

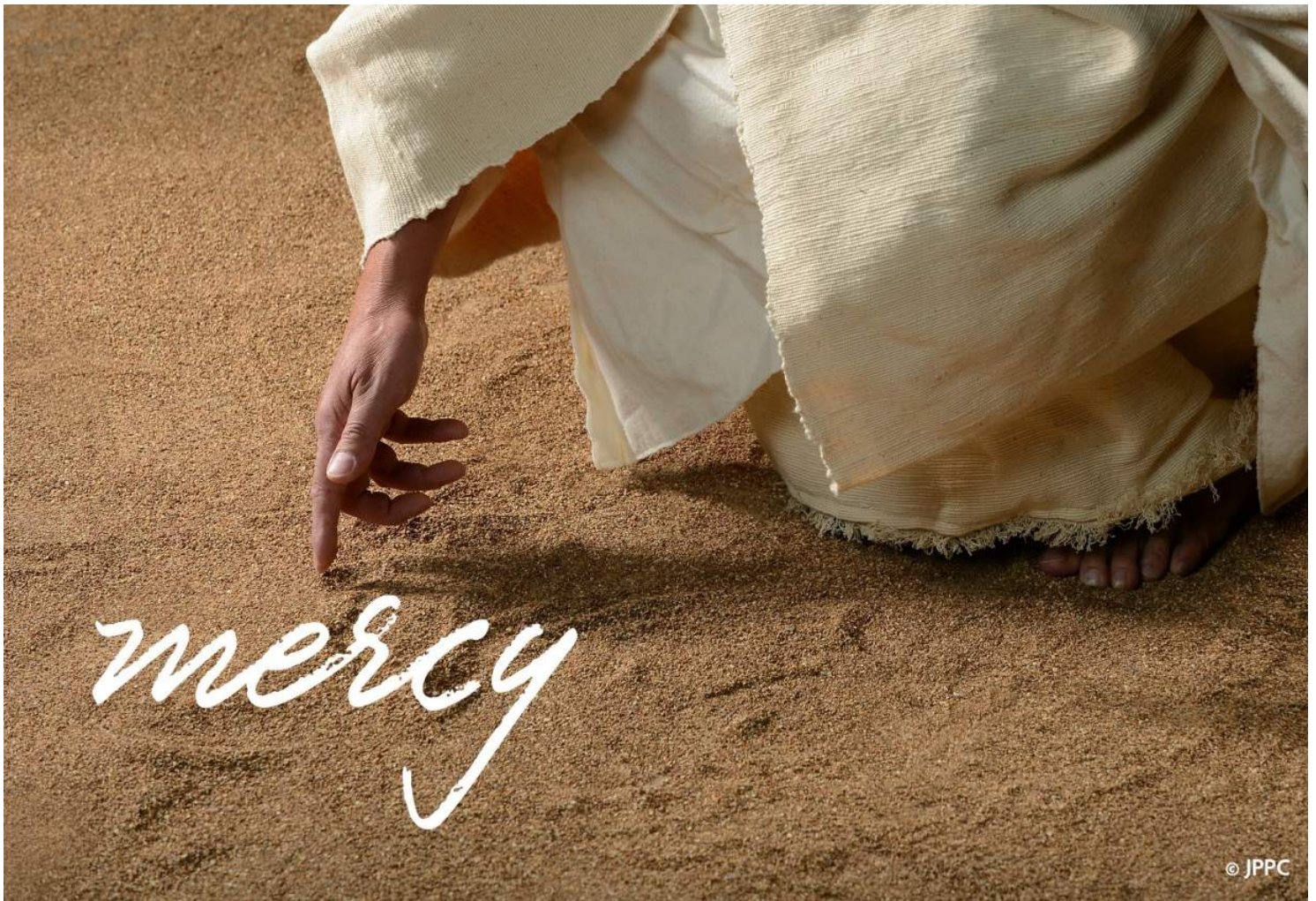

Christ's Priesthood

Why did the Father send his co-eternal Son to become a man named Jesus, born of the Virgin? Per the angel in Joseph's dream: to save *us from our sins*. When G. K. Chesterton was asked why he became Catholic, he was quite direct: *It's the only Church that can forgive my sins*. He was referring to Confession. "Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained" (John 20:23). The priest's authority to absolve sins in Jesus' Name was established by the Risen Lord.

