

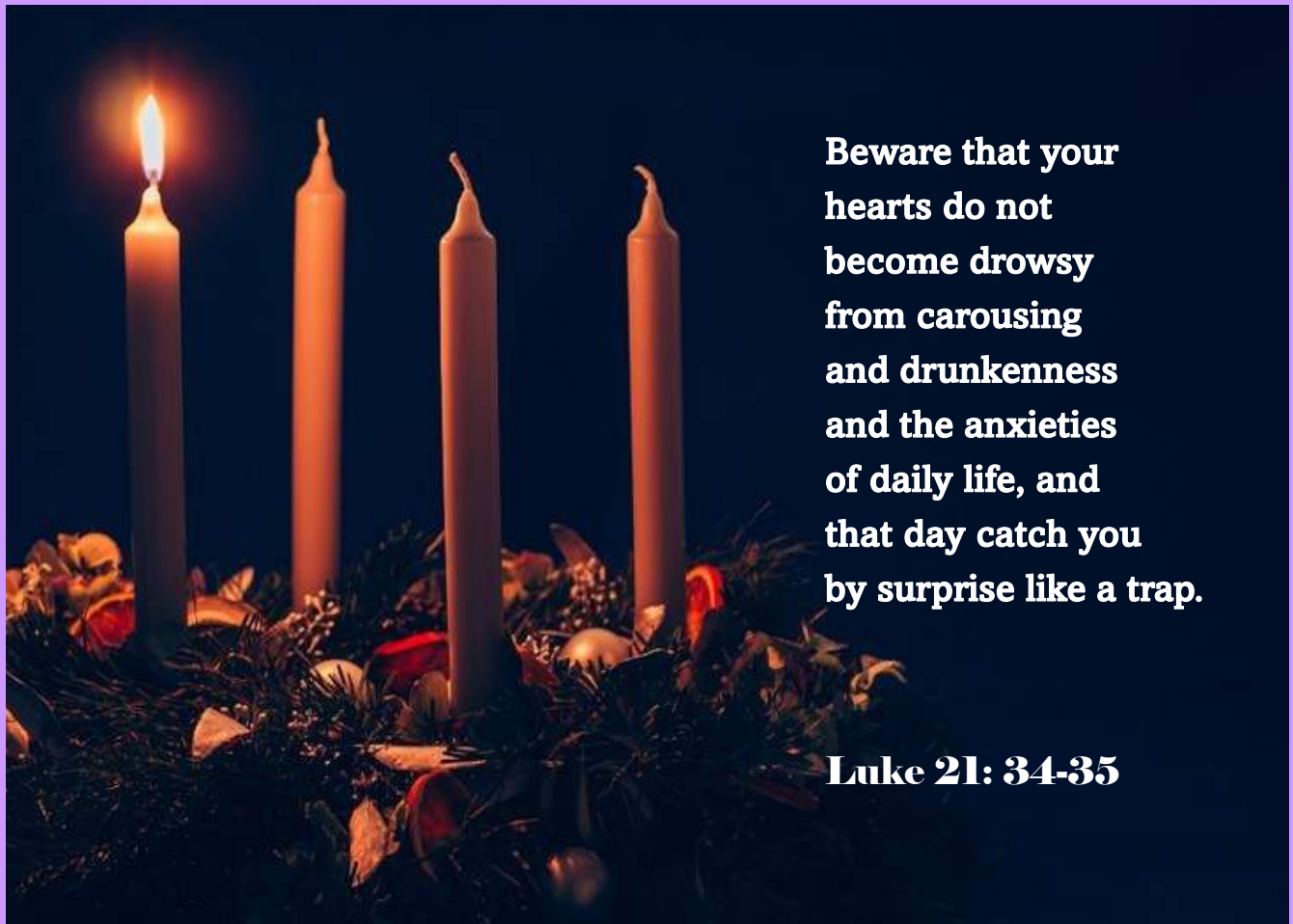

Advent

"Stay with us, Lord, for the shadows fall long and evening is spent. Jesus stayed with them" (Luke 24:29). The Emmaus-destined travelers and Jesus booked the night at the Hampton Inn.

History's sun is setting. Something new is being born. "The kingdom of heaven is at hand!" (Matthew 3:2). It's Advent. From now until December 17, we anticipate Christ's Second Coming.

