BECOMING CATHOLIC & ADULT CONFIRMATION

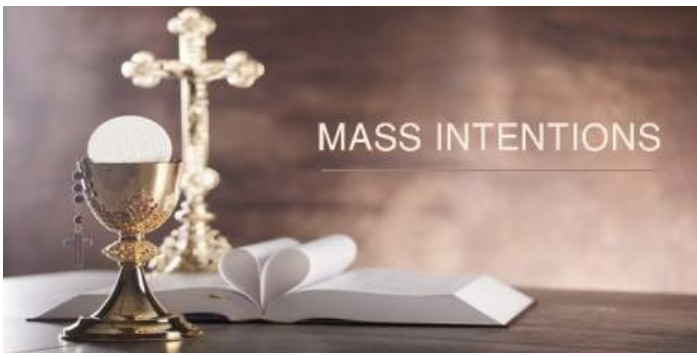

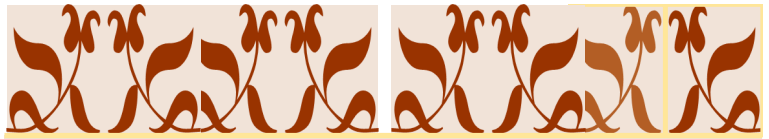

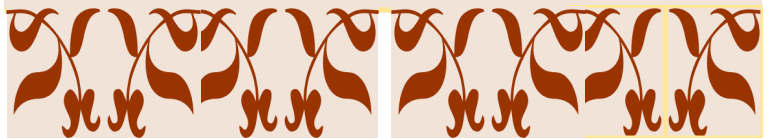

Stewardship Reflection

**"I will be their God and they shall be my people."
Jeremiah 31:33**

What does it mean to be God's people? It means we recognize that everything we have and everything we are belongs to God. We aren't "owners" of anything, we are merely "stewards" of the gifts God has given us. It means we are willing to use our gifts and our lives to care for our family, our neighbors and for people we don't know, just as God cares for each of us.

When I am Lifted up from the Earth

“And when I am lifted up from the earth,” says Christ, *“I will draw all people to myself.”* That’s quite a claim. Nonetheless, the claim continues to be fulfilled within Christ’s Body, the Church. The claim also draws the hearts of many non-believers. *“I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold. These also I must lead, and they will hear my voice, and there will be one flock, one shepherd”* (John 10:16). In other words, *“When I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw all people to myself.”*

The *Book of Numbers* tells of Hebrews wandering the desert *en route* to the Promised Land, led by Moses. The Hebrews were complaining. In punishment, God plagued them with “saraph serpents” (flying venomous snakes – sounds awful) which fatally bit many of them. But God gave them an antivenom: *“Make a saraph mounted on a pole, and if a bitten victim looks at it, he will recover”* (Numbers 21:4-9).

Biblical snakes hearken back to Genesis 3, when Satan tempts Eve. The serpent’s fatal strike injected the sickness of sin and death. But God gives Moses a remedy: Make an image of the evil. Raise it up on a pole and look upon it. Anyone who does so will be healed. That’s a prophecy of the Cross of Jesus Christ.


God’s plan of redemption is riddled with irony. As St. Paul says, *“He who knew no sin was made sin for us, so that we might become the righteousness of God in him”* (2 Corinthians 5:21). Satan mocked God by parodying God. Christ mocked Satan by parodying Satan. Satan duped Eve by promising life. Christ duped Satan by promising death. But with a twist: Christ’s death raises the dead to life.

