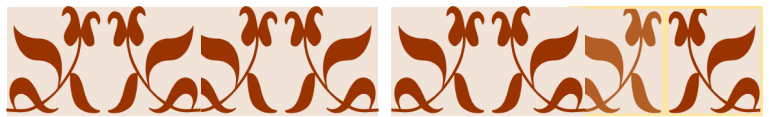

THE PASSION

The beginnings of Christ's mission are contemplated in the rosary's *The Joyful Mysteries of the Annunciation, Visitation, Nativity, Presentation in the Temple, and Finding in the Temple*. Like Christ, our lives began with joyful hope, a fresh beginning. Like a rosebud, every newborn shines beauty and wonder upon us all.

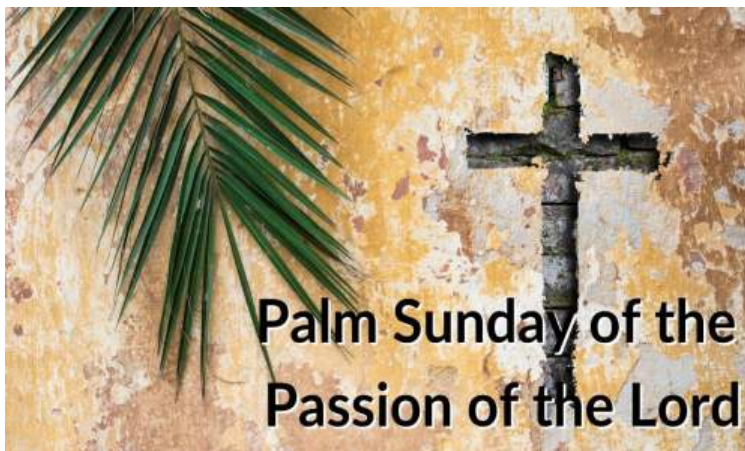
But life's journey is long and painful. Our beginning's freshness fades into a distant memory, like a lost treasure. The beginning's romance gives way to the realism of life's rough and fallen path where thieves rob our innocence and taunt us with suffering.

We don't travel far before we feel the Cross. We experience the *Sorrowful Mysteries* in one way or another: *the Agony in the Garden, Scourging at the Pillar, Crowning with Thorns, Carrying of the Cross, and Death*. But traversing this "valley of tears" promises New Birth: *Rising from the Dead*. Purity of heart blossoms from suffering and brings Wisdom, the crown jewel of prophets and kings of old. If you seek wisdom, God will love you in a most intimate way. "I love those who love me, and those seek me find me" (Proverbs 8:17). The Cross gives New Birth to a New Creation. Its crown is Wisdom.

St. Paul says, "You can trust in this: If we died with Him, we will also live with Him. If we endure, we will also reign with Him" (2 Timothy 2:11-12). The Cross of Jesus — which includes our personal crosses — purifies us for God's Kingdom. Suffering makes us wise. "The desire of Wisdom leads to a kingdom" (Wisdom 6:20).

Christ's Cross turns suffering into something good. Suffering in love reveals humanity's moral greatness. Suffering matures and makes us wise. It makes us generous and conquers self-centeredness. What an irony! In suffering, we overcome ourselves despite ourselves. We discover, within, an empathy for all who suffer. St. John Paul II called this "solidarity in suffering." In our suffering, God prepares us to console others who suffer.

During this Passion Week, reflect on this mystery. In so doing, you will become a missionary of hope. Embrace the Cross. Join Christ in redeeming the world!

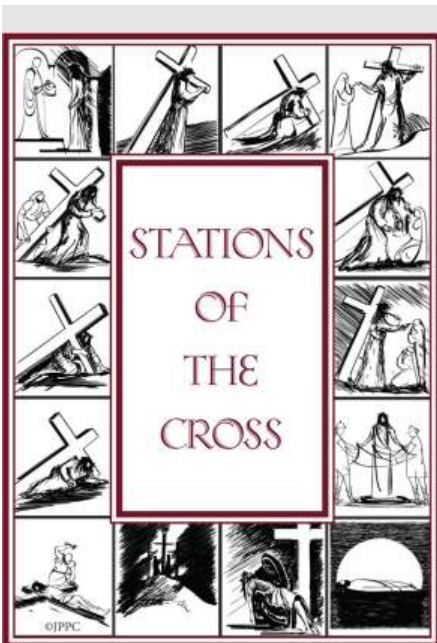

Did you know...

