

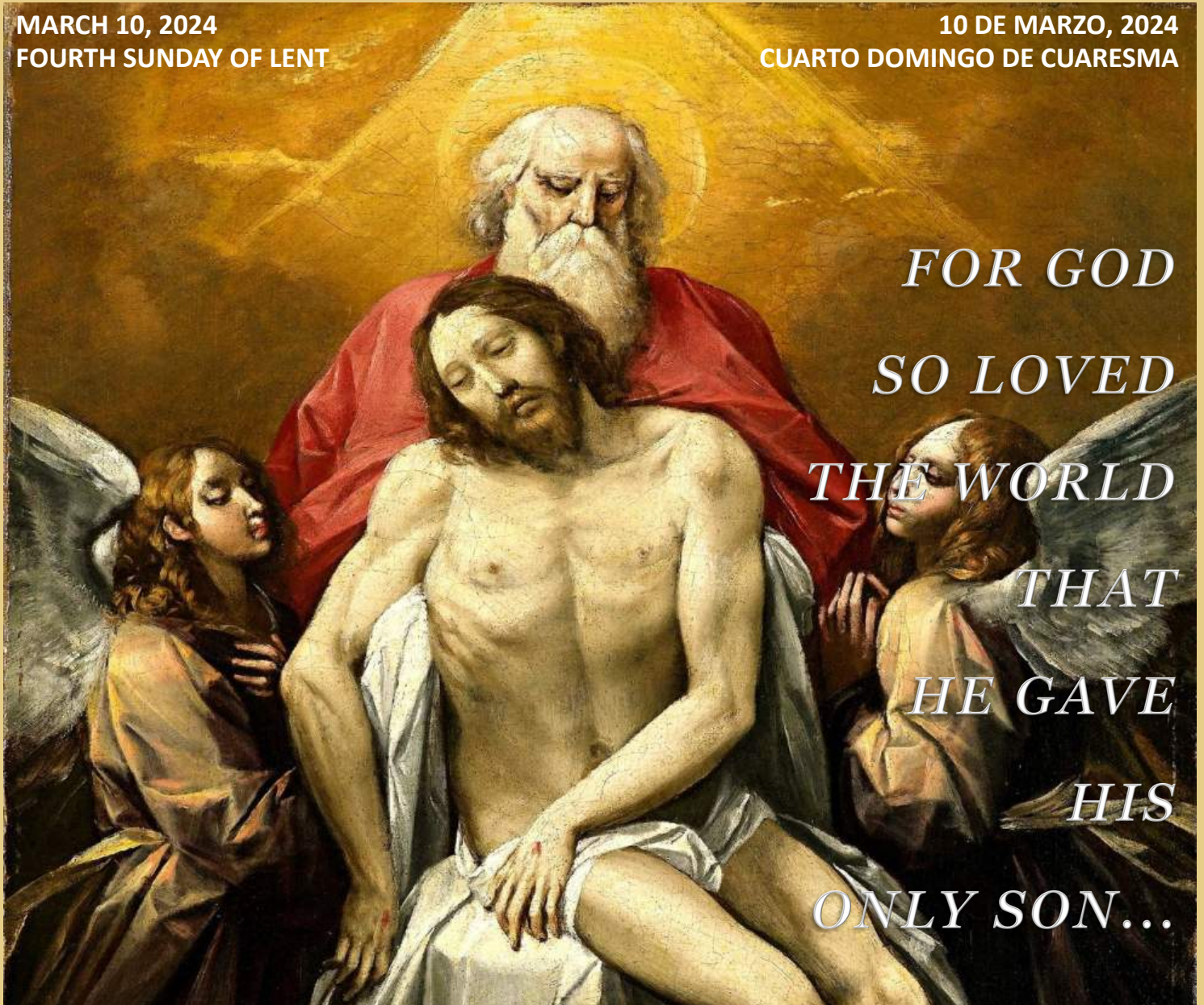

Stewardship Reflection

"For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son..." John 3:16

That we nurture and develop our gifts, and in gratitude, generously give back with increase our time in prayer, our talent in charitable works and our treasure to support the mission and ministry of our parish and greater Church.

LET THERE BE LIGHT

“God separated the light from the darkness.”(Genesis 1:4)

*“And this is the verdict, that the light came into the world, but people preferred darkness to light, because their works were evil. For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come toward the light, so that his works might not be exposed.”
(John 3:19-20)*

History and human hearts are battlegrounds between light and darkness. This conflict has been history's driving force since Cain killed Abel.

