

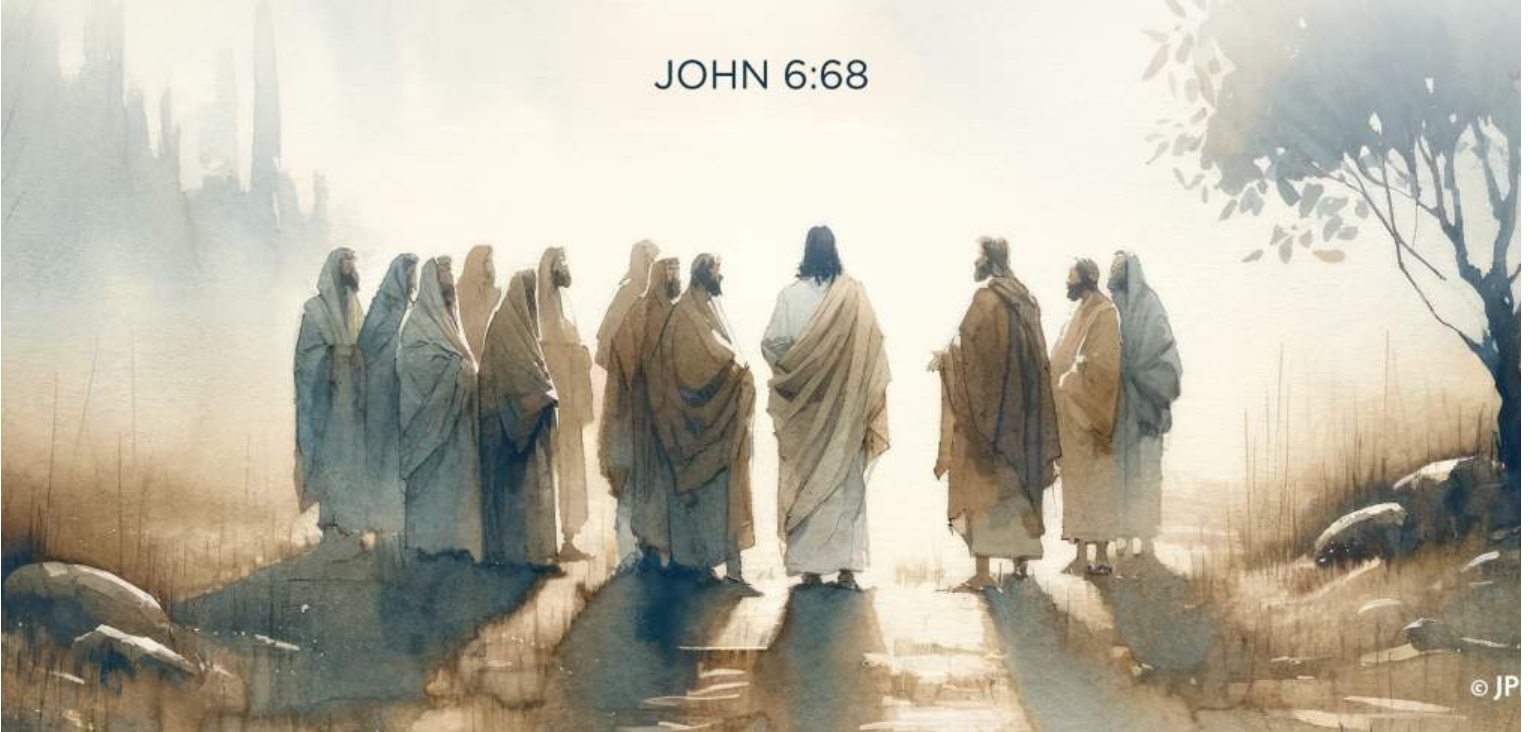

Our Daily Bread

We say it in the “Our Father”
What does it mean? We don’t know

Catholic voices on the questions

“Our daily bread” occurs in the middle of the “Our Father”: “Our daily bread” is a translation from the original Greek word, *ἐπιούσιον* (*epiousion*). As far as we know, the word exists nowhere else in Greek. Nobody knows what it means. Some have translated it as “supersubstantial bread.” We translate it “our daily bread.” Perhaps it really means something like, “the bread we can’t wrap our minds around” or “what-the-heck-is-it bread.”

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tackles the question: “Daily” (*epiousios*) occurs nowhere else in the New Testament. Taken in a temporal sense, this word is a pedagogical repetition of “this day,” to confirm us in trust “without reservation.” Taken in the qualitative sense, it signifies what is necessary for life, and more broadly every good thing sufficient for subsistence. Taken literally (*epiousios*: “super-essential”), it refers directly to the Bread of Life, the Body of Christ, the “medicine of immortality,” without which we have no life within us. Finally in this connection, its heavenly meaning is evident: “this day” is the Day of the Lord, the day of the feast of the kingdom, anticipated in the Eucharist that is already the foretaste of the kingdom to come. For this reason, it is fitting for the Eucharistic liturgy to be celebrated each day. (CCC 2837)

St. Augustine took a crack at it: The Eucharist is our daily bread. The power belonging to this divine food makes it a bond of union. Its effect is then understood as unity, so that, gathered into his Body and made members of him, we may become what we receive.... This also is our daily bread: the readings you hear each day in church and the hymns you hear and sing. All these are necessities for our pilgrimage.

