A GOOD WORD FOR 2024 GRADUATES

“Why are you troubled?” Christ asks this in today’s Gospel (Luke 24:38). In John’s Gospel, he says, “Be not unbelieving but believe” (John 20:27). “Whoever believes in me will never die” (John 11:26).

Put aside anxiety. “Consider the lilies of the field. They neither toil nor spin, yet not even Solomon in all his splendor was dressed like one of these” (Matthew 6:28-30). These are good words from Christ to graduates and to all who are starting a phase in life. Like lilies, God clothes you with grace.

Despite today’s overwhelming problems, there’s a spark of brightness. That spark is you. There’s hope in the questions that young people ask these days. Today, people raise good questions and propose new ideas for a better world. Don’t let disappointment shatter hope. Disappointment is a fact of life, and it makes you mature. Disappointment makes us face reality with humility. But disappointment is not life’s last word. Jesus Christ is the last word.

Sixty years ago, the Catholic Church made some bold proclamations:

- “In the face of the world’s modern development, the number constantly swells of the people who raise the most basic questions and recognize them with new sharpness: What is man? What is this sense of sorrow, of evil, of death, which continues to exist despite so much progress? What purpose have these victories purchased at so high a cost? What can men and women offer to society, what can they expect from it? What follows this earthly life?” (Second Vatican Council, “Pastoral Constitution of the Church in the Modern World”, *Gaudium et Spes*, 10).
- “It is only in the Mystery of the Word made flesh that the mystery of man becomes clear.” (*Gaudium et Spes* 22)
- “The Gospel of Christ constantly renews the life and culture of fallen humanity... It never ceases to purify and elevate the morality of people.... It makes fruitful the [cultures] of every people of every age. It strengthens, perfects, and restores them in Christ. Thus, the Church stimulates and advances human culture. By her action, also by her liturgy, [the Church] leads people to inner freedom.” (*Gaudium et Spes* 58)

Dear graduates, be generous. In the grace of your Baptism and Confirmation, build a better world. “Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven” (Matthew 5:12).

PALABRAS DE BIEN PARA LOS GRADUADOS DE 2024

—¿Por qué estás preocupado? Cristo pregunta esto en el Evangelio de hoy (Lucas 24:38). En el Evangelio de Juan, Él dice: "No seas incrédulo, sino hombre de fe" (Juan 20:27). "Todo aquel que cree en mí no morirá jamás" (Juan 11:26).

Deja a un lado la ansiedad. "Observa los lirios del campo, como van creciendo sin fatigarse ni tejer. Ni Salomón en toda su gloria, se vistió como uno de ellos" (Mateo 6:28-30). Estas son las palabras de bien que Cristo exclama para los graduados y para todos los que están comenzando una etapa nueva en la vida. Como los lirios, Dios te viste de gracia.

A pesar de los abrumadores problemas de hoy, hay una chispa de brillo. Esa chispa eres tú. Hay esperanza en las preguntas que hacen los jóvenes de hoy. Hoy en día, la gente plantea buenas preguntas y propone nuevas ideas para un mundo mejor. No dejes que la decepción destruya la esperanza. La decepción es un hecho de la vida y te hace madurar. La decepción nos hace enfrentar la realidad con humildad. Pero la decepción no es la última palabra de la vida. Jesucristo es la última palabra.

