The Graces of Baptism & Confirmation

And the Journey of Love & Life

Baptism made you holy. Innocence claimed you for God. The root of a baptized soul is a Divine Love that empowers you to love God and neighbor with God's love and in the way that God loves.

Love *wills the good of the other*. Love is the New World into which you were born at Baptism. It will blossom like a radiant rose at dawn when Christ comes again. At death, when you pass from the womb of this world into the New World of Heaven, you may be so amazed as to say something like, "I've become a child again!".

Life is a journey.

Biologically, psychologically, and emotionally, we cannot remain children. "When I was a child, I talked like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I put the ways of childhood behind me" (1 Corinthians 13:11). Life is also a spiritual journey that progresses in the opposite direction. As we grow in holiness, we mature into spiritual childhood. "Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like little children, you cannot enter the kingdom of heaven" (Matthew 18:3). The American artist, Carl Schmitt, wrote, "When will we learn that childhood is in a great sense not simply a preparation for adult life, but a thing unique and complete in itself – a master piece of God." For the Christian, adulthood is a passage to spiritual childhood. This is where the grace of Confirmation comes in.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church says, "This seal of the Holy Spirit marks our total belonging to Christ ... [and] the promise of divine protection in the great eschatological trial" (CCC 1296). Through Confirmation, the Holy Spirit gives you strength and courage to endure unavoidable temptations against innocence and against faith, hope, and love. Moreover, you are strengthened to endure the purifications of the "refiners fire" (Malachi 3:2). Confirmation strengthens you to hold your peace amidst the deceptions of sin and the spirit of Antichrist (CCC 675-677). Confirmation gives you the courage to bear witness to the Gospel until Christ's coming. Be attentive to the Holy Spirit's whispers. Hold your peace and bear witness to Christ, remaining unscathed as you watch the "storms of destruction pass by" (Psalm 57).

LAS GRACIAS DEL BAUTISMO Y LA CONFIRMACION

Y el viaje del amor y la vida

El bautismo te hizo santo. La inocencia te lleva a Dios. La raíz de un alma bautizada es un Amor Divino que te capacita para amar a Dios y al prójimo con el amor de Dios y de la manera en él que nos ama.

El amor *desea el bien del otro*. El amor es el Nuevo Mundo en el que naciste en el Bautismo. Este amor florecerá como una rosa radiante al amanecer cuando Cristo venga de nuevo. Al morir, cuando pasas del vientre de este mundo al Nuevo Mundo de los Cielos, tu asombro será tan grande que bien podrías decir: "¡Me siento como un niño otra vez!"

La vida es un viaje. No podemos seguir siendo niños ni biológica, psicológica o emocionalmente. "Cuando era niño, hablaba como un niño, pensaba como un niño, razonaba como un niño. Cuando llegué a ser hombre, dejé atrás los caminos de la niñez" (1 Corintios 13:11). La vida es también un viaje espiritual que progresa en la dirección opuesta. A medida que crecemos en santidad, maduramos en la infancia espiritual. "De cierto les digo que si ustedes no cambian o no se hacen como niños, no entrarán en el Reino de los Cielos" (Mateo 18:3). El artista estadounidense, Carl Schmitt, escribió: "¿Cuándo aprenderemos que la infancia en un gran sentido, no es simplemente una preparación para la vida adulta, sino algo único y completo en sí mismo, una obra maestra de Dios?" Para el cristiano, la edad adulta es un pasaje a la infancia espiritual. Aquí es donde entra en juego la gracia de la Confirmación.

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica dice: "Este sello del Espíritu Santo marca nuestra total pertenencia a Cristo...[y] la promesa de la protección divina en la gran prueba escatológica" (CIC 1296). A través de la Confirmación, el Espíritu Santo te da fuerza y coraje para soportar las tentaciones que inevitablemente roban la inocencia y van contra la fe, la esperanza y el amor. Además, con la gracia de la Confirmación eres fortalecido para soportar las purificaciones del "fuego purificador" (Malaquías 3:2). La Confirmación te fortalece para mantener tu paz en medio de los engaños del pecado y del espíritu del Anticristo (CIC 675-677). La Confirmación te da la valentía de ser testigo del Evangelio hasta la venida de Cristo. Permanece atento a los susurros del Espíritu Santo. Mantén paz en tu vida y da testimonio de Cristo con tus buenas acciones, permaneciendo a salvo mientras ver "pasar las tormentas de destrucción" (Salmo 57).

Carlo Acutis started cataloging Eucharistic Miracles around the world when he was just 11 years old and wrote at the time, "The more Eucharist we receive, the more we will become like Jesus so that on this earth we will have a foretaste of Heaven." He then asked his parents to start taking him to all the places of the Eucharistic miracles, and two and half years later the project was completed.

He researched over 136 Eucharistic miracles that occurred over the centuries in different countries around the world, and have been acknowledged by the Church and collected them into a virtual museum. Besides creating a website to house this virtual museum, he helped create panel presentations that have traveled around the world. Carlo is the youngest contemporary person to be beatified. He used his gifts to share these Eucharistic Miracles with us all!
