The Fulfillment

For the past few Sundays, the Gospels reveal Jesus' divine power. At Jesus' baptism, the Father's voice proclaimed, "This is my beloved Son." That was the first public revelation of Jesus as the Son of God. Last week, the Gospel was about Jesus changing water into wine at the wedding in Cana. That was the first of his miracles when he "so revealed his glory, and his disciples began to believe in him."

In today's Gospel, Jesus goes into a synagogue on the Sabbath and reads the prophet Isaiah: "*The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me, to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord.*" He concludes by saying: "*Today, this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing.*"

Flash back to *Leviticus*. God said to Moses: "*Seven weeks of years shall you count--seven times seven years--so that the seven cycles amount to forty-nine years. Then, on the tenth day of the seventh month [of the 49th year], let the trumpet resound ... This fiftieth year you shall make sacred by proclaiming liberty in the land for all its inhabitants. It shall be a jubilee for you, when every one of you shall return to his own property, everyone to his own family estate*" (*Leviticus 25: 8-10*). This 50th Jubilee year was supposed to be a year-long Sabbath: debts cancelled, slaves freed, and collateral returned. Of course, this was arguably the least-observed law in the Covenant.

However, Christ fulfills the jubilee! Changing water into wine suggests the fulfillment. However, Christ's jubilee is not of this world. It's beyond death. The invitation is issued at Baptism.

Christ has come to set us free from the burdens of a fallen world. So use your borrowed time – in work and in leisure – to pursue goodness, truth and beauty. Prepare yourselves for the ultimate and enduring Freedom and Joy: the Jubilee of God's Paradise. "*To him who conquers, I will grant to eat of the Tree of Life, which is in the Paradise of God*" (*Revelation 2:7*).

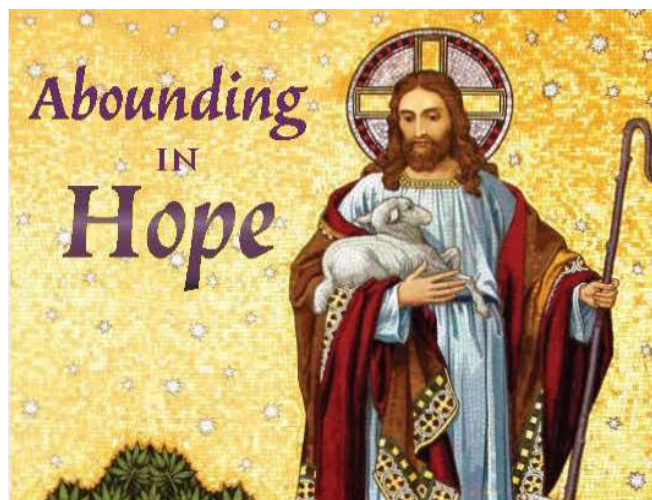

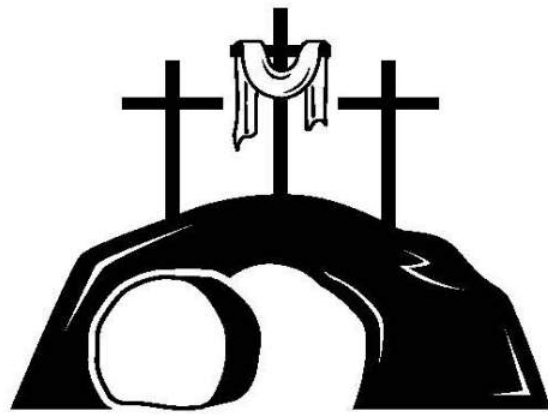

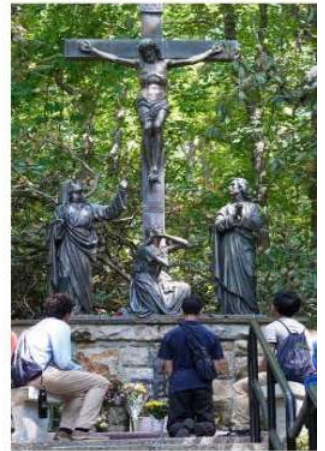

Una Misión Cumplida

Durante los últimos domingos, los Evangelios han revelado el poder divino de Jesús. En el bautismo de Jesús, la voz del Padre proclamó: "Este es mi Hijo amado". Esa fue la primera revelación pública de Jesús como el Hijo de Dios. La semana pasada, el Evangelio nos reveló como Jesús transformó el agua en vino en las bodas de Caná. Ese fue el primero de sus milagros cuando "así reveló su gloria, y sus discípulos comenzaron a creer en Él".

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús entra en una sinagoga un sábado donde lee al profeta Isaías: "*El Espíritu del Señor está sobre mí, porque me ha unguido para llevar a los pobres la buena nueva, para anunciar la liberación a los cautivos y la curación a los ciegos, para dar libertad a los oprimidos y proclamar el año de gracia del Señor.*" Jesús concluye diciendo: "Hoy mismo se ha cumplido este pasaje de la Escritura que acaban de oír".

En el libro Levítico, Dios le dice a Moisés: "*Deberás contar siete semanas de años—siete veces siete años—de manera que el periodo de las siete semanas de años sume un total de cuarenta y nueve años. Luego, a los diez días del mes séptimo [del año 49], harás resonar un fuerte toque de trompeta... Santificarás este quincuagésimo año proclamando la libertad para todos los habitantes de la tierra. Este será para ustedes un jubileo, en el que cada uno recobrará su propiedad y regresará a su familia.*" (Levítico 25:8-10). Se suponía que este 50º año del Jubileo sería un año Sabático durante el cual todas las deudas se cancelan, se liberan a los esclavos y las fianzas se devuelven. Por supuesto, esta fue la ley en el Pacto con Israel que menos fue cumplida.

Sin embargo, ¡Cristo sí cumple el Jubileo! Convertir el agua en vino indica este cumplimiento. Sin embargo, el jubileo de Cristo no es de este mundo. Está más allá de la muerte. La invitación llega en el Bautismo.

Cristo ha venido para liberarnos de las cargas de un mundo quebrantado. Así que usa tu tiempo prestado, en el trabajo y en el descanso, para buscar la bondad, la verdad y la belleza. Prepárense para la máxima y duradera Libertad y Alegría: el Jubileo del Paraíso de Dios. "*Al vencedor, le daré de comer del árbol de la vida, que se encuentra en el Paraíso de Dios*" (Apocalipsis 2:7).
