# Learning and Holiness

## Masters and Disciples

First comes the disciple. Then the master appears.

Guiding a soul down the long and winding road of learning is a fine art. So is guiding a soul *into* holiness. Note: I didn't say, "guiding a soul *to* holiness." I said, "guiding a soul *into* holiness." "To" seeks a destination. "Into" dives into what is already present. A baptized soul possesses innate holiness, *into* which a person must be guided. A spiritual guide accompanies another *into* the holiness of their Baptism.

All learning (spiritual and secular) is a journey "into" rather than "to." Learning doesn't have a destination. It reveals what's already there. Holiness isn't a destination. It's a discovery.

In Catholic Tradition, learning and holiness are distinct but not separate pursuits. Rather, they are two facets on the diamond of human growth. St. Thomas Aquinas said knowledge that doesn't "end" in love is useless. For Aquinas, the "end" is a discovery, not a destination.

Here's the clincher: True knowledge presupposes love. We love because we have first touched, tasted, smelled, heard, and seen, releasing the energy of intelligence. We learn and work to prosper and pray.

"*Nascantur in admiratione.*" "Let them be born in wonder." Academic subjects – math, science, technology, languages, literature, writing, arts, philosophy, religion, etc. – should provoke wonder and prayer. Before these subjects daunt us, they should amaze us. When knowledge is a *goal*, it causes anxiety (rampant nowadays). Wonder, not a goal, is key to true learning. Wonder requires reflection at leisure. That said, learning's occupational hazards are arrogance and being disputatious, which narrow the mind. Enlightenment can deceptively dazzle the mind, leading one to confuse the "part" for the "whole." True learning requires humility, which opens the mind. Wonder, humility, and reflection sing together.

Aquinas said, "*The end of our knowing is to know God as something unknown.*" Knowledge gazes beneath the starry sky of Mystery. Per G.K. Chesterton, knowledge is not about getting the heavens into our head, but about getting our head into the heavens. The Creator of (1) *the world* and (2) *our ability to know it* is Something Unknown. In this world, we cannot know as much as we wish. But we can love as much as we wish. However, the more we *love* in this world, the more we will *rejoice in knowing* in the next.

## Aprendizaje y Santidad

### Maestros y discípulos

Primero viene el discípulo. Después aparece el maestro.

Guiar a un alma por el largo y sinuoso camino del aprendizaje es un arte. También lo es guiar a un alma en la santidad. Nota: Yo no dije "guiar a un alma *hacia* la santidad". Yo dije: "guiando a un alma *en* la santidad". "*Hacia*" busca un destino. "*En*" se sumerge en lo que ya está presente. Una alma bautizada posee una santidad innata, *en la* cual una persona debe ser guiada. Un guía espiritual acompaña a otro *en* la santidad de sus mutuos Bautismos.

Todo aprendizaje (espiritual y secular) es un viaje "*en*" y no "*hacia*". El aprendizaje no tiene un destino. Revela lo que ya está ahí. La santidad no es un destino. Es un descubrimiento.

En la Tradición Católica, el aprendizaje y la santidad son actividades distintas, pero no separadas. Más bien, son dos facetas en el diamante del crecimiento humano. Santo Tomás de Aquino dijo que el conocimiento que no "termina" en el amor es un conocimiento inútil. Para Tomás de Aquino, el "fin" es un descubrimiento, no un destino.

Aquí está el factor decisivo: el verdadero conocimiento presupone amor. Amamos primero a través de nuestros sentidos del tacto, olfato, oído, gusto y vista, usando la energía del intelecto. Aprendemos y trabajamos para poder prosperar y orar.

"*Nascantur en admiración*". "Que nazcan maravillados". Las asignaturas académicas (matemáticas, ciencias, tecnología, idiomas, literatura, escritura, artes, filosofía, religión, etc.) deben provocar asombro y oración. Antes de que estos temas nos intimiden, deberían sorprendernos. Cuando el conocimiento es una *meta*, causa ansiedad (excesiva hoy en día). El asombro, no una meta, es la clave para el verdadero aprendizaje. El asombro requiere reflexión en el tiempo libre. Dicho esto, los riesgos del aprendizaje son la arrogancia y la disputa, las cuales estrechan la mente. La ilustración o iluminación intelectual y cultural puede deslumbrar engañosamente la mente, llevando a uno a confundir la "parte" con el "todo". El verdadero aprendizaje requiere humildad, la cual abre la mente. El asombro, la humildad y la reflexión cantan juntos.

Tomás de Aquino dijo: "*El fin de nuestro conocimiento es conocer a Dios como algo desconocido*". El Conocimiento existe bajo el cielo luminoso del Misterio. Según G.K. Chesterton, el conocimiento no se trata de meter los cielos en nuestra cabeza, sino de meter nuestra cabeza en los cielos. El Creador de (1) *el mundo* y (2) *nuestra capacidad de conocerlo* es Algo Desconocido. En este mundo, no podemos saber tanto como quisiéramos. Pero podemos amar todo lo que queramos. Y será que cuanto más amemos en este mundo, más nos *regocijaremos en saber* en el próximo.