Hace sesenta años, la Iglesia Católica hizo algunas proclamaciones audaces:

- "Ante la actual evolución del mundo, son cada día mas numerosos los que plantean o los que acometen con nueva agudeza las cuestiones mas fundamentales: ¿Qué es el hombre? ¿Cuál es el sentido del dolor, del mal, de la muerte, que a pesar de tantos progresos, subsisten todavía? ¿Qué valor tienen las victorias logradas a tan caro precio? ¿Qué puede dar el hombre y la mujer a la sociedad y qué pueden esperar de ella? ¿Qué hay después de esta vida terrenal?" (Concilio Vaticano II, "Constitución pastoral sobre la Iglesia en el mundo contemporáneo", *Gaudium et spes*, 10)
- "El misterio del hombre solo se esclarece en el misterio del Verbo encarnado" (*Gaudium et Spes* 22)
- "La buena nueva de Cristo renueva constantemente la vida y la cultura de la humanidad caída... Purifica y eleva incesantemente la moral de los pueblos... Hace fecundar las cualidades espirituales y las tradiciones de cada pueblo y de cada edad, las fortalece, perfecciona y restaura en Cristo. Así, la Iglesia estimula y promueve la cultura humana. Y con su acción, incluida la litúrgica, [la Iglesia] educa al hombre en la libertad interior". (*Gaudium et Spes* 58)

Queridos graduados, sean generosos. En la gracia de vuestro Bautismo y Confirmación, construyan un mundo mejor. "Alégrense y regocíjense, porque grande será tu recompensa en el cielo" (Mateo 5:12).

