The Prodigal

Two brothers. One tale. A sinner. A favorite son. The father celebrated his sinner's return. The favorite became angry and refused to enter his father's house. How could a faithful son be bitter? It's a case of fidelity without love.

Some people identify with the prodigal son. Others use him to excuse their sins. But the prodigal doesn't excuse his sins, even when committing them. Nor does he map out an action plan: "I'll have my fun, and when money runs out, dad will take me back and pay up." Some young men can be like that. As my brother-in-law said, "Every man that lives past thirty deserves an award."

When the prodigal "came to himself" (Luke 15:17) he said, "I will arise and go to my father" (Luke 15:18). Just as he impetuously followed his feckless heart into sin, he followed his enlightened heart back to his father. Sin's grief uncovered his deepest desire: to be in his father's house. Like Christ after being found in the Temple, he said to himself: "Did you not know I had to be in my Father's house" (Luke 2:49)?

Why did the older son refuse to enter his father's house? He did not want to be with his brother. He saw the speck in his brother's eye ignoring the plank of pride in his own. Because of pride, the older brother never followed his heart – neither when it was wrong nor when it was right. He had nothing to do with his heart.

For the older brother, it was about career planning. Repentance or conversion had nothing to do with it. He was so afraid of being wrong that he never gave himself the chance of being right – especially about life's most important challenges: loving God and neighbor.

What are your biggest regrets and sins? That's a rhetorical question. Confess them to a priest. Then forget it. Reject the temptation to narrate the hamster wheel of regrets in your mind. Stop watching those old mental "YouTube" videos. They are temptations of the highest order, draining you of life and seducing you to beat yourself up. You've confessed. You've resolved to do good and avoid evil. You've acknowledged your regrets. Now acknowledge what you want. "I want to be in my Father's house." With Christ, take it from there.

Going to Confession



1. The priest gives a blessing or greeting.
2. Make the Sign of the Cross and say,
"Bless me father, for I have sinned."
My last confession was..." (give weeks, months, or years).
3. Confess all your sins to the priest.
(If you are unsure or uneasy, tell him and ask for help.)
4. Say, "I am sorry for these and all my sins."
5. The priest gives a penance and offers advice to help you become a better Catholic.
6. Say an Act of Contrition, expressing your sorrow for your sins.
7. The priest, acting in the person of Christ, then absolves you from your sins.

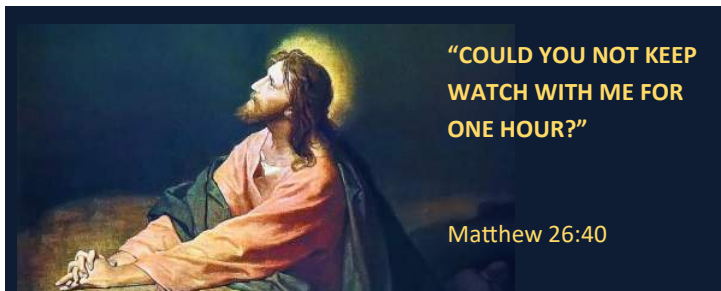

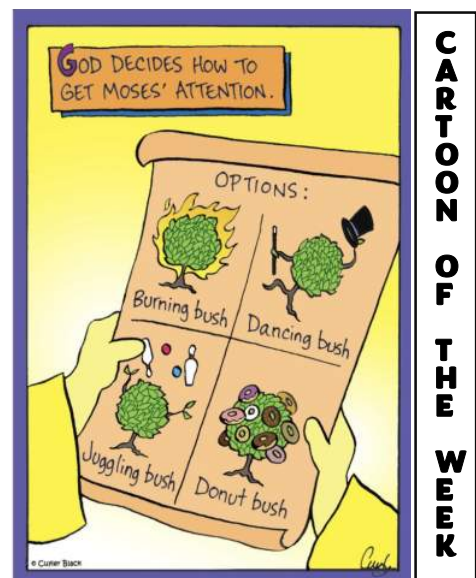

El hijo pródigo

Dos hermanos. Una historia. Un pecador. Un hijo predilecto. El padre celebró el regreso de su pecador. El favorito se enojó y se negó a entrar en la casa de su padre. ¿Cómo un hijo fiel puede estar tan amargado? Es un caso de fidelidad sin amor.

Algunas personas se identifican con el hijo pródigo. Otros lo usan como excusa para sus pecados. Pero el hijo pródigo no excusa sus pecados, ni siquiera cuando los comete. Tampoco tiene un plan de acción: "Me divertiré, y cuando se acabe el dinero, papá vendrá y pagará por mí". Algunos jóvenes pueden ser así. Como dice mi cuñado: "Todo hombre que vive más de los treinta, se merece un premio".

Cuando el hijo pródigo "volvió en sí" (Lucas 15:17) dijo: "Me levantaré e iré a la casa de mi padre" (Lucas 15:18). Así como siguió impetuosamente a su corazón irresponsable hacia el pecado, el hijo prodigo siguió su corazón iluminado de regreso a su padre. La agonía del pecado le hizo descubrir su deseo más profundo: estar en la casa de su padre. Como Cristo, después de haber sido encontrado en el Templo, se dijo a sí mismo: "¿No sabían que yo debo ocuparme de los asuntos de mi Padre?" Lucas 2:49.

¿Por qué el hijo mayor se negó a entrar en la casa de su padre? No quería estar con su hermano. Vió la paja en el ojo de su hermano, ignorando la viga del orgullo en el suyo. Por orgullo, el hermano mayor nunca siguió su corazón, ni cuando estaba mal ni cuando estaba bien. No tenía interés en cosas del corazón.

Para el hermano mayor, se trataba de planificar su carrera. El arrepentimiento o la conversión no tenían nada que ver. Tenía tanto miedo de equivocarse que nunca se dió a sí mismo la oportunidad de tener razón, especialmente en los desafíos más importantes de la vida: amar a Dios y al prójimo.

¿Cuáles son tus mayores arrepentimientos y pecados? Es una pregunta retórica. Confíesalos a un sacerdote y luego olvídalos. Rechaza la tentación de narrar la ruedilla de los arrepentimientos en tu mente. Deja de ver esos viejos videos mentales de "YouTube". Son tentaciones del más alto orden, que te drenan de la vida y te seducen para que te golpees. Si ya has confesado, has resuelto hacer el bien y evitar el mal, has reconocido tus remordimientos, entonces reconocerás lo que quieres. "Estar en la casa de mi Padre". Con Cristo, toma el camino a partir de ahí.
