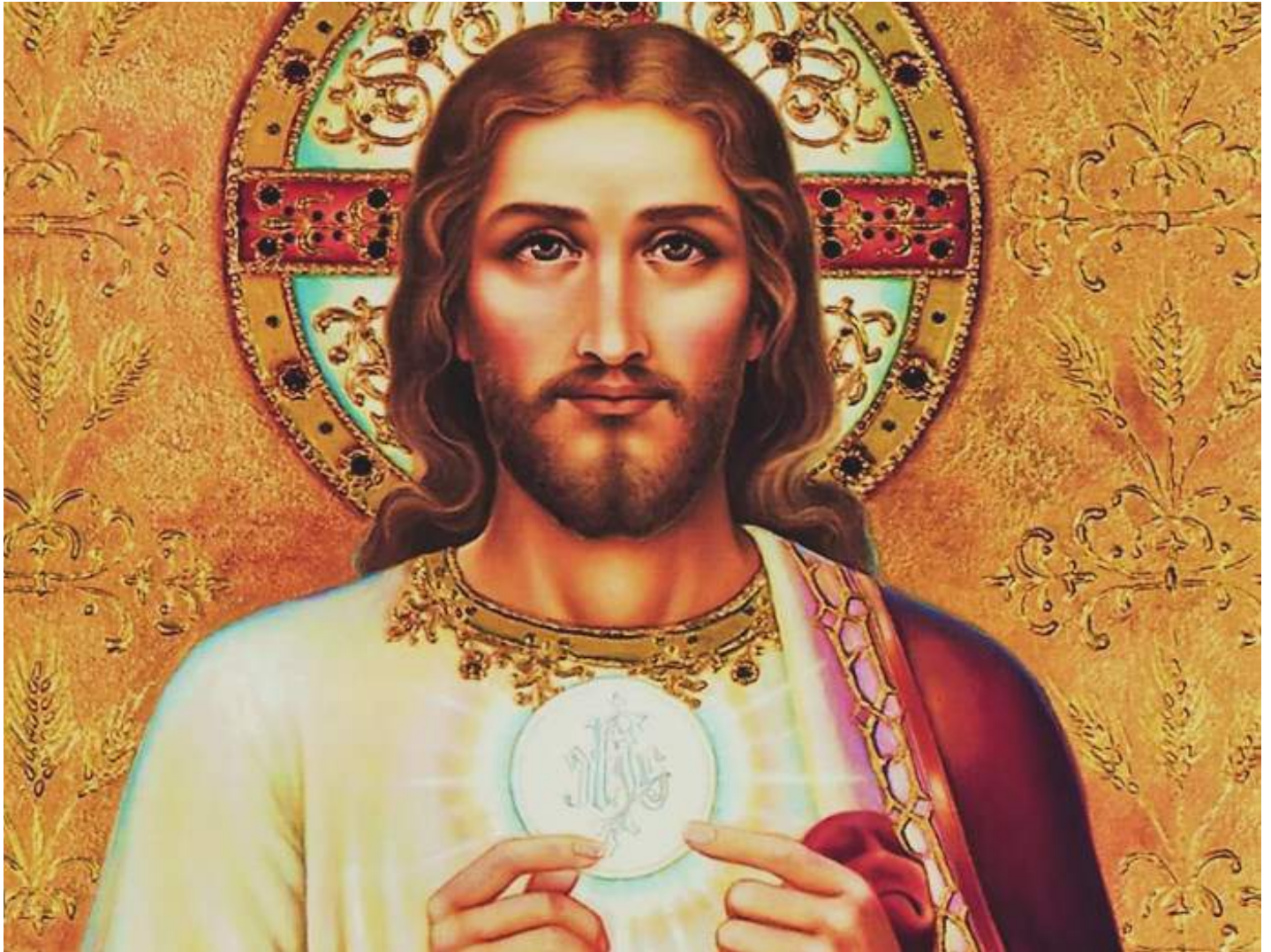

# Following Christ

**“There are two ways, the one of life, the other of death; But between the two, there is a great difference.”  
(Didache—Teaching of the Twelve Apostles, 60 AD)**

The young man in today’s Gospel wanted to know the Way to Life. “Good master, what good work shall I do to have eternal life?” Jesus looked at the young man and loved him. Jesus gave him only one answer: “Follow me.” The young man left sad because he was wealthy. He may have changed his mind later, but we’re not told.