St. Thomas Aquinas goes theologically deep: Thus Christ, the true bread, gives life to the world by reason of his divinity; and he descends from heaven by reason of his human nature...he came down from heaven by assuming human nature: ‘He emptied himself, taking the form of a servant. (Commentary on *The Gospel of John*).

What do you think? Contemplate the question. Ask the Holy Spirit for the Gift of Understanding, to give you insight into this sacred Mystery.

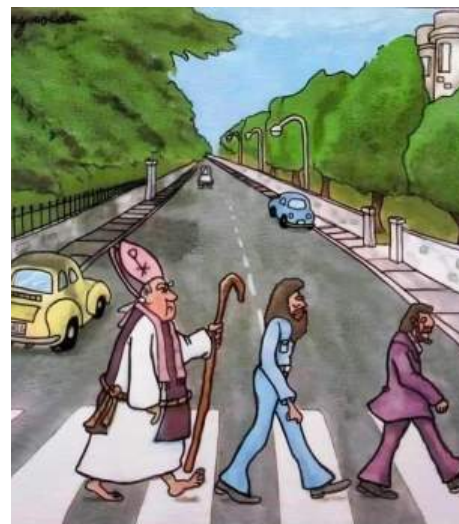

Nuestro “Pan de cada día”

Lo decimos en el “Padre Nuestro”
¿Que significa? No sabemos

Catholic voices on the questions

“Nuestro pan de cada día” ocurre en medio del “Padre Nuestro”: “Nuestro pan de cada día” es una traducción de la palabra griega original, *ἐπιούσιον* (*epiousion*). Hasta donde sabemos, la palabra no existe en ningún otro lugar en la lengua griega. Nadie sabe lo que significa. Algunos la han traducido como “pan supersustancial”. Nosotros la traducimos como “el pan nuestro de cada día”. O tal vez signifique realmente algo como “el pan que no podemos entender” o “ni idea que pan es”.

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica aborda la pregunta: “*Diario*” (*epiousios*) no aparece en ninguna otra parte del Nuevo Testamento. Tomada en un sentido temporal, esta palabra es una repetición pedagógica de “este día”, que nos confirma con certeza el “sin reservas”. En el sentido cualitativo, “*Diario*” significa lo que es necesario para la vida y, más ampliamente, todo lo bueno que es suficiente para subsistir. Tomado literalmente (*epi-ousios*: “super-esencial”), se refiere directamente al Pan de Vida, el Cuerpo de Cristo, la “medicina de la inmortalidad”, sin la cual no tenemos vida dentro de nosotros. Y en esta última conexión, su significado celestial es evidente: “hoy” es el día del Señor, el día de la fiesta del reino, anticipada en la Eucaristía que es ya el anuncio del reino venidero. Por esta razón, es oportuno que la liturgia eucarística se celebre cada día. (CIC 2837)

San Agustín se atrevió a definirlo: la Eucaristía es el pan nuestro de cada día. El poder que tiene este alimento divino lo convierte en un lazo de unión. Su efecto es lo que entendemos como unidad, para que, reunidos en su Cuerpo y hechos miembros de él, lleguemos a ser lo que recibimos... Este es también nuestro pan de cada día: las lecturas que escuchas cada día en la iglesia y los himnos que escuchas y cantas. Todas estas son necesidades en nuestra peregrinación.

Santo Tomás de Aquino profundiza teológicamente: Cristo, el verdadero pan, da la vida al mundo por razón de su divinidad; y desciende del cielo por razón de su naturaleza humana... bajó del cielo asumiendo la naturaleza humana: “Se despojó a sí mismo, tomando la condición de servidor”. (*Comentario del Evangelio de Juan*).

¿Qué piensas de todo esto? Contempla la pregunta. Pide al Espíritu Santo el Don de la Comprensión, para que te dé entendimiento en este sagrado Misterio.

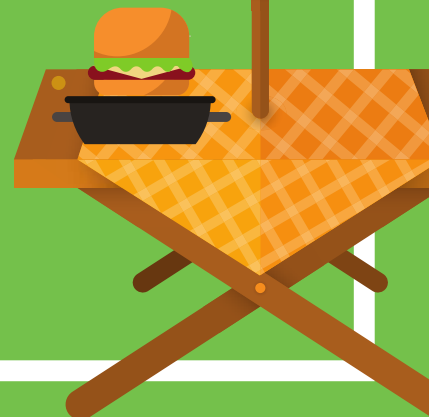
