Back to School

Back to school. Fresh starts can be apprehensively fun, like the first day of climbing Mount Everest. For new kids on the block, school's first day can be daunting. In any event, come mid-October, it'll be a grind.

A school is a river with a strong current. Jump in, and you perilously maneuver. The river's end is out of sight. There's little time to ponder the destination. Survival matters.

Some advice: Occasionally, take a break and swim ashore. Sit down on the river's bank, dripping wet. Catch your breath and think about where the river is taking you.

School's river empties into a vast, wide ocean of rough seas. The world. You're destined to swim that ocean for life. But there's a sunrise on its horizon.

Sailing into that seascape, graduates often think they are the generation that will change the world. Perhaps. If so, it'll be in ways unforeseen. Prophets rarely understand their prophecies. The future's only certainty is its uncertainty. One's navigation is influenced, but not determined, by the river's lessons. So, swim to shore every now and then, and reflect on what you're doing. And ponder the eastern sunrise.

Jesus did this with his Apostles. "Come away by yourselves to a secluded place and rest a while" (Mark 6:31). Escape the fray and ask, "What am I doing?" "Where am I going?" "What is this all about?" Conceive no quick answers. Leave some questions open-ended. Openness to the mysterious sunrise is meditation. It grants Wisdom. Mysticism opens our minds and hearts to God's Wisdom.

Steeped in wisdom, humans pass through visible realities to those which are unseen. Our era needs such wisdom more than bygone ages if human discoveries are to be further humanized. For the future of the world stands in peril unless wiser people are forthcoming... It is, finally, through the gift of the Holy Spirit that humans come by faith to the contemplation and appreciation of the divine plan (Second Vatican Council, *Pastoral Constitution of the Church in the Modern World*, 15).

Contemplation is an openness to Wisdom – and perhaps an encounter. It is mystical prayer, a work of the Holy Spirit. It's God's delightful invasion of your whole person. It produces Love. Wisdom will "mix her wine" (Proverbs 9:2) and show you God's Love and Light – and your destiny.

Vuelta a la escuela

Vuelta a al escuela. Los nuevos comienzos pueden ser divertidos pero también preocupantes, como el primer día de una expedición al Monte Everest. Para los nuevos niños, el primer día de escuela puede ser desalentador. Para mediados de octubre, lo mas seguro, será una rutina.

Una escuela es un río con una fuerte corriente. Salta en ella, y tendrás que maniobrar peligrosamente. La desembocadura del río está fuera de vista. Hay poco tiempo para reflexionar sobre el destino. La supervivencia es lo que importa.

Algunos consejos: De vez en cuando, tómate un descanso y nada hasta la orilla. Siéntate en la orilla del río, empapado. Recupera el aliento y piensa a dónde te lleva el río.

El río de la escuela desemboca en un vasto y ancho océano de mares agitados. Es el mundo. Estás destinado a nadar ese océano de por vida. Pero hay un amanecer en su horizonte.

Navegando en estos mares, los graduados a menudo piensan que son la generación que cambiará el mundo. Quizás. Si es así, será de maneras inesperadas. Los profetas raramente entienden sus propias profecías. La única certeza del futuro es su incertidumbre. El aprender a navegar está influenciado, pero no determinado, por las lecciones que enseña el río. Por lo tanto, toma tiempo de vez en cuando para nadar hacia la orilla y reflexiona sobre lo que estás haciendo. Reflexiona sobre la puesta del sol en el poniente.

Jesús hizo esto con sus apóstoles. "Vengan ustedes solos a un lugar desierto, para descansar un poco" (Marcos 6:31). Escapa de la bulla y pregúntate: "¿Qué estoy haciendo?" — ¿A dónde voy? — ¿Qué significa todo esto? No busques respuestas rápidas. Deja algunas preguntas abiertas. El abrir tu mente al misterio de un nuevo amanecer es meditación, Esto otorga Sabiduría. El misticismo abre nuestras mentes y corazones a la Sabiduría de Dios.

Impregnados de sabiduría, los seres humanos pasan de las realidades visibles a aquellas que no se ven. Nuestros tiempos necesitan esa sabiduría más que las épocas pasadas para que los descubrimientos humanos se humanicen aún más. Porque el futuro del mundo está en peligro a menos que existan mas personas sabias ... Es, finalmente, a través del don del Espíritu Santo que los hombres llegan por la fe a la contemplación y al aprecio del diseño divino (Concilio Vaticano II, Constitución pastoral de la Iglesia en el mundo contemporáneo, 15).

La contemplación es una puerta a la Sabiduría, y tal vez un encuentro. Es una oración mística, una obra del Espíritu Santo. Es la maravillosa presencia de Dios en toda tu persona. Produce Amor. La sabiduría "mezclará su vino" (Proverbios 9:2) y te mostrará el Amor y la Luz de Dios, y tu destino.