Christ begins to disclose this in the story about the woman caught in adultery. Jesus asked, "Has no one condemned you?" She replied, "No one, sir." Jesus said, "Neither do I. Go, and sin no more." In this encounter, Christ reveals himself as a priest. When sins are sincerely disclosed to a priest of Jesus Christ, there is no condemnation. Rather, the innocence of Baptism is restored.

Neither angels nor Mary can forgive sins. St. John Vianney said, "Without the priest, the death and passion of our Lord would be of no avail ... After God, the priest is every thing.... See the power of the priest; out of a piece of bread the word of a priest makes a God ... The priest continues the work of redemption on earth...The priesthood is the love of the Heart of Jesus."

Through the priest, the Church does what Christ did when he forgave sins. The priest's spiritual authority flows from Christ's passion and death. When we approach any of the sacraments, we approach Jesus' Cross and its life-giving power. At the Last Supper, Jesus consecrated his Apostles to be the first priests of the New Covenant. Through Holy Orders, Christ empowers priests to nurture the grace of Baptism.

The "Holy Sacrifice" of the Mass is celebrated by a priest. Mass makes present Christ's death and resurrection (Paschal Mystery). When bread and wine are consecrated separately, they make present Christ's sacrifice. During the Communion Rite, the priest consumes the Body and Blood of Christ under both species (bread and wine), which makes present the reunion of Christ's Body and Blood at his resurrection. Holy Communion is Christ's Risen Body. When we receive Communion, we participate most fully in Christ's death and resurrection. Our life becomes Christ's life. Christ's death and resurrection becomes our death and resurrection

Going to Confession



1. The priest gives a blessing or greeting.
2. Make the Sign of the Cross and say,
"Bless me father, for I have sinned."
My last confession was..." (give weeks, months, or years).
3. Confess all your sins to the priest.
(If you are unsure or uneasy, tell him and ask for help.)
4. Say, "I am sorry for these and all my sins."
5. The priest gives a penance and offers advice to help you become a better Catholic.
6. Say an Act of Contrition, expressing your sorrow for your sins.
7. The priest, acting in the person of Christ, then absolves you from your sins.

