

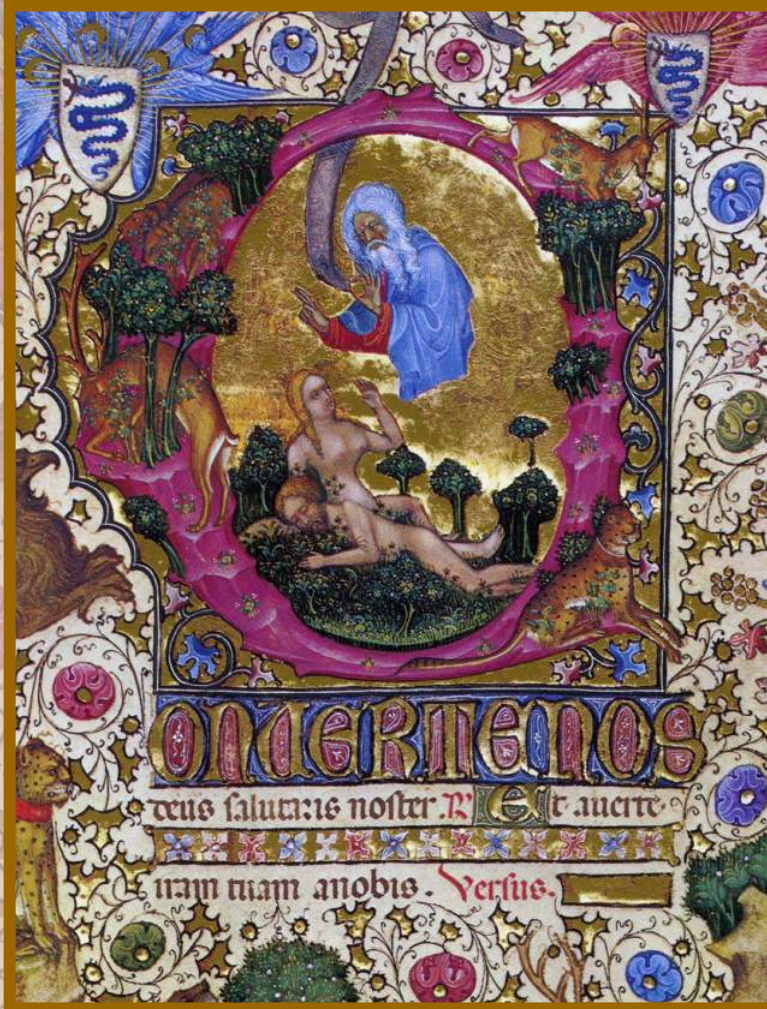

Love's Sacred Order

In *Genesis 1*, Earth evolves into full beauty on Day Five. Man and Woman – God's embodied Sacraments – are created on Day Six. On Day Seven, God contemplates this mysterious offspring of his thought. Man and Woman are the Masterpieces of Paradise. Together, they are God's "image and likeness" (Genesis 1:26) and fruitfully perfect Creation. They are intelligent and life-giving. Their love flowers in children, multiplying God's human Sacraments (Genesis 1:28).

In *Genesis 2*, God made Man from mud, into muscle and blood. God breathes spirit into Man's muscle and blood. He's now matter and spirit, body and soul. Unique and alone in Creation. Animals come next, but they're not suitable partners. So, God creates Woman – an equal, though different. Like the Man, Woman is intelligent and free.

In *Genesis 2*, Woman is Creation's finishing touch and perfection. Adam takes note. "This one is bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh" (Genesis 2:23). "That is why a man leaves his father and mother and clings to his wife, and two of them become one flesh" (Genesis 2:24). Creation is further perfected by the *union* Man and Woman in a life-giving bond called "marriage."

In today's Gospel, Jesus says marriage is an indissoluble bond "from the beginning". St. Paul says marriage signifies the union between Christ the "Bridegroom" and his "Bride", the Church. Heaven is a "Wedding Feast" (Revelation 19:6-9). Saints say holiness is a "nuptial union" with God.

Marriage is the world's most ancient institution. It is civilization's foundation, where children learn the lessons of life, love, and society. Marriage is irreplaceable. The human sex instinct ultimately builds civilization. It's an instinct that builds institutions.

All are called to holiness, married or not. But friendship is for everyone. Friendship foretells the Heavenly City (Revelation 21). It's key to happiness. Marriage builds on friendship and thrives in friendship. Marriage and friendship comprise God's *sacred order* of love.

