Election Considerations

I begin by quoting a bishop. *“According to Catholic doctrine, there are doubtless commandments which are not binding when obedience to them requires too great a sacrifice, but there are sacred obligations of conscience from which no one can release us and which we must fulfill even at the price of death itself. At no time, and under no circumstances whatsoever, may a man, except in war and in lawful defense, take the life of an innocent person.”* For now, I won’t identify the bishop. But the reasoning is familiar to Catholics. Suffice it to say, he got in hot water for saying this.

The bishop’s point is about “moral absolutes.” There are some things we must never do. Some human rights must never be violated. Examples include torture, lynching, abortion, targeting civilians in combat, and exploiting vulnerable persons— like the poor, refugees, migrants, wage earners, elderly, and orphans. Such sins “cry to heaven” (*Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1867*). “You must not mistreat or oppress a foreigner...” (*Exodus 22:21*). Those who commit these sins, with responsibility and conscience, will face God’s Judgment. “What you did to the least of my brothers and sisters, you have done to me” (*Matthews 25:40*). Human rights do not derive from states, laws, or ideas. They derive from nature as given by God.

“Conscience” is not a subjective opinion. It is an intelligent, honest, and informed “act of knowing” what is right and wrong— something humans are capable of. In this election, your conscience should cast your vote. I am not suggesting this clears up your questions and dilemmas. You may be conflicted. In fact, the proposition that “your conscience” casts your vote probably raises more questions and dilemmas. Voting decisions are rarely clearcut. As the king in “The King and I” sang, *“Is a puzzlement!”* For Catholics, no candidate totally fits the bill, as if Mother Teresa and Francis of Assisi were on the ballot. But we must vote with an enlightened conscience and leave the rest to Providence.

“Participation in political life requires judgments about concrete circumstances.... On these often complex matters, it is the laity’s responsibility to form their consciences and grow in the virtue of prudence to approach the many and varied issues of the day with the mind of Christ”

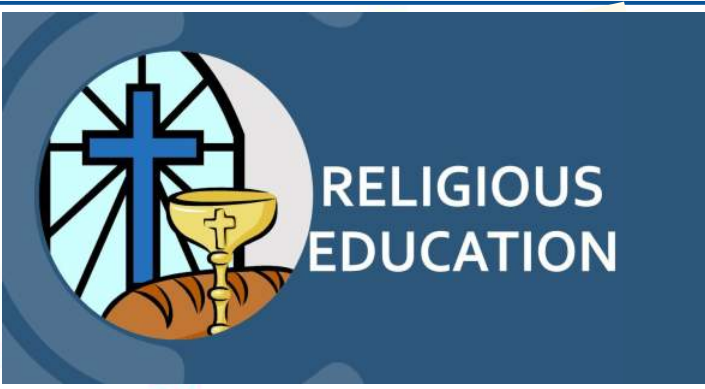

AROUND THE DIOCESE



Every October, the Church in the US. Celebrates Respect Life Month. The following are the remarks from Bishop Burbidge's statement issued as Chair of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) Pro-Life Activities Committee:

As your most precious gift of human life is attacked, draw us ever closer to your Real Presence in the Eucharist. By the power of your Eucharistic Presence, help us to defend the life of every human person at every stage. Transform our hearts to protect and cherish all whose lives are most vulnerable. For you are God, forever and ever. Amen."

