What is Mass?

Reflection on the Body and Blood of Christ

By Fr. Frederick Edlefsen



J.R.R. Tolkien wrote this in a letter to his son Michael, dated November 1, 1963: *"You speak of 'sagging faith,' however... The only cure for sagging faith is Communion. Though always Itself, perfect and complete and inviolate, the Blessed Sacrament does not operate completely and once for all in any of us. Like the act of Faith it must be continuous and grow by exercise. Frequency is of the highest effect... Also I can recommend this as an exercise (alas! only too easy...): make your communion in circumstances that affront your taste. Choose a snuffling or gabbling priest or a proud and vulgar friar; and a church full of the usual bourgeois crowd, ill-behaved children – from those who yell to those products of Catholic schools who the moment the tabernacle is opened sit back and yawn... Go to Communion with them (and pray for them). It will be just the same (or better than that) as a mass said beautifully by a visibly holy man, and shared by a few devout and decorous people. (It could not be worse than the mess of the feeding the Five Thousand – after which Our Lord propounded the feeding that was to come)."*

Mass and Holy Communion bear fruit with consistent practice. That's true of life's most important things. Like regular meals, some are good, and some are bad, most are forgotten, but over time they all sustain life. Mass after Mass, the sanctifying power of the Eucharistic Sacrifice works in ways that are usually unnoticeable and yet life-giving.

In the Church's liturgy, Christ makes present his Paschal mystery – his death and resurrection. Good Friday and Easter are not just past events. Rather, Christ's death destroyed death for all time. His sacrifice transcends all times and events. *"The event of the Cross and Resurrection abides and draws everything toward life"* (*Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1085*).

Mass continuously makes present Christ's Paschal mystery until the End of Time. When you attend Mass regularly, your whole life is continuously offered to the Father through Christ's sacrifice. *"Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise them up at the last day"* (John 6:54).

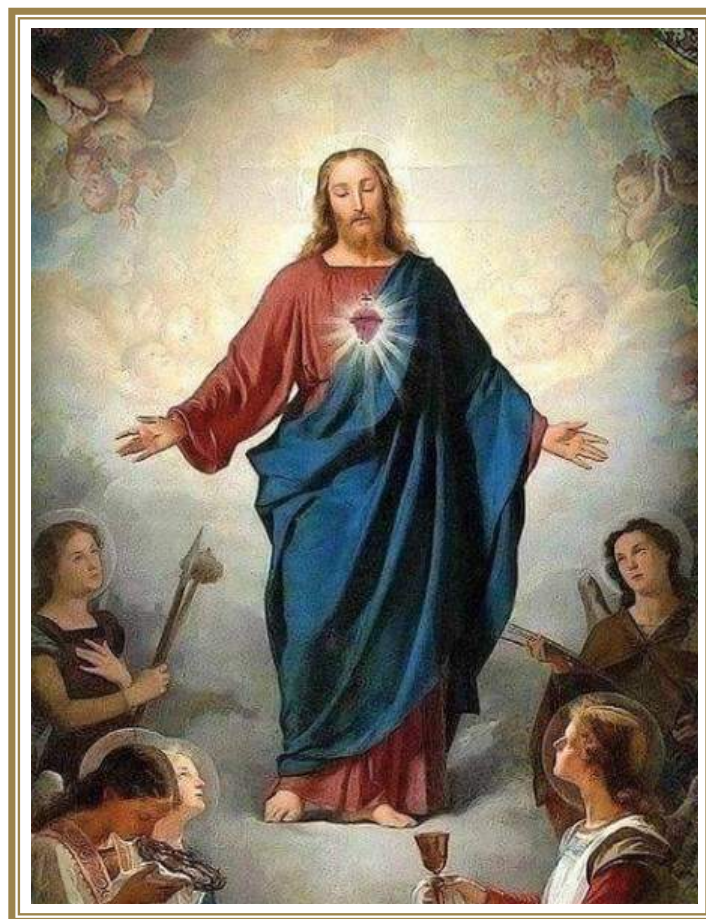

¿Que es la Misa?