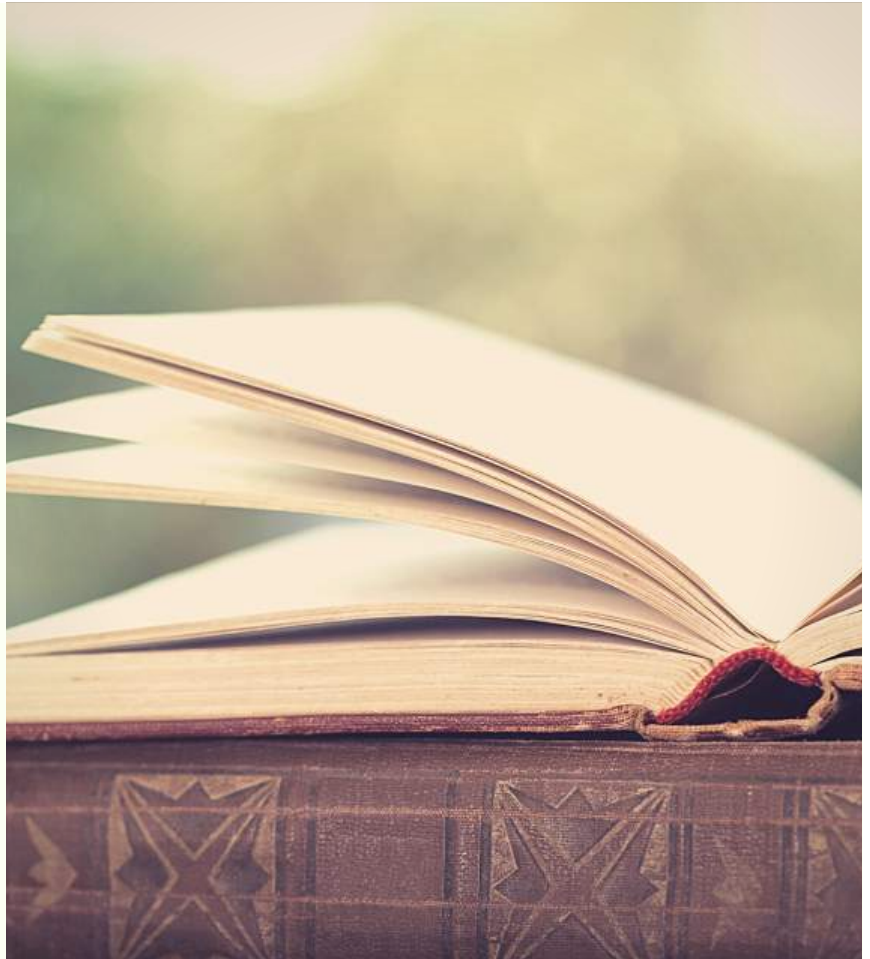

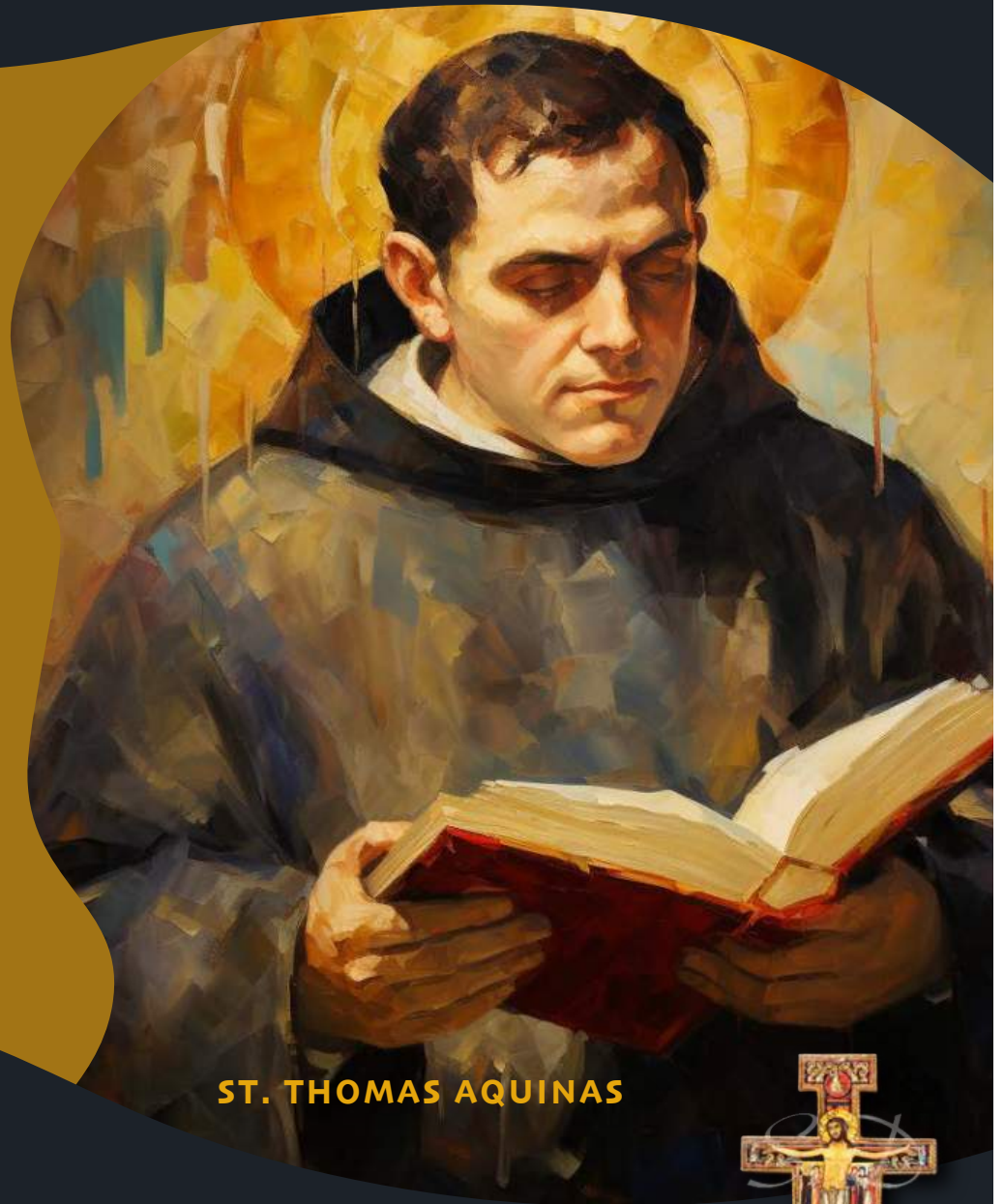