Holy Chrism is a consecrated mixture of olive oil and balsam. These oils are ordinarily blessed once a year, during the Chrism Mass celebrated by the diocesan Bishop together with his priests. Anointing with chrism oil signifies the gift of the Holy Spirit. It is used for the sacrament of confirmation, in the solemn rite of baptism; consecration of churches and bishops; blessings of major church bells, baptismal water, patens, and chalices.



The Stations of the Cross, also known as the Way of the Cross or Via Crucis, commemorate Jesus's passion and death on the cross. There are 14 stations that each depict a moment on his journey to Calvary, usually through sacred art, prayers, and reflections. The practice began as pious pilgrims traced his path through Jerusalem on the Via Dolorosa.

Later, for the many who wanted to pass along the same route, but could not make the trip to Jerusalem, a practice developed that eventually took the form of the fourteen stations currently found in almost every church throughout the world.

LA PASIÓN

Por el P. Frederick Edlefsen

Los inicios de la misión de Cristo se contemplan en los *Misterios Gozosos* del Santo Rosario: *la Anunciación, la Visitación, la Natividad, la Presentación en el Templo y el Hallazgo en el Templo*. Al igual que Cristo, nuestras vidas comienzan llenas de una esperanza jubilosa, un nuevo inicio. Así como un capullo de rosa, cada recién nacido irradia belleza y regocijo sobre todos nosotros.

Pero el viaje de la vida es largo y doloroso. El brio inicial se va convirtiendo en un recuerdo lejano, como un tesoro perdido. El romance que existe al comienzo de nuestra vida da paso a la realidad del camino áspero y dañado de la vida, donde ladrones roban nuestra inocencia y nos acosan con formas de sufrimiento.

No llegamos muy lejos antes de sentir la Cruz. Experimentamos los *Misterios Dolorosos* de una u otra manera: *la Agonía en el Huerto, la Flagelación en la Columna, la Coronación de Espinas, la Cruz a cuestas, y la Muerte*. Sin embargo, la promesa por atravesar este "valle de lágrimas" es un Nuevo Nacimiento: *La Resurrección de entre los Muertos*. Un corazón puro florece del sufrimiento y trae Sabiduría, la joya más valiosa de los profetas y reyes del pasado. Si buscas sabiduría, Dios te amará de la manera más íntima. "Yo amo a los que me aman, y los que me buscan, me encontrarán" (Proverbios 8:17). La Cruz da un Nacimiento Nuevo a una Nueva Creación. Su corona es la Sabiduría.

San Pablo dice: "*Podéis confiar en esto: si morimos con Él, también viviremos con Él. Si perseveramos, también reinaremos con él*" (2 Timoteo 2:11-12). La Cruz de Jesús, que incluye nuestras cruces personales, nos purifican para el Reino de Dios. El sufrimiento nos hace sabios. "El deseo de la Sabiduría conduce a la realeza" (Sabiduría 6:20).

La cruz de Cristo convierte el sufrimiento en algo bueno. Sufrir por amor revela la grandeza moral de la humanidad. A través del sufrimiento se adquiere madurez y sabiduría. Nos hace generosos y vence el egocentrismo. ¡Qué ironía! En el sufrimiento, nos superamos nosotros mismos a pesar de nosotros mismos. Descubrimos, en nuestro interior, una empatía por todos los que sufren. San Juan Pablo II llamó a esto "solidaridad en el sufrimiento". En nuestro sufrimiento, Dios nos prepara para que podamos consolar a otros que sufren.

Durante esta Semana Santa, reflexiona sobre el misterio de la Pasión de Cristo. Al hacerlo, te convertirás en un misionero de esperanza. Abraza la Cruz. ¡Únete a Cristo a redimir al mundo!
