de "convertir estas piedras en pan". Él vence nuestro orgullo, codicia, envidia e ira al rechazar la oferta de Satanás de tener los reinos y riquezas del mundo. Y vence al mismo Satanás al negarse a poner a prueba el poder de Dios arrojándose desde el pretil del Templo. "¡Satanás, vete!"

Pero a diferencia de Cristo, nosotros tenemos nuestras debilidades con las que lidiar. No obstante, persevera humildemente en la oración y mantén la calma. Confía completamente en Dios. Resistir la debilidad requiere fe, no fuerza. Afrontar las aflicciones de la debilidad humana que pesan sobre el cuerpo y el alma es una penitencia en sí misma. Todos los santos y almas benditas han pasado por tales pruebas. Esta experiencia es una etapa fructífera de tu crecimiento espiritual, incluso si Dios parece estar ausente y tus debilidades parecen prevalecer. Acéptalo con calma y humildad. Satanás perderá la batalla contigo si reconoces tus debilidades y recuerdas que eres de carne y hueso, no un ángel. Se ha dicho antes, vas a Dios a pie y no en las alas de ángel.

Este es nuestro desierto. Es nuestro desierto en soledad con Dios. Es nuestro desierto fructuoso y vivificante si estamos dispuestos a aceptar simplemente nuestras debilidades en humilde oración en lugar de perseguirlas, como fantasmas. Deja que el Espíritu Santo te guíe al desierto de sacrificio y caridad durante cuarenta días. Mi querido cristiano, deja que el Espíritu te prepare para ver a Jesús cara a cara y ver a Dios en tu prójimo.

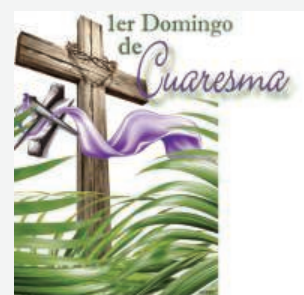

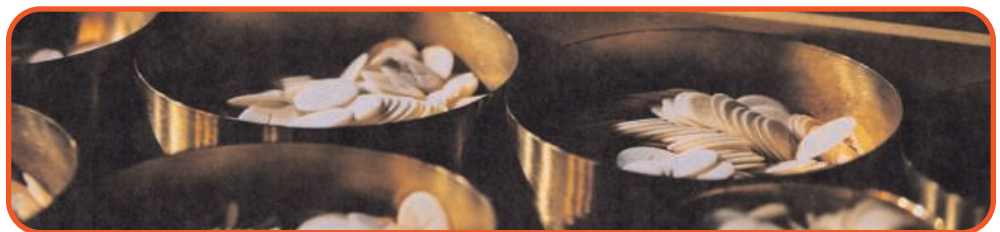