Una reflexión sobre el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo

Por el P. Frederick Edlefsen

J.R.R. Tolkien escribió esto en una carta a su hijo Michael, fechada el 1 de noviembre de 1963: *"Sin embargo, hablas de 'fe debilitada'... La única cura para la fe debilitada es la Comunión. Aunque siempre es Él mismo, perfecto, completo e inviolable, el Santísimo Sacramento no opera completamente y de una sola vez en ninguno de nosotros. Al igual que el acto de fe, debe ser continuo y crecer por medio del ejercicio. La frecuencia es de mayor efecto... También puedo recomendar esto como un ejercicio (¡ay! demasiado fácil...): haz tu comunión en circunstancias que ofenden tu gusto. Escoge a un sacerdote que gruñe o platica mucho o a un fraile orgulloso y vulgar; y una iglesia llena de la habitual muchedumbre burguesa, de niños mal portados, desde los que gritan hasta los productos de las escuelas católicas que en el momento en que se abre el tabernáculo se sientan y bostezan... Comulga con ellos (y reza por ellos). Será igual (o mejor) que una misa dicha bellamente por un hombre visiblemente santo, y compartida por unas pocas personas devotas y decorosas. (No podría ser peor que el desorden de dar alimento a los Cinco Mil— después del cual Nuestro Señor presentó el alimento que estaba por venir)".*

La Misa y la Santa Cena dan fruto con la práctica constante. Esto es cierto con la mayoría de las cosas más importantes de la vida. Al igual que las comidas diarias, algunas son buenas y otras son malas, la mayoría se olvidan, pero con el tiempo todas nos dan sustento para vivir. Al ir a Misa tras Misa tras Misa, el poder santificador del Sacrificio Eucarístico actúa de maneras que generalmente son imperceptibles y, sin embargo, vivificantes.

En la liturgia de la Iglesia, Cristo hace presente su misterio pascual, su muerte y resurrección. El Viernes Santo y la Pascua no son solo eventos pasados. Más bien, la muerte de Cristo destruyó la muerte para siempre. Su sacrificio trasciende todos los tiempos y acontecimientos. "El acontecimiento de la cruz y de la resurrección *permanece* y nos lleva todo lo que es vida" (*Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, 1085*).

La Misa hace presente continuamente el misterio pascual de Cristo hasta el fin de los tiempos. Cuando asistes a Misa regularmente, toda tu vida se ofrece continuamente al Padre a través del sacrificio de Cristo. "El que come mi carne y bebe mi sangre, tiene Vida eterna, y yo lo resucitaré en el último día" (Juan 6:54).

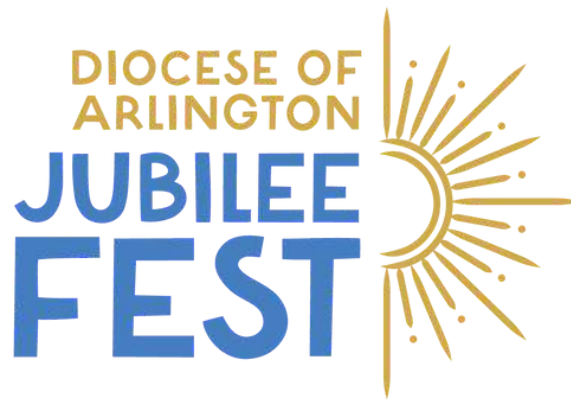
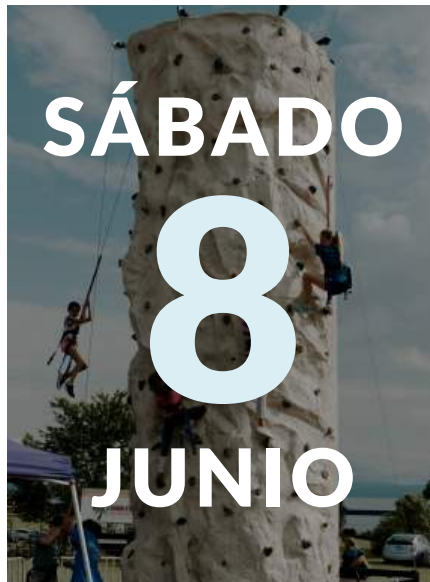
