Heaven's Playful Innocence

In today's Gospel, Jesus says, "If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all." Putting his arm around a child, he says, "Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me."

Jesus is teaching us about "spiritual childhood" – what St. Therese of Lisieux calls "the little way." It means a return to innocence and simplicity. God first revealed his Son to us as a child. He did not come in royal power and authority nor with an air of self-importance – but in vulnerable innocence.

The child Jesus suggests something about Heaven: playfulness. This is contrary to the Evil One, who tempts us to proudly take ourselves too seriously. The Holy Spirit, on the other hand, lightens our load, making us freer and more playful. A sense of humor is the fruit of innocence. However, playful innocence requires protection, like a fence around the playground, which is role of the Church's moral teachings.

The spiritual life is a journey back to childhood, not to be confused with childishness. For the spiritual life is all about the *purification of the heart*, that is, a *return to* and the *discovery of* the innocence of our Baptism. Spiritual childhood is an aspect of Heaven: a free and playful way of life without fear.

St. Therese wrote this poem about Heaven to God:

***So I can enjoy in Heaven your sweet presence
I will practice all the virtues of childhood
Did you not say:
"Heaven is for the child."***

She also wrote another prophetic poem about Heaven:

***My heaven is to remain forever in His presence,
To call Him my Father and to be his Child.
In His divine arms, I do not fear the storm.
Total abandonment, that alone is my law.***

Jesus said, "Whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it" (Matthew 16:25). And the Blessed Mother said: "God has cast down the might from their thrones but has lifted up the lowly" (Luke 1:52). This is the Way that is the *Person of Jesus Christ*. And this is a prophetic message of the Church today, whose great example is St. Therese. Her feast day is on October 1.

La inocencia alegre del cielo

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús dice: "Si alguno quiere ser el primero, que sea el último de todos y el servidor de todos". Poniendo su brazo alrededor de un niño, Jesús declara: "El que recibe a un niño como este en mi nombre, a mí me recibe".

Jesús nos está enseñando sobre la "infancia espiritual", lo que Santa Teresa de Lisieux llama el "caminito". Significa un retorno a la inocencia y a la sencillez. Dios nos reveló a su Hijo por primera vez como un niño. No llegó con poder o autoridad real ni con un aire de presunción, sino con una inocencia vulnerable.

El niño Jesús apunta a lo que existe en el Cielo: alegría. Esto es contrario a lo que propone el Maligno, que nos tienta a tomarnos a nosotros mismos demasiado en serio. El Espíritu Santo, en cambio, aligera nuestra carga, haciéndonos más libres y alegres. El sentido del humor es fruto de la inocencia. Sin embargo, la inocencia animada requiere protección como una valla alrededor del patio de recreo, el cual es el papel de las enseñanzas morales de la Iglesia.

La vida espiritual es un viaje de vuelta a la infancia, que no debe confundirse con el infantilismo. Porque la vida espiritual tiene que ver con la *purificación del corazón*, es decir, *con el retorno* y el *descubrimiento* de la inocencia de nuestro Bautismo. La infancia espiritual es un aspecto del Cielo: una forma de vida libre y alegre sin miedo.

Santa Teresita escribió a Dios este poema sobre el Cielo:

***Para que pueda disfrutar en el Cielo de tu dulce presencia
Practicaré todas las virtudes de la infancia***

***¿No dijiste:
"El cielo es para el niño"?***

También escribió otro poema profético sobre el Cielo:

***Mi cielo es permanecer en su presencia divina,
Llamarlo Padre mío, y ser y sentirme su hija.
En sus divinos brazos, no temo la tormenta.
¡Es toda y mi sola ley el abandono completo!***

Jesús dijo: "El que quiera salvar su vida, la perderá; y el que pierda su vida a causa de mí, la encontrará" (Mateo 16:25). La Santísima Virgen dijo: "Dios derribó a los poderosos de sus tronos, y elevó a los humildes" (Lucas 1:52). Este es el Camino que es la *Persona de Jesucristo*. Y este es un mensaje profético de la Iglesia de hoy, cuyo gran ejemplo es Santa Teresita. Su fiesta es el 1 de octubre.