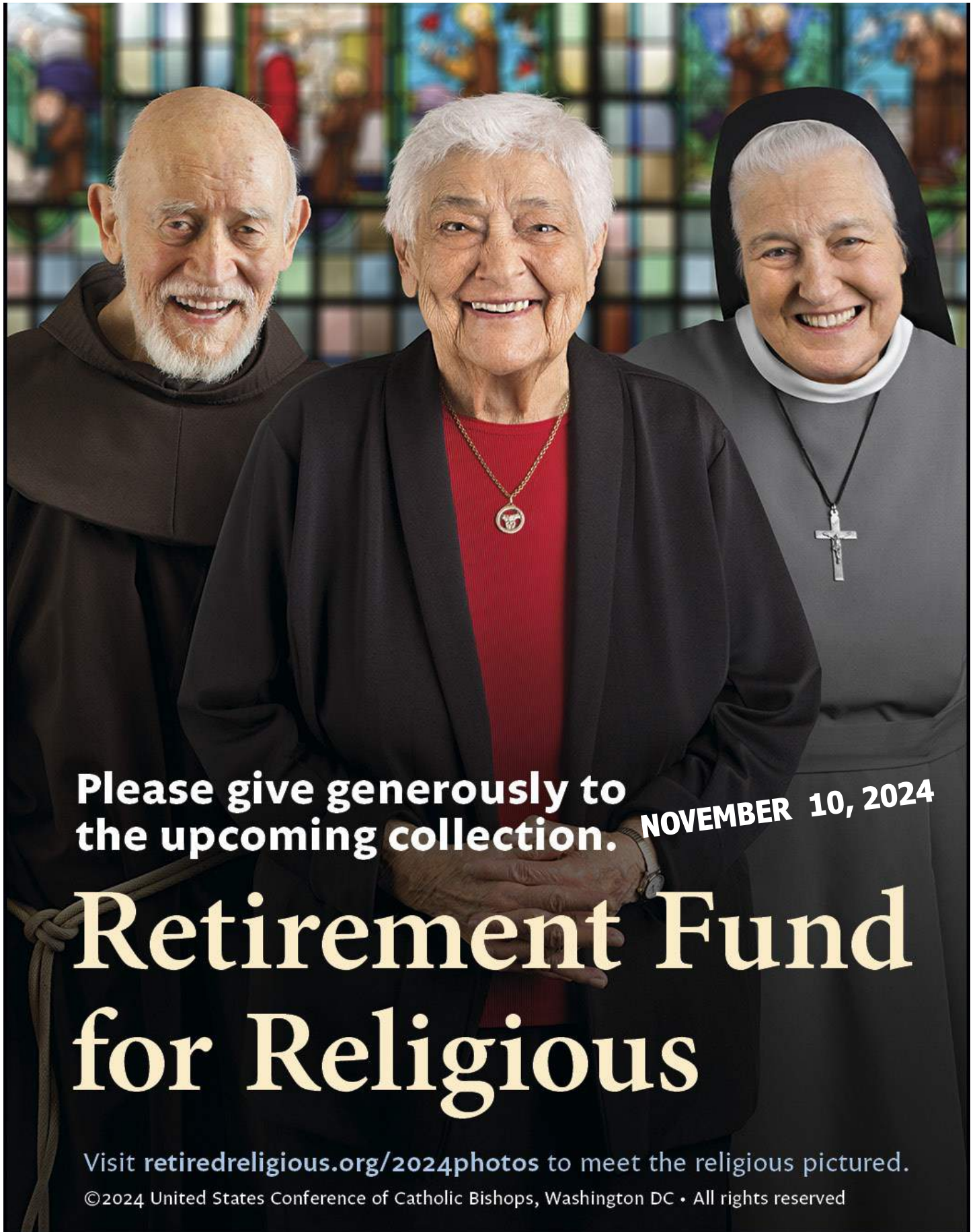

Consideraciones Electorales

Voy a empezar este artículo citando las palabras de un obispo: *"Según la doctrina católica, hay indudablemente mandamientos que no son obligatorios cuando la obediencia a ellos requiere un sacrificio demasiado grande, pero hay obligaciones sagradas de conciencia de las que nadie puede liberarnos y que debemos cumplir incluso al precio de la muerte misma. En ningún momento, y bajo ninguna circunstancia, puede un hombre, excepto en la guerra y en legítima defensa, tomar la vida de una persona inocente"*. Por ahora, no voy a identificar al obispo, basta decir que se metió en problemas por decir estas palabras. Sin embargo, el razonamiento es familiar para los católicos.

El punto del obispo es sobre los "absolutos morales". Hay algunas cosas que nunca debemos hacer. Algunos derechos humanos nunca deben ser violados. Algunos ejemplos son la tortura, los linchamientos, el aborto, los ataques contra civiles en combate y la explotación de personas vulnerables, como los pobres, los refugiados, los migrantes, los asalariados, los ancianos y los huérfanos. Tales pecados "claman al cielo" (*Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, 1867*). "No debes maltratar ni oprimir a un extranjero..." (*Éxodo 22:21*). Aquellos que cometen estos pecados, por su propia voluntad y conciencia, enfrentarán el Juicio de Dios. "Lo que hicieron con el más pequeño de mis hermanos, lo hicieron conmigo" (*Mateo 25:40*). Los derechos humanos no vienen de los gobiernos, las leyes o ideas. Vienen de la naturaleza dada por Dios.

La "conciencia" no es una opinión subjetiva. Es un "acto de saber" lo que está bien y lo que está mal, en una manera inteligente, honesta e informada, algo de lo que los humanos son capaces de hacer. En esta elección, tu conciencia debe dirigir tu voto. No espero que esto aclare tus preguntas y dilemas. Mas bien, puede crearte más conflicto. De hecho, la proposición de que "tu conciencia" dirija tu voto probablemente plantea más preguntas y dilemas. Las decisiones electorales rara vez son claras. Para los católicos, no hay candidato que llene totalmente los requisitos, no como si la Madre Teresa y Francisco de Asís estuvieran en la boleta electoral. Pero debemos votar con una conciencia informada y dejar el resto a la Divina Providencia.

¿Quién fue el obispo perseguido citado al principio de este artículo? Fue el obispo Clemens von Galen de la diócesis de Münster, Alemania, hablando desde el púlpito el 3 de agosto de 1941.