**"The dawn from on high shall break upon us."
(Canticle of Zechariah, Luke 1:78-79)**

Advent foretells Christ's Second Coming. Make amends. Confess sins. Meditate on the Gospel. December 17 begins a nine-day preparation for Christmas, contemplating Christ's First Coming. Make that time warm and festive. Make it intimate with loved ones. Cut back on electronics. Turn on togetherness and mutual prayer.

Family Tips for Advent

Advent Wreath (Starting First Sunday of Advent): Light the candles as a family daily at dinner time. Each child can take turns lighting the candles.

St. Nicholas Day (December 6): Children put out shoes on St. Nick's Eve hoping the kind bishop will visit with gifts. Fill kids' shoes with treats. Many families give gifts on both December 6 and Christmas.

The Mary candle (December 9, Immaculate Conception): Place a blue-ribboned candle by an image of the Virgin at mealtime. Then, read this prayer: **"This light is entrusted to you to be kept burning brightly. In Baptism, you have been enlightened by Christ. Walk always as a child of Light. Keep the flame of Faith alive in your heart. When the Lord comes, go out to meet Him with all the Saints in the Heavenly Kingdom."**

The Empty Manger (December 17-24): Make a manger in your home and in your heart. Plan acts of kindness, honoring Baby Jesus, as birthday presents to the divine Child. On Christmas Eve, place the Baby Jesus in the manger.

The Christ Candle (Christmas Eve): Decorate a large white candle with symbols of Christ and Christmas cards. Light it on Christmas Eve. Continue to light the Christ Candle at Sunday dinner through February 2 (Feast of the Presentation), reminding your family that Christ is the "Light of the world" (John 8:12).

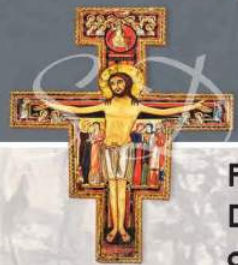

Adviento

"*Quédate con nosotros, Señor, porque las sombras se alargan y se termina el día*" (Lucas 24:29). Los viajeros iban con destino a Emaús y Jesús reservó la noche en el Hampton Inn.

El sol de la historia del mundo se está poniendo.. Algo nuevo está naciendo. "¡El reino de los cielos está cerca" (Mateo 3:2). Es Adviento. Desde ahora hasta el 17 de diciembre, anticipamos la segunda venida de Cristo.

**"Nos viste una Luz de la altura"
(Cántico de Zacarías, Lucas 1:78-79)**

El Adviento predice la segunda venida de Cristo. Haz enmiendas. Confiesa los pecados. Medita en el Evangelio. El 17 de diciembre comienza un periodo de nueve días de preparación para la Navidad contemplando la Primera Venida de Cristo. Haz que ese tiempo sea cálido y festivo. Hazlo íntimo con tus seres queridos. Reduce el consumo de productos electrónicos. Practica la unión y la oración mutua.

Consejos familiares para el Adviento

Corona de Adviento (a partir del primer domingo de Adviento): Con la familia, encienda las velas todos los días a la hora de la cena. Cada niño puede turnarse para encender las velas.

Día de San Nicolás (6 de diciembre): Los niños dejan zapatos afuera en la víspera de San Nicolás con la esperanza de que el benevolente obispo los visite con regalos. Llena los zapatos de los niños con golosinas. Muchas familias dan regalos tanto el 6 de diciembre como en Navidad.

La vela de María (9 de diciembre, Inmaculada Concepción): Coloque una cinta azul alrededor de una vela junto a una imagen de la Virgen a la hora de comer. Luego, lee esta oración: "**Esta luz te ha sido confiada para que la mantengas ardiendo brillantemente. En el Bautismo, has sido iluminado por Cristo. Camina siempre como un hijo de la Luz. Mantén viva la llama de la Fe en tu corazón. Cuando venga el Señor, salgan a su encuentro con todos los santos en el Reino de los Cielos**".

El pesebre vacío (17-24 de diciembre): Coloque un pesebre en tu casa y en tu corazón. Planifique actos de bondad, en honor al Niño Jesús, como regalos de cumpleaños para el divino Niño. En la víspera de Navidad, coloque al Niño Jesús en el pesebre.

La Vela de Cristo (Nochebuena): Decora una gran vela blanca con símbolos de Cristo y tarjetas de Navidad. Enciéndela en Nochebuena. Continúe encendiendo la Vela de Cristo cada domingo hasta el 2 de febrero (Fiesta de la Presentación), recordándole a su familia que Cristo es la "Luz del mundo" (Juan 8:12)