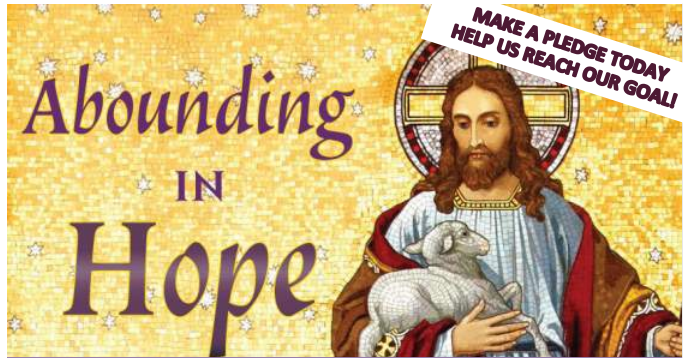

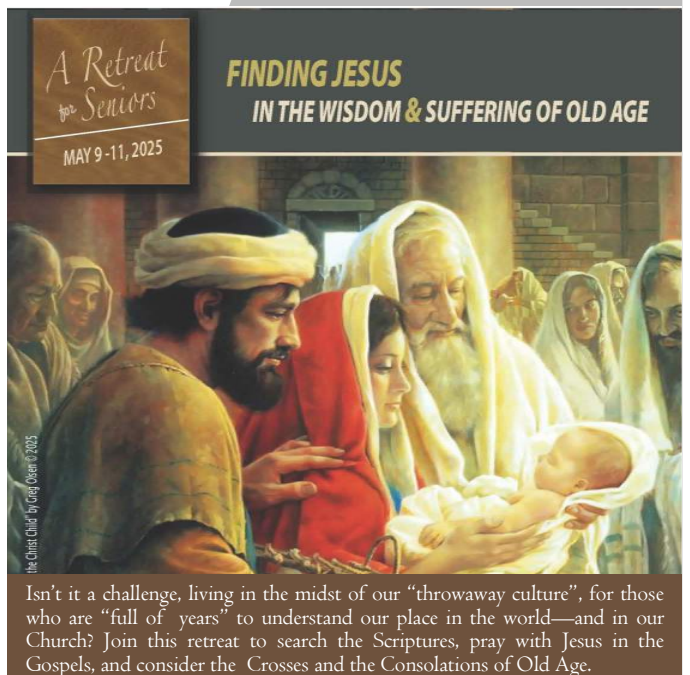

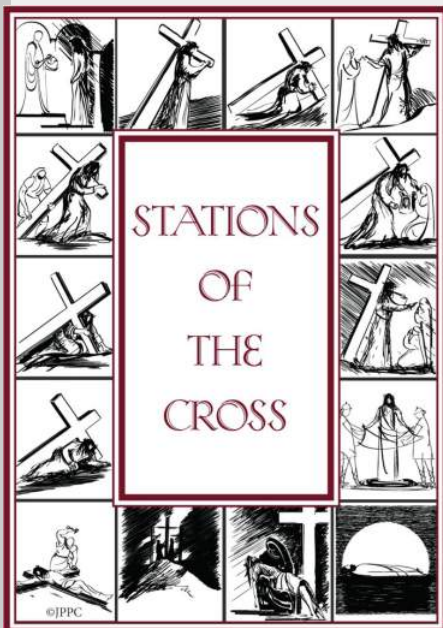

Stewardship Reflection

"...For his sake I have accepted the loss of all things and I consider them so much rubbish, that I may gain Christ..." Philippians 3:8

The first commandment says that we should not put other gods before the Lord. Living stewardship by sharing our time in prayer, our talent in charitable works, and our treasure to support the Church helps us keep God first in everything. It helps us from putting other gods before God. It helps us from becoming a slave to our possessions. It helps us to use our gifts for the glory of God and not for the glory of ourselves.



The Stations of the Cross, also known as the Way of the Cross or Via Crucis, commemorate Jesus's passion and death on the cross. There are 14 stations that each depict a moment on his journey to Calvary, usually through sacred art, prayers, and reflections. The practice began as pious pilgrims traced his path through Jerusalem on the Via Dolorosa. Later, for the many who wanted to pass along the same route, but could not travel to Jerusalem, a practice developed that eventually took the form of the fourteen stations currently found in almost every church throughout the world.

El Sacerdocio de Cristo

¿Por qué el Padre envió a su Hijo Dios a que se convirtiera en un hombre llamado Jesús, nacido de la Virgen? El ángel que apareció en el sueño de José da esta respuesta: para *salvarnos de nuestros pecados*. Cuando le preguntaron a G. K. Chesterton por qué se había convertido al catolicismo, él fue bastante directo: *Es la única Iglesia que puede perdonar mis pecados*. Se refería al sacramento de la Confesión. "Los pecados serán perdonados a los que ustedes se los perdonen, y serán retenidos a los que ustedes se los retengan" (Juan 20:23).

La autoridad del sacerdote para absolver los pecados en el Nombre de Jesús fue establecida por el Señor Resucitado. Cristo comienza a revelar esto en la historia de la mujer adúltera cuando Jesús le pregunta: "¿Nadie te ha condenado?" Ella respondió: "No señor". Jesús le dijo: "Yo tampoco. Vete, y no peques más". En este encuentro, Cristo se revela como sacerdote. Cuando los pecados se confiesan sinceramente a un sacerdote en la persona de Jesucristo, no hay condenación. Más bien, se restaura la inocencia del Bautismo.

Ni los ángeles ni María pueden perdonar los pecados. San Juan Vianney dijo: "Sin el sacerdote, la muerte y la pasión de nuestro Señor no servirían de nada... Después de Dios, el sacerdote lo es todo... Mira el poder del sacerdote cuando de un pedazo de pan, la palabra de un sacerdote hace un Dios... El sacerdote continúa la obra redentora de Cristo en la tierra... El sacerdocio es el amor del Corazón de Jesús".

A través del sacerdote, la Iglesia hace lo que Cristo hizo al perdonar los pecados. La autoridad espiritual del sacerdote fluye de la pasión y muerte de Cristo. Cuando recibimos cualquiera de los sacramentos, nos acercamos a la cruz de Jesús y a su poder vivificante. En la Última Cena, Jesús consagró a sus Apóstoles para ser los primeros sacerdotes de la Nueva Alianza. A través del Orden Sagrado, Cristo capacita a los sacerdotes para sustentar la gracia del Bautismo.

El "Santo Sacrificio" de la Misa es celebrado por un sacerdote. La Misa hace presente la muerte y resurrección de Cristo (Misterio Pascual). Cuando el pan y el vino se consagran por separado, se hace presente el sacrificio de Cristo. Durante el Rito de la Comunión, el sacerdote consume el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo bajo las dos especies (pan y vino), lo que hace presente la reunión del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo en su resurrección.
