

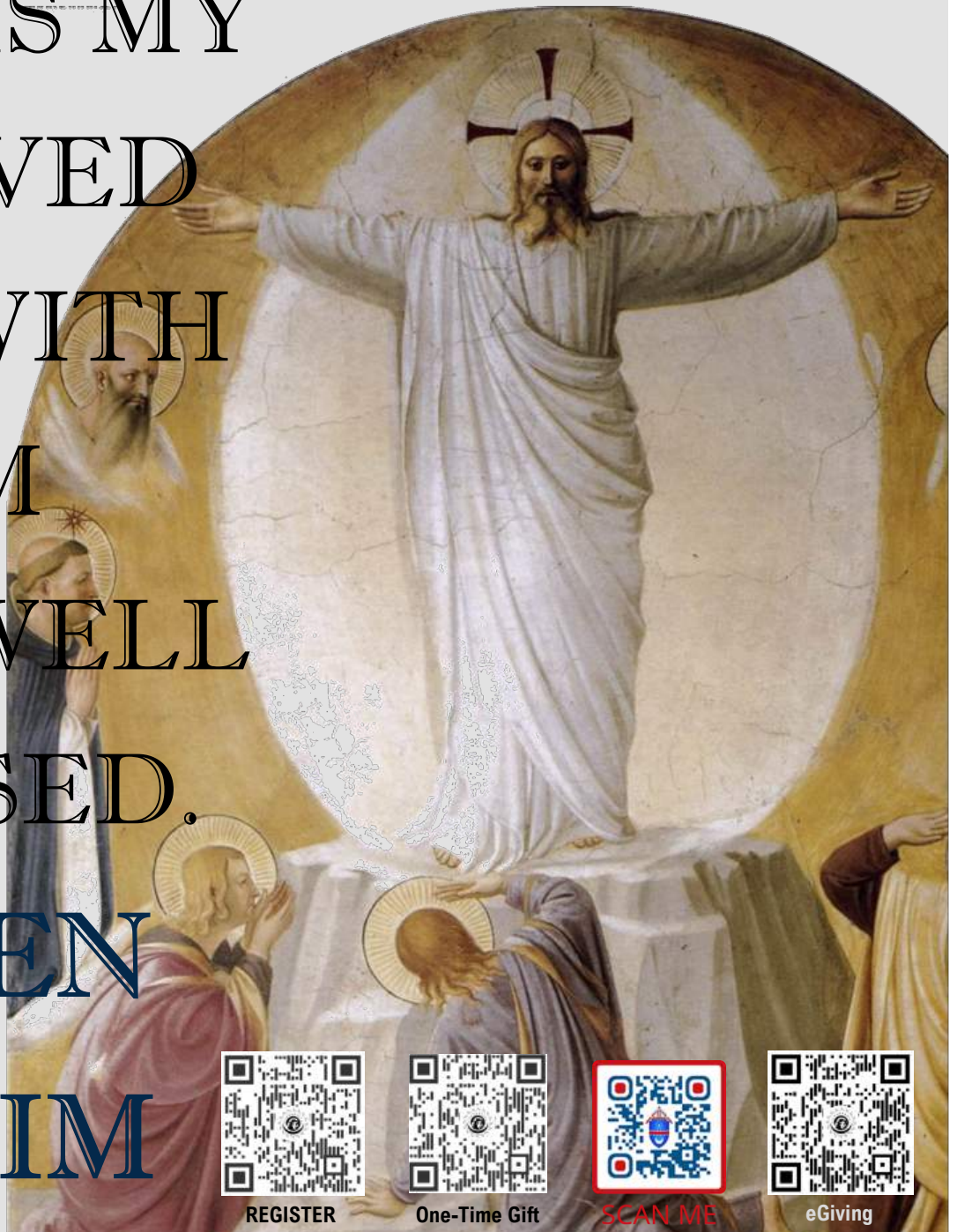

Stewardship Reflection

**"Here I am!" he answered.
Genesis 22:11**

It is easy to say, "Here I am, Lord," when we are kneeling in church. But how easy is it to say "Here I am, Lord," when a neighbor needs our help, or when we are invited to join a parish ministry, or when we are asked to provide financial support? Often times we are called when it's not convenient for us. Discipleship is not easy, most of the time it will make us uncomfortable and vulnerable.

THE TRANSFIGURATION

We know little about the 7th century monk Anastasius of Sinai. "Anastasius" is Greek for "Resurrection". Two Byzantine Emperors went by that name, as did four Popes, some Greek footballers, and a weightlifter. None of them had the surname "of Sinai", the mountain where Moses received God's Law.

