FIRST COMMUNIONS and the Cantaloupe Patch

Today, the Fifth Sunday of Easter, we have First Communions and the May Crowning of Mary at the 10:00 AM Mass. We will also have five First Communions at the Spanish Mass on May 5. During First Communion Masses, I survey the patch of second graders, sitting in the front pews, who will receive Christ's Body and Blood for the first time. What do I see? God's garden. To me, it looks a like a cantaloupe patch with eyes. Isaiah calls it a vineyard.

*"Let me sing now for my Beloved
A song of my Beloved concerning his vineyard.
My Beloved had a vineyard on a fertile hill." (Isaiah 5:1)*

We are all this garden's caretakers. Moreover, we all should set the example and receive every Communion as if it were our First Communion. At Mass, earth and heaven come together in a happy experience of innocence and joy – in Holy Communion.

Second grade is good timing for First Communion. Kids are entering the "Age of Reason," when they begin to grasp the difference between right and wrong. They're embarking on an age of discovery but without too much seriousness. They are passing into what might be called the "golden years," which run roughly through ages eight and nine, when play and learning go together. It's an age of primeval rationality, curiosity, imagination, and a hankering for adventure and discovery.

"Nascantur in admiratione." "Let them be born in wonder," goes the old saying. For kids, the best learning begins with *delight*. *Delight* leads to *wonder*, and *wonder* leads to *wisdom*. Wonder is God's invitation to be his friend. Golden age kids are also becoming capable of loyal friendship, including with Jesus. Jesus stories provoke their imaginations to learn about God and Creation. Miracles, angels, saints, Bible stories, art, sacred music, poems, and prayers feed children's maturing souls and form their moral imagination. We humans must know the rhymes before the reasons.

Our children have now approached God's Altar to receive Christ's Body and Blood. Bring them back every Sunday and Holy Day. Teach them to live in the grace they have received. Form their minds and hearts in the beauty of the Catholic faith. "Be shepherds of God's flock that is under your care, watching over them..." (1 Peter 5:2).

PRIMERAS COMUNIONES

El próximo domingo, en la misa en español, tendremos cinco Primeras Comuniones y la Coronación de María en mayo. Durante las Misas de Primera Comunión, yo observo desde el pulpito a los jóvenes que recibirán el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo por primera vez. ¿Y qué veo? El jardín de Dios. El profeta Isaías lo llama la viña.

*"Voy a cantar en nombre de mi amigo
el canto de mi amado a su viña.
Mi Amado tenía una viña en una colina fértil".
(Isaías 5:1.)*

Todos somos guardianes del jardín de Dios. Además, todos debemos dar el ejemplo y recibir cada Comunión como si fuera nuestra Primera Comunión. Durante cada Misa, la tierra y el cielo se unen en una experiencia feliz llena de inocencia y alegría—en Sagrada Comunión. Para prepararnos para esta experiencia, debemos confesarnos regularmente.

La gracia de recibir el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo debe ser preservada y cultivada. A medida que nuestros jóvenes continúan recibiendo la Santa Comunión, debemos continuar enseñándoles la maravilla de la presencia de Dios dentro de nosotros.

"Nascantur en admiración". "Que nazcan maravillados", dice el viejo refrán. Para los jóvenes, el mejor aprendizaje comienza con *el deleite*. *El deleite* lleva al *asombro*, y *el asombro* lleva a la *sabiduría*. El asombro es una forma en que Dios nos invita a ser su amigo. Los jóvenes son capaces de entablar amistades leales, incluso con Jesús. Las historias de Jesús ayudan a los jóvenes a aprender sobre Dios y la Creación. Los milagros, los ángeles, los santos, las historias bíblicas, el arte, la música sacra, los poemas y las oraciones alimentan las almas dóciles de los jóvenes y forman su imaginación de una manera pura. Los humanos debemos conocer el gozo antes que las razones.

Nuestros jóvenes se están acercando al Altar de Dios para recibir el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. Tráelos de nuevo todos los domingos y días santos. Enséñales a vivir en la gracia que han recibido. Forma sus mentes y corazones en la belleza de la fe católica. "Sed pastores del rebaño de Dios, que les ha sido confiado; velen por él..." (1 Pedro 5:2)
