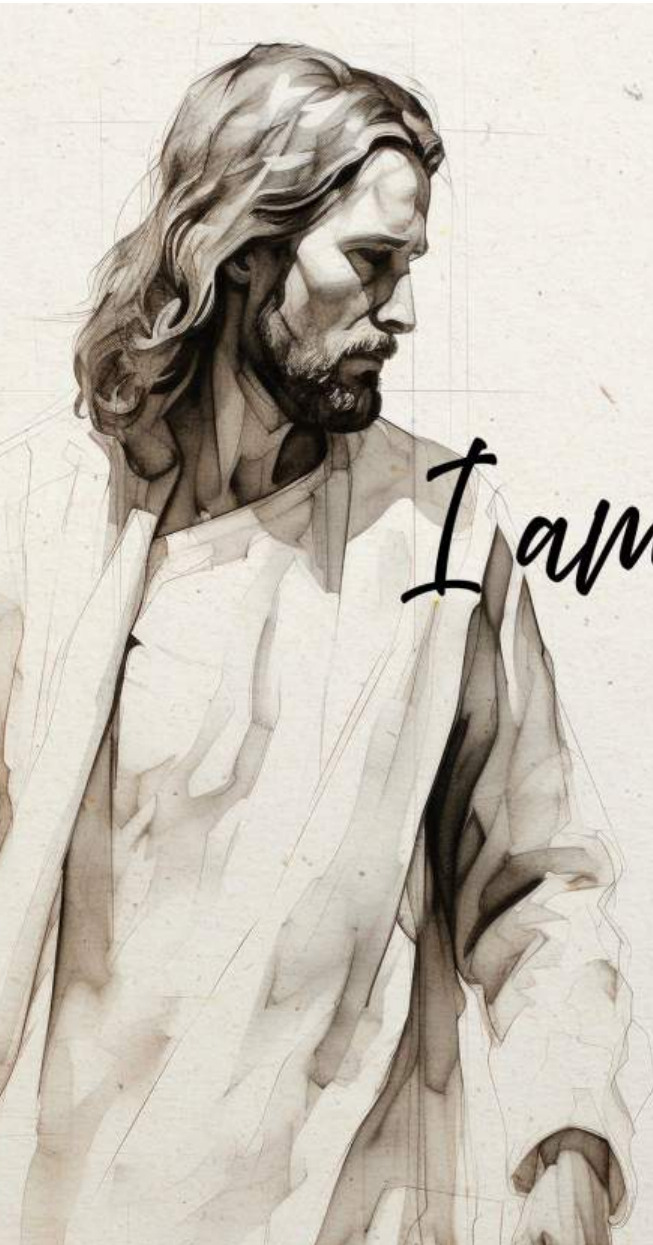

Improvisation

Reflections on Love Songs and Love

In the fall of 1971, my first-grade teacher asked the class if anyone knew a Halloween song. I stood up and improvised a song. I made up lyrics about ghosts and monsters, with no discernable melody or story line. Then, I sat down. Why did I do that? I don't know.

Love can be like that. Improvised, uncalculated, clumsy, and badly expressed. It is spontaneously inspired. We just know we love and want love, whatever that means. So, we just do it badly and don't know why, like a made-up Halloween song. Grade-B movies, ditties, and sappy poems express love badly. For example, take Terry Jack's 1974 hit song "Seasons in the Sun". The lyrics are awful. As bad as they get. But, when a guy with sideburns sings them to a pot-boiler tune, he makes ten-million girls cry. Love's impulse often lingers at the doorway of sentimentality. But sentimentality (like falling in love) is just that – a doorway. Love invites us to an adventure beyond the doorway, into life's inner rooms.

Philosopher Josef Pieper defined love as an affirmation that, "*it is good you exist for me.*" Pieper highlights two terms: "*exist*" and "*for me*". Start with "*exist*". Created existence comes from an Uncreated Existence we call "God". God created us through, with, and in his "Love". We love because we exist through Love. We can't help it. It just is.

Now consider, "*for me*". Human love cannot be ego-free. Jesus said, "Love your neighbor *as yourself*" (Mark 12:31). There must be some "*as yourself*" in it. Unlike God, we are needy because we are created. Therefore, human love improvises a game of *tug-and-pull* between *love-of-neighbor* and *love-of-self*. We become more like Christ when, in his grace, we overcome ourselves to love others more. Love becomes a sacrifice. With the Holy Spirit's help, we plunge into Christ's command: "*As I have loved you, so you also should love one another*" (John 13: 34). Sacrifice is implied. Through the Spirit's Gifts, love's improvisation rises to another level. It becomes chaste, generous, and willing to sacrifice for the good of someone else. Love says, "Consider someone else, beside yourself." "*As I have loved you...*" (John 13: 34).

Improvisación

Reflexiones sobre las canciones de amor y el amor

En el otoño de 1971, mi maestra de primer grado le preguntó a la clase si alguien conocía una canción de Halloween. Me puse de pie y empecé a improvisar una canción. Inventé letras sobre fantasmas y monstruos, sin melodía discernible ni lógica en la historia. Al terminar, me senté. ¿Por qué lo hice? No lo sé.

El amor puede ser así. Improvisado, sin cálculo, torpe y mal expresado. Es de inspiración espontánea. Solo sabemos que amamos y que queremos ser amados, sea lo que sea que eso signifique. Por lo tanto, lo hacemos mal y no sabemos por qué, de la misma manera que con una canción inventada de Halloween. Así también, las películas de clase B, las cancioncillas y los poemas cursis expresan mal el amor. Por ejemplo, tomemos el éxito de Terry Jack de 1974 "Seasons in the Sun". La letra es terrible. Pero, cuando un chico atractivo las canta con una melodía cautivante, hace llorar a diez millones de chicas. El impulso del amor a menudo se detiene en la puerta del sentimentalismo. Pero el sentimentalismo (como enamorarse) es solo eso: una puerta. El amor nos invita a una aventura más allá de la puerta, a las áreas interiores de la vida.

El filósofo alemán Josef Pieper definió que el amor a algo o a alguien significa afirmarle que "*es bueno que existas, que estes en el mundo para mí*". En esta definición, Pieper destaca dos términos: "*existir*" y "*para mí*". Empecemos con "*existir*". La existencia creada proviene de una Existencia No-Creada que llamamos "Dios". Dios nos creó a través de, con y en su "Amor". Amamos porque existimos a través del Amor. Es inevitable. Simplemente, lo es.

Ahora consideremos, el "*para mí*". El amor humano no puede estar libre de ego. Jesús dijo: "Ama a tu prójimo como a ti mismo" (Marcos 12:31). A diferencia de Dios, nosotros somos seres necesitados porque hemos sido creados. Por lo tanto, el amor humano improvisa una contienda entre *el amor al prójimo* y *el amor a sí mismo*. Nos volvemos más como Cristo cuando, en su gracia, nos superamos para amar más a los demás. El amor se convierte en un sacrificio. Con la ayuda del Espíritu Santo, nos sumergimos en el mandato de Cristo: "*Así como yo los he amado, así ámense también ustedes los unos a los otros*" (Jn 13, 34). El sacrificio está implícito. A través de los dones del Espíritu, la improvisación del amor se eleva a otro nivel. Se vuelve casto, generoso y dispuesto a sacrificarse por el bien de otra persona. El amor nos dice: "Considera a alguien más, mas allá de ti mismo". "*Así como yo los he amado...*" (Juan 13:34).
