# The Other Side of Markets

## Why Grandmere Introduced Me to a Fishmonger

When I was a teenager, Grandmere—my grandmother on dad’s side—embarrassed me at stores. She introduced me to everybody, including a Kroger’s fishmonger named Brad.

Grandmere was baptized Ella Longendyke in Coxsackie, New York early in the last century. Her Dutch ancestors settled in the Hudson Valley shortly after the Mayflower. She married Frederick Herman Edlefsen, a bread salesman born of a Danish baker and a Viennese Catholic Jew. Go figure. Frederick died in 1957, leaving Ella a widow. She worked to put Martin (my Dad) and Dawn (my Aunt) through college. Though Dutch Reformed, you’d never know it. Later in life, she often employed her Catholic grandson to mix Bloody Marys before lunch.

Grandmere was from a different time. I was a Gen X teenager in a world of electronic check-out counters. In her world, flesh-and-blood merchants kept everyone one in touch. You personally knew your butcher, baker and fishmonger. To pay for Dad’s and Dawn’s college, she ran a deli, among other jobs. Of course, she cultivated a good taste in cold cuts and held Jewish delicatessens in high esteem. It was a neighborly business.

Per Catholic Social Teaching, commerce is about both prosperity and friendship. Healthy business promotes love, civilization, and culture. Markets are social. We’ve all heard tales of young men and women meeting spouses while working behind counters or waiting on tables. Commerce is a matchmaker and friend-maker. In Grandmere’s world, neighbors, businesses, friends, and marriages were woven together like a tapestry.

Catholic Social Teaching calls this the “Common Good.” It is “the sum total of social conditions which allow people, either as groups or individuals, to reach their fulfillment more fully and more easily” (*Compendium of the Social Doctrine of the Church, #164*). “Everything is connected” (Pope Francis, *Laudato Si*, 117).

Some practical advice: Offer some humor or good words to workers in stores, restaurants, airports, and commercial places. Be generously patient and gracious when they make inconvenient mistakes. Restrain selfish tendencies. Patience is a fruit of the Holy Spirit. Per St. Therese of Lisieux: Do small things with the greatest love. Even in marketplaces. The person behind the counter has a story. Grandmere introduced me to Brad. I was embarrassed. Perhaps she made Brad’s day. That’s the other side of Markets.

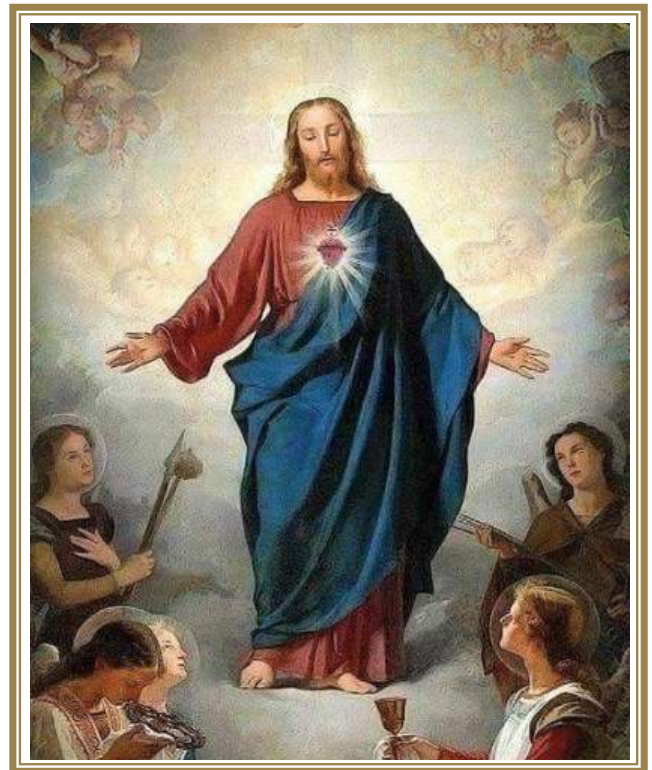

## El otro lado de los Negocios

### ¿Por qué Grandmere me presentó a un vendedor de pescado?

Cuando era adolescente, Grandmere (mi abuela paterna) me avergonzaba en las tiendas. Me presentaba a todo el mundo, incluyendo a Brad, el vendedor de pescado de la tienda Kroger.

Grandmere fue bautizada como "Ella" Longendyke en Coxsackie, Nueva York, a principios del siglo pasado. Sus antepasados holandeses se establecieron en el valle de Hudson poco después de la llegada del Mayflower. Se casó con Frederick Herman Edlefsen, un vendedor de pan e hijo de un panadero danés y una judía católica vienés. Un caso curioso. Frederick murió en 1957, dejando viuda a "Ella", la cual trabajo varios empleos para que Martin (mi papá) y Dawn (mi tia) fueran a la universidad. Aunque "Ella" creció en una familia religiosa, nunca te lo imaginarias. Mas tarde en su vida, a menudo empleaba a su nieto católico para mezclar Bloody Marys antes del almuerzo.

Grandmere era de otra época. Yo era un adolescente de la generación X en un mundo de cajas registradoras electrónicas. En su mundo, los empleados de las tiendas eran quienes mantenían en contacto al vecindario entero. Conocías personalmente al carnicero, panadero y al vendedor de pescados. Para pagar la universidad de papá y Dawn, "Ella" tuvo varios trabajos, incluyendo el manejo de una tienda de embutidos. De esta forma, "Ella" logró cultivar un buen gusto por los embutidos y alta estima por los tiendas delicatessen judías. Su tienda era uno de los negocios del vecindario.

Según la Doctrina Social Católica, el comercio tiene que ver tanto con la prosperidad como con el compañerismo. Los negocios saludables promueven el amor al prójimo, la civilización y la cultura. Los negocios son sociales. Todos hemos escuchado historias de muchachos y muchachas que conocieron a sus cónyuges mientras trabajaban detrás de los mostradores o sirviendo mesas. El comercio da oportunidades para formar matrimonios y amistades. En el mundo de Grandmere, los vecinos, los negocios, los amigos, y los matrimonios se entretejan como un tapiz.

La Doctrina Social de la Iglesia llama a esto el "Bien Común". Es "la suma total de las condiciones sociales que permiten a las personas, ya sea como grupos o como individuos, alcanzar su potencial plena y fácilmente". (*Compendio de la Doctrina Social de la Iglesia, #164*). "Todo esta conectado" (Papa Francisco, *Laudato Si*, 117).

Algunos consejos prácticos: ofrezca algo de humor o buenas palabras a los trabajadores en tiendas, restaurantes, aeropuertos y lugares comerciales. Sea generoso y amable aun cuando estas personas cometan errores que le molesten. Restringa las tendencias egoístas. La paciencia es un fruto del Espíritu Santo. Según Santa Teresita de Lisieux: Haz pequeñas cosas con el mayor amor. Incluso en las tiendas. La persona detrás del mostrador tiene una historia. Cuando Grandmere me presentó a Brad, me sentí avergonzado. Pero talvez este encuentro le alegro el día a Brad. Esa es la otra cara de los negocios.