What are the “possessions” that make us “go away sad?” Material possessions? Lifestyles? Resentments? Memories? Political opinions? Possibilities abound.

I offer you some wisdom about detachment from the world by Pope Saint John Paul II in his great 1993 encyclical letter, “*The Splendor of Truth*” (*Veritatis Splendor*).

**“Then someone came to him...” In the young man, whom Matthew’s Gospel does not name, we can recognize every person who, consciously or not, approaches Christ the Redeemer of man and questions him about morality. For the young man, the question is not so much about rules to be followed, but about the full meaning of life. This is in fact the aspiration at the heart of every human decision and action, the quiet searching and interior prompting which sets freedom in motion. This question is ultimately an appeal to the absolute Good which attracts us and beckons us; it is the echo of a call from God who is the origin and goal of man’s life... In order to make this “encounter” with Christ possible, God willed his Church. Indeed, the Church “wishes to serve this single end: that each person may be able to find Christ, in order that Christ may walk with each person the path of life.” (St. John Paul II, *The Splendor of Truth*, 7)**

**“The question which the rich young man puts to Jesus of Nazareth is one which rises from the depths of his heart. It is an essential and unavoidable question for the life of every man, for it is about the moral good which must be done, and about eternal life. The young man senses that there is a connection between moral good and the fulfillment of his own destiny.” (The Splendor of Truth, 8)**

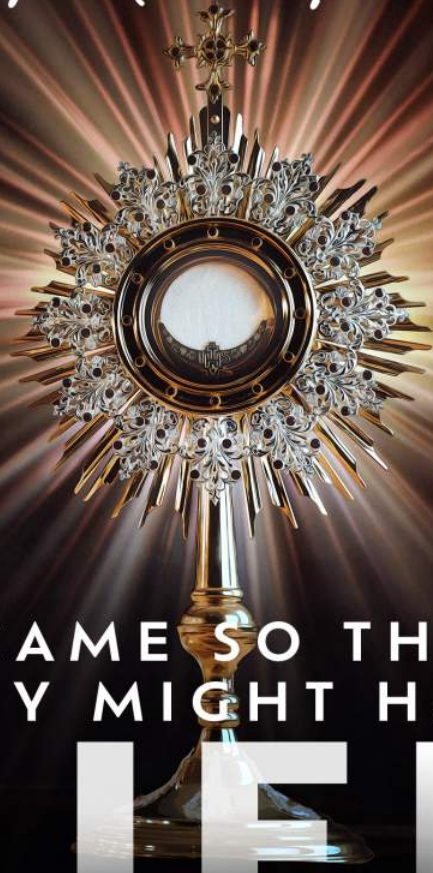

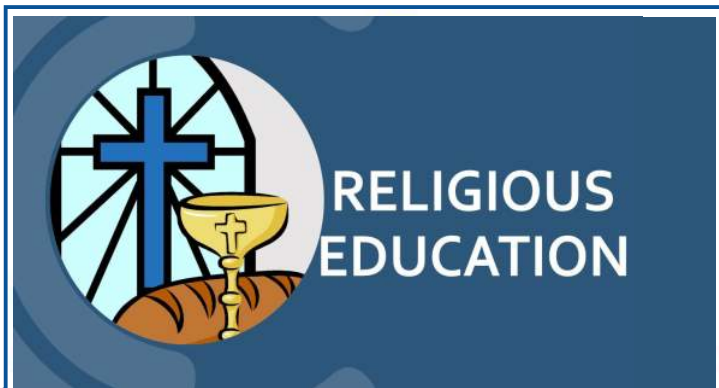

**AROUND THE DIOCESE**



Every October, the Church in the US. Celebrates Respect Life Month. We are asked to reflect on the gift of every human life and how to build a culture that protects life from conception to natural death. The following are the remarks from Bishop Burbidge's statement issued in his role as Chair of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) Pro-Life Activities Committee:

**I invite all Catholics to join me in a concerted effort of prayer between now and our national elections, by daily praying our Respect Life Month "Prayers for Life to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament":**

*"Jesus, you came that we might have life—and have it in abundance. Together with the Father and the Holy Spirit, you form us in our mothers' wombs and call us to love you for all eternity. As your most precious gift of human life is attacked, draw us ever closer to your Real Presence in the Eucharist. Dispel the darkness of the culture of death, for you are the light that shines in the darkness, and the darkness cannot overcome it. By the power of your Eucharistic Presence, help us to defend the life of every human person at every stage. Transform our hearts to protect and cherish all whose lives are most vulnerable. For you are God, forever and ever. Amen."*

## Siguiendo a Cristo

**"Hay dos caminos, uno de la vida, el otro de la muerte; pero entre los dos hay una gran diferencia".**

**(Didaché – Enseñanza de los Doce Apóstoles, 60 d.C.)**

El joven del Evangelio de hoy quería conocer el Camino a la Vida Eterna. "Buen maestro, ¿qué he de hacer de bueno para conseguir la vida eterna?" Jesús miró al joven y con mucho amor le dio una sola respuesta: "Sígueme". El joven se fue triste porque era rico. Es posible que haya cambiado de opinión más tarde, pero el Evangelio no lo dice.

¿Cuáles son las "posesiones" que nos hacen "irnos tristes"? ¿Posesiones materiales? ¿Estilos de vida? ¿Resentimientos? ¿Recuerdos? ¿Opiniones políticas? Las posibilidades abundan.

Les ofrezco un poco de sabiduría sobre el desapego del mundo por parte del Papa San Juan Pablo II en su gran carta encíclica de 1993, "El esplendor de la Verdad" (*Veritatis splendor*).

**«Se le acercó uno...». En el joven, que el evangelio de Mateo no nombra, podemos reconocer a todo hombre que, conscientemente o no, se acerca a Cristo, redentor del hombre, y le formula la pregunta moral. Para el joven, más que una pregunta sobre las reglas que hay que observar, es una pregunta de pleno significado para la vida. En efecto, ésta es la aspiración central de toda decisión y de toda acción humana, la búsqueda secreta y el impulso íntimo que mueve la libertad. Esta pregunta es, en última instancia, un llamamiento al Bien absoluto que nos atrae y nos llama hacia sí; es el eco de la llamada de Dios, origen y fin de la vida del hombre. Precisamente con esta perspectiva, el concilio Vaticano II ha invitado a perfeccionar la teología moral, de manera que su exposición ponga de relieve la altísima vocación que los fieles han recibido en Cristo, única respuesta que satisface plenamente el anhelo del corazón humano.**

**Para que los hombres puedan realizar este «encuentro» con Cristo, Dios ha querido su Iglesia. En efecto, ella «desea servir solamente para este fin: que todo hombre pueda encontrar a Cristo, de modo que Cristo pueda recorrer con cada uno el camino de la vida» .**  
**(San Juan Pablo II, El Esplendor de la Verdad, 7)**

**"Desde la profundidad del corazón surge la pregunta que el joven rico dirige a Jesús de Nazaret: una pregunta esencial e ineludible para la vida de todo hombre, pues se refiere al bien moral que hay que practicar y a la vida eterna. El interlocutor de Jesús intuye que hay una conexión entre el bien moral y el pleno cumplimiento del propio destino".**