That's sin written large, not God's design. The Father's Word shares Light by giving Life: *“All things came to be through him, and without him nothing came to be. What came to be through him was life, and this life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it” (John 1:3-5).* Creation's light reflects God's Light. St. Thomas Aquinas says everything that “is”, is “light”. Light is existence. For men and angels, this light is life.

In the beginning, God created light and then separated the light from darkness, calling light “Day” and darkness “Night” (Genesis 1:4-5). Darkness is angels who followed Lucifer before earth's creation. Darkness is diminishment of light and life. It is sin. *“Our struggle is not with flesh and blood, but with the principalities, with the powers, with the world rulers of this present darkness, with the evil spirits in the heavens”* (Ephesians 6:12).

Then comes Jesus: *“I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness but will have the light of life” (John 8:12).* *“God is light, and in him there is no darkness”*(1 John 1:5).

At Time's End, *“Night will be no more, nor will they need lamp or sun, for the Lord God shall give them light, and they shall reign forever and ever”* (Revelation 22:5). The separation of light and darkness that took place in the Beginning comes full circle in the End. Christ the Light conquers darkness. The Final Judgment, the New Creation, and the New Jerusalem are the ultimate victory of light over darkness.

*“When the sun had set and it was dark,
a flaming torch passed between the parts...” (Genesis 15:17)*

Hágase la Luz

"Dios separó la luz de las tinieblas". (Génesis 1:4.)

"En esto consiste el juicio: que la luz vino al mundo, pero los hombres prefirieron las tinieblas a la luz, porque sus obras eran malas. Todo el que obra mal aborrece la luz y no se acerca a ella, por temor de que sus obras sean descubiertas". (Juan 3:19-20.)

La historia y los corazones humanos son campos de batalla entre la luz y la oscuridad. Este conflicto ha sido la fuerza motriz de la historia de la humanidad desde que Caín mató a Abel.

Eso es el pecado en su máxima expresión, no el diseño de Dios. La Palabra del Padre imparte Luz al dar Vida: *"Todas las cosas fueron hechas por medio La Palabra, y sin ella no se hizo nada de todo lo que existe. En ella estaba la vida, y la vida era la luz de los hombres. La luz resplandece en las tinieblas, y las tinieblas no la percibieron" (Juan 1:3-5).* La luz de la creación refleja la luz de Dios. Santo Tomás de Aquino decía que todo lo que "es", es "luz". La luz es existencia. Para los hombres y los ángeles, esta luz es vida.

En el principio, Dios creó la luz y luego separó la luz de las tinieblas, y llamó "Día" a la luz y "Noche" a las tinieblas (Génesis 1:4-5). Las tinieblas son los ángeles que siguieron a Lucifer antes de la creación de la tierra. La oscuridad es la disminución de la luz y de la vida. Es pecado. *"Porque nuestra lucha no es contra enemigos de carne y sangre, sino contra los Principados, y Potestades, contra los gobernantes de este mundo de tinieblas, contra los espíritus del mal que habitan en el espacio" (Efesios 6:12).*

Luego viene Jesús: *"Yo soy la luz del mundo. El que me sigue, no andará en tinieblas, sino que tendrá la luz de la Vida" (Juan 8:12).* *"Dios es luz, y en él no hay tinieblas" (1 Juan 1:5).*

Al final de los tiempos, *"ya no habrá más noche, ni les hará falta la luz de las lámparas ni la luz de sol, porque el Señor Dios los iluminará, y reinará por los siglos de los siglos" (Apocalipsis 22:5).* El círculo de a separación de la luz y la oscuridad que tuvo lugar en el Principio se cierra en el Fin. Cristo, la Luz, vence a las tinieblas. El Juicio Final, la Nueva Creación y la Nueva Jerusalén son la victoria final de la Luz sobre las tinieblas.

"Cuando se puso el sol y estaba completamente oscuro, una antorcha encendida pasó en medio de las partes..." (Génesis 15:17)

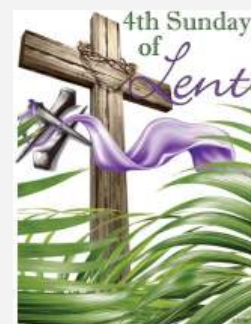
