Knowing Jesus

Jesus asked, "Who do people say that I am?" The Apostles gave opinions. "Some say John the Baptist." "Some say Elijah." "Others say one of the prophets." But Jesus is not an opinion. He's a person. So, he got personal. He asked, "Who do **you** say that I am?"

"Right is right when nobody is right, and wrong is wrong when everybody is wrong," said G.K. Chesterton. Peter got it right, personally: "**You** are the Christ." Ever since, the Church proposes personal fidelity to Peter, the Pope. Fidelity to Peter is another way of saying, "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God." It's personal. It starts a friendship.

Step one: Confess sins. We must reject the manifold death of lying, perjury, cheating, detraction, slander, gossip, backbiting, cruelty, greed, wrath, vengeance, manipulation, envy, unchastity, adultery, drunkenness, and picking-and-choosing which morals apply to us and which don't. Friends don't let friends do these things.

Step two: Cultivate virtues, habits of doing the good: Prudence, Justice, Self-Control, and Courage. "Blessed are the pure of heart, for they shall see God" (Matthew 5:8). They're key to friendship.

Step three: Cultivate a personal relationship with Jesus Christ through prayer and meditation on God's Word. "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God" (Deuteronomy 8:3).

Jesus prayed often, in solitude, to speak with his Father. "I will beckon you to the wilderness and speak tenderly to your heart" (Hosea 2:14). Jesus' heart-to-hearts with his Father provoked a disciple to ask, "Teach us how to pray" (Luke 11:1).

St. Therese of Lisieux said, "For me, prayer is a surge of the heart; it is a simple look turned toward heaven, it is a cry of recognition and of love, embracing both trial and joy." This little, if only brief, "surge of the heart" is greater than all the good works. Prayer is Love's supreme act. "If I give away everything I own, and if I hand my body over so that I may boast but do not have love, I gain nothing" (1 Corinthians 13:3).

St. Therese wrote, "I understood that the Church had a Heart and that this Heart was BURNING WITH LOVE." "Yes," she said, "I have found my place in the Church and it **is You, O my God...**"

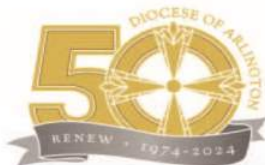

Conociendo a Jesús

Jesús preguntó: "¿Quién dice la gente que soy yo?" Los Apóstoles dieron sus opiniones. "Algunos dicen que eres Juan el Bautista". "Algunos dicen que eres Elías". "Otros dicen que alguno de los profetas". Pero Jesús no es una opinión. Es una persona. Así que El lo tomo mas personal y les preguntó: Y ustedes "¿quién **dicen** que soy yo?"

"Lo correcto es lo correcto, aunque no lo haga nadie, y lo incorrecto es incorrecto, aunque todo el mundo se equivoque al respecto", dijo G.K. Chesterton. El apóstol Pedro acertó al afirmar: "**Tú eres** el Cristo". Desde entonces, la Iglesia propone una fidelidad personal a Pedro, el Papa. La fidelidad a Pedro es otra forma de decir: "Tú eres el Cristo, el Hijo del Dios vivo". Esta afirmación es personal. Da comienzo a una amistad.

Primer paso: Confesar los pecados. Debemos rechazar la impiedad múltiple de la mentira, el perjurio, el engaño, la detracción, la calumnia, el chisme, la murmuración, la crueldad, la codicia, la ira, la venganza, la manipulación, la envidia, la falta de castidad, el adulterio, la embriaguez y la elección de qué moral se aplica a nosotros y cuál no. Los amigos no dejan que sus amigos hagan estas cosas.

Segundo paso: Cultivar virtudes, hábitos de hacer el bien: Prudencia, Justicia, Autocontrol y Coraje. "Bienaventurados los limpios de corazón, porque ellos verán a Dios" (Mateo 5:8). Esta es la clave de la amistad con Jesús.

Tercer Paso: Cultivar una relación personal con Jesucristo a través de la oración y la meditación en la Palabra de Dios. "No solo de pan vivirá el hombre, sino de toda palabra que sale de la boca de Dios" (Deuteronomio 8:3).

Jesús rezaba a menudo, en soledad, para hablar con su Padre. "Te haré señas para que vengas al desierto y hablaré tiernamente a tu corazón" (Oseas 2:14). La conversación sincera de Jesús con su Padre provocó que un discípulo le preguntara: "Enséñanos a orar" (Lucas 11:1).

Santa Teresa de Lisieux dijo: "Para mí, la oración es un impulso del corazón; una sencilla mirada dirigida al cielo, un grito de reconocimiento y de amor, desde dentro de la prueba como desde dentro de la alegría". Este corto impulso, aunque breve, es más grande que todas las buenas obras. La oración es el acto supremo del Amor: "Si doy todo lo que tengo, y si entregara mi cuerpo a las llamas, pero no tengo amor, no me sirve para nada" (1 Corintios 13:3).

Santa Teresa escribió: "Comprendí que la Iglesia tenía un Corazón y que este Corazón estaba ARDIENDO DE AMOR". "Sí", dijo ella, "he encontrado mi lugar en la Iglesia y **eres Tú, oh mi Dios...**"

Reflexión de la Semana

“Si alguien quiere ser mi discípulo, que se niegue a sí mismo, tome su cruz y me siga.” Marcos 8:34

Vivir un estilo de vida de corresponsabilidad significa que no solo seré responsable por mi propia vida, sino también de la vida de los demás.