Anastasius of Sinai says Jesus' Transfiguration foretold his Resurrection. Why? To save the faith of Peter, James, and John, who would be in danger of losing it on Good Friday. Let's hear from Anastasius.

From a Sermon on the Transfiguration of the Lord by Anastasius of Sinai

Upon Mount Tabor, Jesus revealed to his disciples a heavenly mystery. While living among them he had spoken of the kingdom and of his second coming in glory, but to banish from their hearts any possible doubt concerning the kingdom and to confirm their faith in what lay in the future by its prefiguration in the present, he gave them on Mount Tabor a wonderful vision of his glory, a foreshadowing of the kingdom of heaven. It was as if he said to them: "As time goes by you may be in danger of losing your faith. To save you from this I tell you now that some standing here listening to me will not taste death until they have seen the Son of Man coming in the glory of his Father." Moreover, in order to assure us that Christ could command such power when he wished, the evangelist continues: Six days later, Jesus took with him Peter, James and John, and led them up a high mountain where they were alone. There, before their eyes, he was transfigured. His face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as light. Then the disciples saw Moses and Elijah appear, and they were talking to Jesus...

Let us run with confidence and joy to enter the cloud like Moses and Elijah, or like James and John. Let us be caught up like Peter to behold the divine vision and to be transfigured by that glorious transfiguration. Let us retire from the world, stand aloof from the earth, rise above the body, detach ourselves from creatures and turn to the creator, to whom Peter in ecstasy exclaimed: "Lord, it is good for us to be here..."

La Transfiguración

Sabemos poco sobre el monje del siglo VII Anastasio del Sinaí. "Anastasio" significa "resurrección" en griego. Dos emperadores bizantinos se hicieron llamar así, al igual que cuatro papas, algunos futbolistas griegos y un levantador de pesas. Ninguno de ellos tenía el apellido "del Sinaí", la montaña donde Moisés recibió la Ley de Dios.

Anastasio del Sinaí dice que la Transfiguración de Jesús anunció su resurrección. ¿Por qué? Para salvar la fe de Pedro, Santiago y Juan, que estarían en peligro de perderla el Viernes Santo. Escuchemos las palabras de Anastasio.

De un sermón sobre la Transfiguración del Señor por Anastasio del Sinaí

En el Monte Tabor, Jesús reveló a sus discípulos un misterio celestial. Mientras vivía entre ellos, les había hablado del reino y de su segunda venida en gloria, pero para desterrar de sus corazones cualquier posible duda sobre el reino y confirmar su fe en lo que el futuro les aguardaba con la prefiguración en el presente, les dio, en el monte Tabor, una visión maravillosa de su gloria, una prefiguración del reino de los cielos. Era como si les dijera: "A medida que pasa el tiempo, pueden estar en peligro de perder la fe. Pero para salvarlos de esto, les digo ahora que algunos de los que están aquí escuchándome, no probarán la muerte hasta que hayan visto al Hijo del Hombre venir en la gloria de su Padre". Además, para asegurarnos de que Cristo podía tener todo el poder cuando quisiera, el evangelista continúa: Seis días después, Jesús tomó consigo a Pedro, Santiago y Juan, y los llevó a una montaña alta donde estaban solos. Allí, ante sus ojos, se transfiguró. Su rostro brillaba como el sol, y sus ropas se volvían blancas como la luz. Entonces los discípulos vieron aparecer a Moisés y a Elías, y estaban hablando con Jesús...

Corramos con confianza y gozo para entrar en la nube como Moisés y Elías, o como Santiago y Juan. Dejémonos arrebatar, como Pedro, para contemplar la visión divina y ser transfigurados por esa gloriosa transfiguración del hijo de Dios. Alejémonos del mundo, alejémonos de lo terrenal, elevémonos por encima del cuerpo, desprendámonos de las cosas y volvámonos al Creador, a quien Pedro en éxtasis le exclamó: "Señor, es bueno que estemos aquí..."

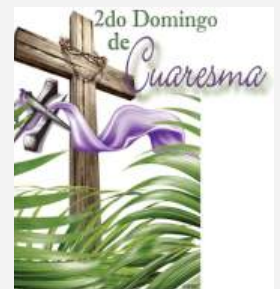

This year we commemorate the Eucharistic Revival that is currently observed throughout our country and the Golden Jubilee of the Diocese of Arlington.