On life's perilous journey – a long and winding road – open your heart to the Holy Spirit's purifying love. Learning to love is like learning to walk. We fall often before walking. We misstep before loving with confidence. That's life. But with God's grace and the Sacrament of Reconciliation, love is purified. For many, it takes a lifetime: "Blessed are the pure of heart, they shall see God" (Matthew 5:8).

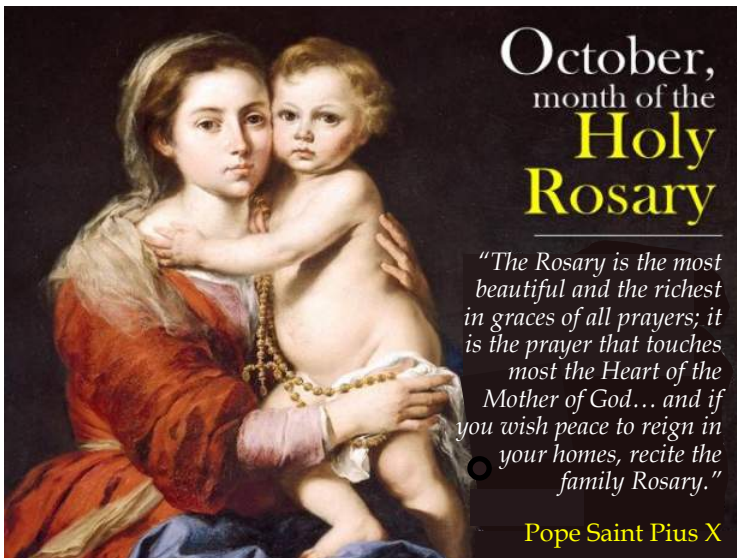

El Orden Sagrado del Amor

En *Génesis 1*, la Tierra evoluciona hacia la belleza completa en el Quinto Día. El Hombre y la Mujer, los Sacramentos encarnados de Dios, son creados en el Sexto Día. En el Séptimo día, Dios contempla a este misterioso producto de su pensamiento. El hombre y la mujer son las obras maestras del Paraíso. Juntos, son la "imagen y semejanza" de Dios (*Génesis 1:26*) y la Creación fructífera perfecta. Ambos son inteligentes y dadores de vida. Su amor florece en los hijos, multiplicándose así los sacramentos humanos de Dios (*Génesis 1:28*).

En *Génesis 2*, Dios hizo al hombre, músculo y sangre, de lodo. Dios sopla espíritu en los músculos y en la sangre del hombre. Así el hombre pasa a ser materia y espíritu, cuerpo y alma. Único y solo en la Creación. Los animales son creados después, pero no son compañeros adecuados. Por lo tanto, Dios crea a la Mujer, una igual, pero diferente. Al igual que el Hombre, la Mujer es inteligente y libre.

En *Génesis 2*, la Mujer es el toque final y la perfección de la Creación. Adán refleja. "Éste es hueso de mis huesos, y carne de mi carne" (*Génesis 2:23*). "Por eso el hombre deja a su padre y a su madre y se une a su mujer, y los dos llegan a ser una sola carne" (*Génesis 2:24*). La creación se perfecciona aún más con la *unión del* Hombre y la Mujer en un vínculo dador de vida llamado "matrimonio".

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús dice que el matrimonio ha sido "desde el principio" un vínculo indisoluble. San Pablo dice que el matrimonio significa la unión entre Cristo, el "Esposo", y su "Esposa", la Iglesia. El cielo es un "banquete de bodas" (*Apocalipsis 19:6-9*). Los santos dicen que la santidad es una "unión nupcial" con Dios.

El matrimonio es la institución más antigua del mundo. Es la base de la civilización, donde los hijos aprenden las lecciones de la vida, el amor y la sociedad. El matrimonio es insustituible. El instinto sexual humano produce la civilización. Es un instinto que construye instituciones.

Todos estamos llamados a la santidad, casados o no. Pero la amistad es para todos. La amistad predice la Ciudad Celestial (*Apocalipsis 21*). Es la clave de la felicidad. El matrimonio se basa en la amistad y prospera en la amistad. El matrimonio y la amistad comprenden el *sagrado orden* del amor de Dios.

En el camino largo y sinuoso de la vida, abre tu corazón al amor purificador del Espíritu Santo. Aprender a amar es como aprender a caminar. A menudo nos caemos antes de caminar. Damos pasos en falso antes de amar con confianza. Así es la vida. Pero con la gracia de Dios y el Sacramento de la Reconciliación, el amor se purifica.
