Patriotism

Independence Day Reflections

The United States is history's only country founded upon a principle of "self-evident" and "unalienable" human rights. *"We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain*

unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness." This line from Preamble of the Declaration of Independence is among the best known in the English language. It proposed something universal about human nature and human rights. This principle informed another "Declaration", the United Nation's *Universal Declaration of Human Rights* (December 10, 1948). Its Preamble begins, *"Whereas recognition of the inherent dignity and of the equal and inalienable rights of all members of the human family is the foundation of freedom, justice and peace in the world..."* If we reflect on these passages from the US's and UN's Declarations, we'll see the global significance of American "patriotism."

"Patriotism" derives from the Latin "patria", which means "fatherland". Moreover, we are "human", which means "from the land (earth)". "Patriotism" is about "humans" gratefully loving their fatherland and their mother earth (the world). It's an aspect of the Fourth Commandment: "Honor your father and mother – the first Commandment with a promise – so that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth" (Ephesians 6:2-3).

Patriots love their fatherland. And, by extension, they love all fatherlands because they love all people who love their nation. Patriots acknowledge ancestral sins (everyone has them) and celebrate ancestral virtues. Patriotism flows from what Alexis de Tocqueville called "mores" – "habits of the heart" – which form a social character. For example, the social virtues of neighborliness and justice are rooted in this. A true patriot grasps, in mind and heart, the universality of *"unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness"* and *"of the inherent dignity and of the equal and inalienable rights of all members of the human family is the foundation of freedom, justice and peace in the world."*

Patriotism flows from the grace of a cultured heart, which obeys the Commandment, "Love your neighbor as yourself" (Mark 12:31). It's also prophetic. It prepares all people for a common destiny, to be citizens of Heaven "from every nation, tribe, race, and tongue..." (Revelation 7:9).

Join us as we gather to pray for an end to human trafficking in all its forms. The Mass will be said in memory of Barbara Amaya, who was herself a victim of human trafficking.

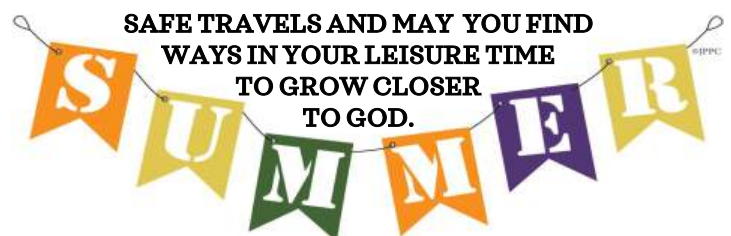
Mass will be followed by a reception in the Parish Hall.

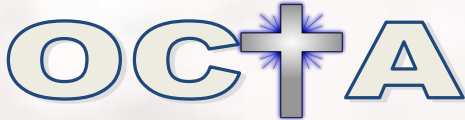

PATRIOTISMO

Reflexiones del Día de La Independencia

Los Estados Unidos es el único país de la historia fundado sobre un principio de derechos humanos "evidentes" e "inalienables". *"Sostenemos que estas verdades son evidentes por sí mismas, que todos los hombres son creados iguales, que son dotados por su Creador de ciertos derechos inalie-*

nables, entre los que se encuentran la vida, la libertad y la búsqueda de la felicidad". Esta línea del Preámbulo de la *Declaración de Independencia* es una de las más conocidas en lengua inglesa. Dicha línea proponía un pensamiento universal sobre la naturaleza humana y los derechos humanos. Este principio sirvió de base para otra "Declaración", la *Declaración Universal de los Derechos Humanos* de las Naciones Unidas (10 de diciembre de 1948). Su preámbulo comienza: *"Considerando que el reconocimiento de la dignidad inherente y de los derechos iguales e inalienables de todos los miembros de la familia humana es el fundamento de la libertad, la justicia y la paz en el mundo..."* Si reflexionamos sobre estos pasajes de las declaraciones de los Estados Unidos y la ONU, veremos el significado global del "patriotismo" estadounidense.

La palabra "Patriotismo" deriva del latín "patria", que significa "paternal". Por otra parte, somos llamado "humanos", lo que significa "de la tierra (tierra)". Por lo tanto, el "patriotismo" se trata de "humanos" que aman con gratitud a su patria y a su madre tierra (el mundo). Esto es un aspecto del Cuarto Mandamiento: "Honra a tu padre y a tu madre, el primer mandamiento con la promesa, para que te vaya bien y disfrutes de larga vida en la tierra" (Efesios 6:2-3).

Los patriotas aman a su patria. Y, por extensión, aman a todas las patrias porque aman a todas las personas que aman a su nación. Los patriotas reconocen los pecados ancestrales (todos los tienen) y celebran las virtudes ancestrales. Según Alexis de Tocqueville, el patriotismo viene de lo que él llama "costumbres", -"hábitos del corazón"- los cuales forman el carácter social de los humanos. Por ejemplo, las virtudes sociales de la buena vecindad y la justicia están arraigadas en este principio. Un verdadero patriota acepta en su mente y en su corazón, la universalidad de *"ciertos derechos inalienables, entre los que se encuentran la vida, la libertad y la búsqueda de la felicidad"* y *"la dignidad inherente y los derechos iguales e inalienables de todos los miembros de la familia humana es el fundamento de la libertad, la justicia y la paz en el mundo"*.

El patriotismo brota de la gracia de un corazón sabio, que obedece el mandamiento: "Ama a tu prójimo como a ti mismo" (Marcos 12:31). También es profético. Prepara a todos los pueblos para un destino común, para ser ciudadanos del Cielo "provenientes de toda nación, tribu, raza y lengua..." (Apocalipsis 7:9).

SUMMER COURSES

CALLED TO LOVE: THEOLOGY OF THE BODY

JULY 15-19, 2024

Students will examine John Paul II's "Catechesis on Human Love" through a close reading of the text and an exploration of the philosophical and biblical sources of his vision. The aim is to see the intimate connection of human love with its Divine Source, the Trinitarian God who is Love, and how the human being, in his entirety, images Him.

TWENTIETH-CENTURY CATHOLIC LITERATURE

JULY 22-26, 2024