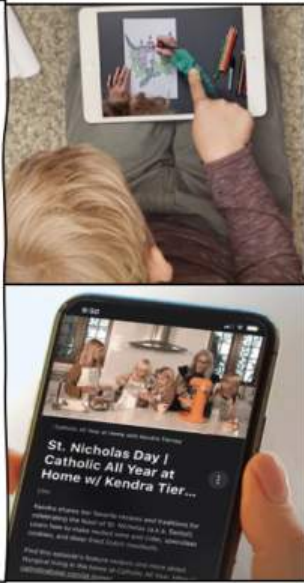

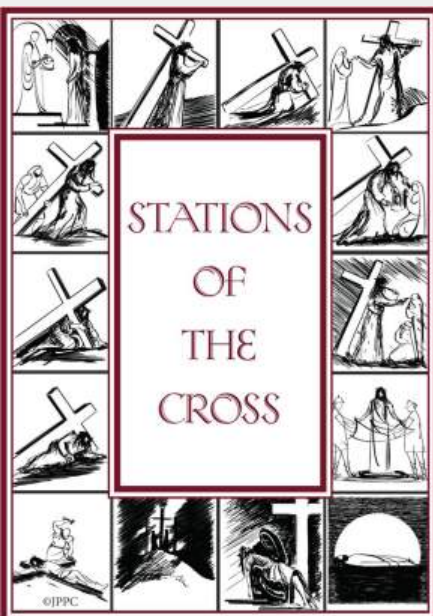

The Stations of the Cross, also known as the Way of the Cross or Via Crucis, commemorate Jesus's passion and death on the cross. There are 14 stations that each depict a moment on his journey to



Calvary, usually through sacred art, prayers, and reflections. The practice began as pious pilgrims traced his path through Jerusalem on the Via Dolorosa.

Later, for the many who wanted to pass along the same route, but could not make the trip to Jerusalem, a practice developed that eventually took the form of the fourteen stations currently found in almost every church throughout the world.

Quando yo sea levantado sobre la tierra

"Y cuando sea levantado en alto sobre la tierra", dijo Cristo, "atraeré a todos hacia mí". Es una declaración contundente. Sin embargo, se continúa cumpliendo a través del Cuerpo de Cristo, la Iglesia. Dicha declaración también atrae a los corazones de muchos no creyentes. "Tengo otras ovejas que no pertenecen a este redil. A éstas también debo guiar, y oirán mi voz, y así habrá un solo rebaño, y un solo Pastor" (Juan 10:16). En otras palabras, "Cuando yo sea levantado de la tierra, atraeré a todos hacia mí".

El *Libro de Números* habla de los Israelitas errando por el desierto *en camino* a la Tierra Prometida bajo la guía de Moisés. Pero en el camino, los Israelitas se quejaron con Dios. Como castigo, Dios envió una plaga de "serpientes abrasadoras" (serpientes venenosas voladoras, suena espantoso) que mordieron fatalmente a muchos de ellos. Pero Dios les dio un antídoto: "Haced una serpiente abrasadora y colóquenla sobre un asta. Y todo el que haya sido mordido, al mirarla, sanará" (Números 21:4-9).

Las serpientes bíblicas se remontan a Génesis 3, cuando Satanás tienta a Eva. El golpe fatal de la serpiente inyectó el veneno del pecado y la muerte. Pero Dios le da a Moisés un remedio: "haz una imagen del mal en un poste. Levanta el poste y míralo. Cualquiera que lo mire será sanado". Esta es una profecía de la Cruz de Jesucristo.

El plan de redención de Dios está plagado de ironía. Como dice San Pablo: "El que no conoció el pecado, Dios lo identificó con el pecado en favor nuestro, a fin de que nosotros seamos justificados por ÉL." (2 Corintios 5:21). Satanás se burló de Dios ridiculizando a Dios. Cristo se burló de Satanás ridiculizando a Satanás. Satanás engañó a Eva prometiéndole vida. Cristo engañó a Satanás prometiéndole la muerte. Pero con un giro: la muerte de Cristo resucita a los muertos.

“Seré su Dios y ellos serán mi pueblo”.
Juan 31:33

Que significa ser el pueblo de Dios? Significa reconocer que todo lo que tenemos y todo lo que somos le pertenece a Dios. No somos los “dueños” de nada, somos simples “administradores” de los dones que Dios nos ha dado. Significa estar dispuestos a utilizar nuestros dones y nuestras vidas para cuidar de nuestra familia, nuestros vecinos y de las personas que no conocemos, de la misma manera como Dios cuida de cada uno de nosotros.

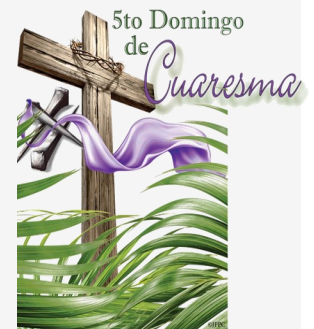
