Baptism's Purgatory

The snow is on the roses. Death looms over all blossoms. All Saints Day foretells Heaven. November prays for purgatory's souls. Baptism plunges us into life's purifying waters. Purification is completed either before or after death.

Do you fear purgatory? St. Theresa of Lisieux said, *"You have too much fear before the good God. I can assure you that He is grieved over this. You should not fear Purgatory because of the suffering there but should instead ask that you not deserve to go there to please God, who so reluctantly imposes this punishment. As soon as you try to please Him in everything and have an unshakable trust He purifies you every moment in His love and He lets no sin remain. And then you can be sure that you will not have to go to Purgatory."*

Here's an antidote to your fear: *"For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you" (Matthew 7:2).* Don't adjudicate others' sins. The millstone may be cast on a neck you'll never see.

Monks of old told this story: *"Once a brother was found guilty, and the older brethren assembled and called for the Abbot. But he would not come. Then the priest called for him, saying, 'Come, for the brothers are assembled and await you.' The Abbot came. But he took with him a very old basket, filled with sand. He carried it behind him. When they greeted the Abbot, they asked, 'Father, what is this?' The old man said to them, 'My sins follow me, and I do not see them, and I have come to judge the sins of another man.' When they heard him, they said nothing to the brother, but forgave him."*

Love is humble and free. Hell is judicial and forced, like a self-imposed verdict on one who has rejected love, justice, honesty, and penance.

What's Hell like? Christ told St. Catherine of Siena, *"In his ignorance man treats himself very cruelly. My care is constant, but he turns my life-giving power into a source of death."*

What's Heaven like? St. Thomas Aquinas called it "Happiness". Gratefully and humbly, ask for it. It's all yours in Christ Jesus, our suffering Servant, if you repent for your sins.

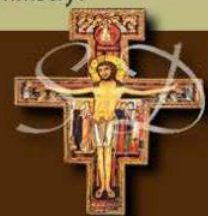

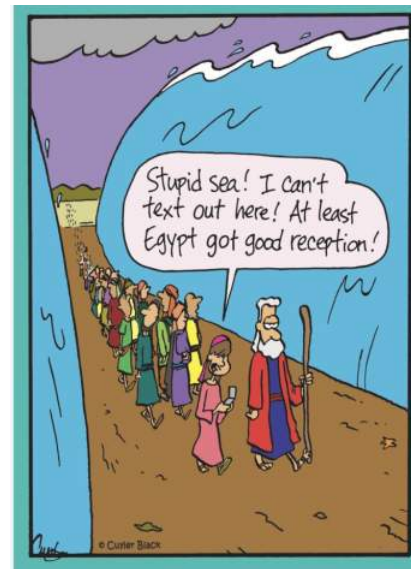

Purgatorio del Bautismo

La nieve cubre las rosas. El lustre de las flores va muriendo. El Día de Todos los Santos anticipa el Cielo. En Noviembre, se reza por las almas del purgatorio. El bautismo nos sumerge en las aguas purificadoras de la vida. La purificación se completa antes o después de la muerte.

¿Temes al purgatorio? Santa Teresa de Lisieux dijo: *“Tienes mucho miedo ante el Buen Dios. Les aseguro que Él se preocupa por esto. No debes temer al Purgatorio por el sufrimiento, sino que debemos querer no ir allí, no por temor sino para causar placer al Buen Dios, que tan a regañadientes impone este castigo. Tan pronto como tratas de complacerlo en todo y tienes una confianza inquebrantable, Él te purifica a cada momento con su infinito amor y no permite que quede ningún pecado. Y entonces puedes estar seguro de que no tendrás que ir al Purgatorio.”*

Un antídoto para tu miedo lo encuentras en la escritura: “Porque de la misma manera que ustedes juzguen, así serán juzgados, y la misma medida que ustedes usen para los demás, será usada para ustedes.” No adjudiques los pecados de los demás. La piedra del molino puede ser colgada en un cuello que nunca verás.

Los monjes de tiempo atrás contaban esta historia: *“Una vez un monje fue declarado culpable, y los monjes mayores se reunieron y llamaron al monje superior, el Abad. Pero éste no quiso venir. Entonces uno de los monjes mayores lo llamo, diciendo: ‘Ven, porque tus hermanos están reunidos y te esperan’. El Abad llevo finalmente. Pero llevaba consigo una cesta muy vieja, llena de arena. La llevaba detrás de sí. Cuando los otros monjes le vieron, le preguntaron: ‘Padre, ¿porque llevas esta canasta? El anciano les dijo: ‘Mis pecados me siguen, y no los veo, y he venido a juzgar los pecados de otro hombre.’ Cuando lo oyeron, los monjes mayores no dijeron nada al monje menor, sino que lo perdonaron.”*

El amor es humilde y libre. El infierno condena y es forzado, como un veredicto autoimpuesto por el que ha rechazado el amor, la justicia, la honestidad y la penitencia.

¿Cómo es el infierno? Cristo le dijo a Santa Catalina de Siena: *“En su ignorancia, el hombre se trata a si mismo con mucha crueldad. Mi cuidado por él, es constante, pero el hombre convierte mi poder vivíficamente en una fuente de muerte.”*

¿Cómo es el cielo? Santo Tomas de Aquino lo llamo “Felicidad”. Pídelo con gratitud y humildad. Es todo tuyo en Cristo Jesús, nuestro Siervo sufriente, si te arrepientes de tus pecados.
