

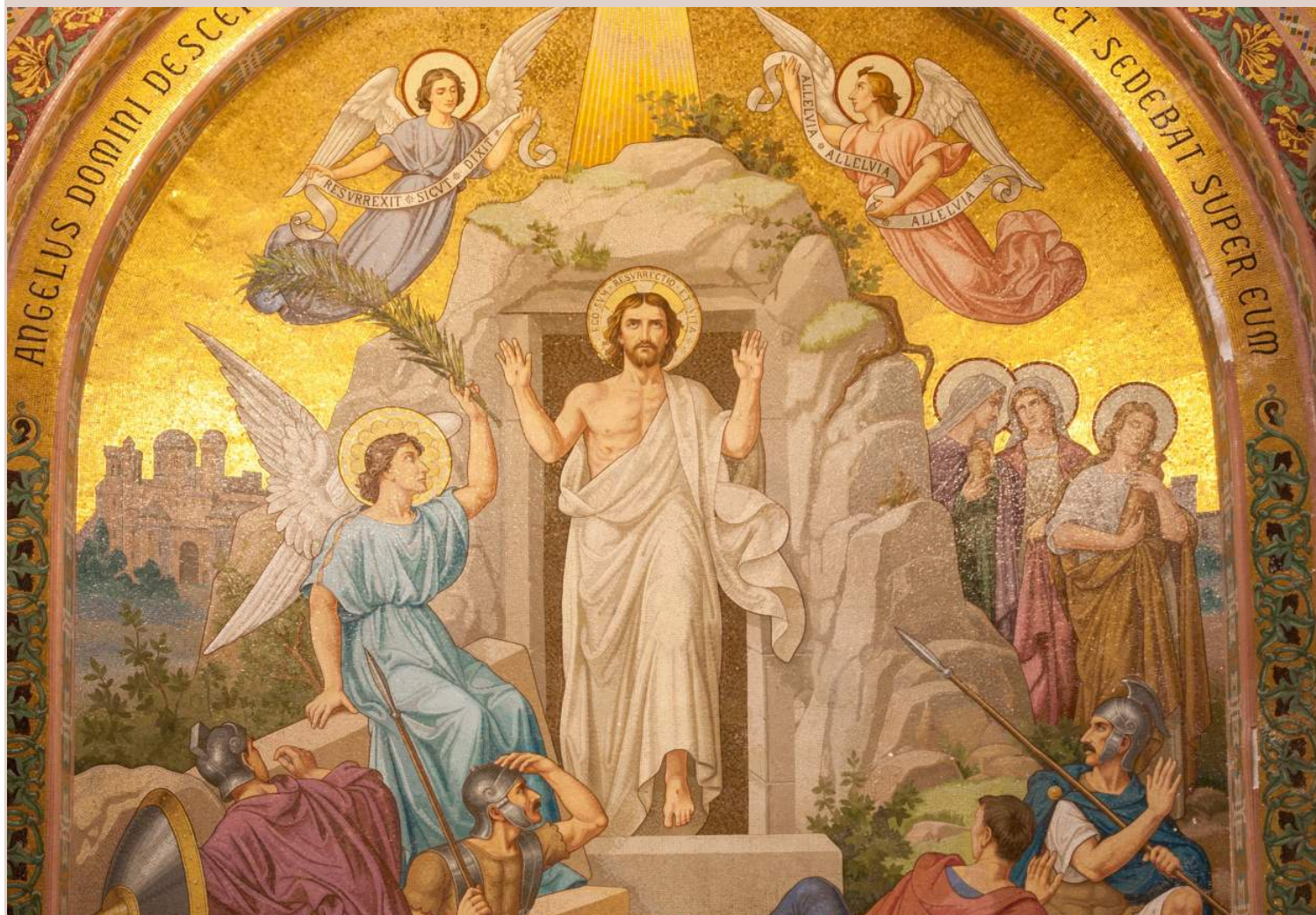

On the First Day of the Week

"On the first day of the week..." (John 20:1). This is the opening line of Easter Sunday's Gospel. All four Gospels begin their resurrection story on "the first day of the week." Of course, this reminds us of the first day of Creation when God said, "Let there be light" (Genesis 1:3). In other words, the resurrection of Jesus is the first day of a New Creation. Something new and fresh is born. All things are made new.

But when Mary Magdalene approached the tomb on that "first day of the week," it was early in the morning, and it was still dark. She was still in darkness when she peered into the open tomb. It was not apparent to Mary Magdalene that Christ was risen and that a New Creation had begun. In fact, she assumed the worst. Mary told Peter and John that the Lord had been taken and "we don't know where they put him."

We all struggle with this experience every day. It's understandable. We still live in a troubled world, rife with wars, cruelty, hatred, attacks on the innocent, and injustice. But God still loves the world. He died for this world – and for every person and creature in it, without exception. While we may be tempted to think that evil has the upper hand, it's a fact that Good has already won. "The wicked are like a dream after waking, Lord, dismissed like shadows when you arise" (Psalm 73:20).

While our times may seem dark, the Risen One says, "Behold, I make all things new" (Revelation 21:5). It's all foretold in the ancient texts of Scripture: "When the sun had set and darkness had fallen, a burning furnace and a blazing torch passed between the parts" (Genesis 15:17). Christ is risen. His Light shines on everyone, casting a blaze of judgment and peace that resolves everything and makes all things new. "Night will be no more, nor will they need light from lamp or sun, for the Lord God shall give them Light, and they shall reign forever and ever" (Revelation 22:5).

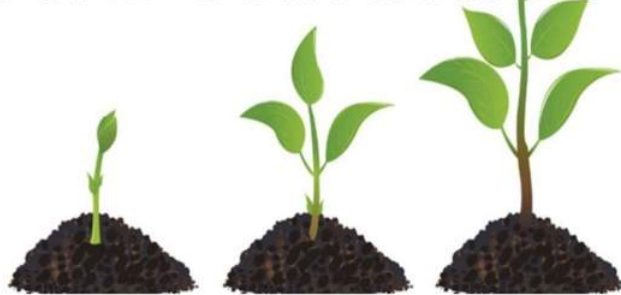

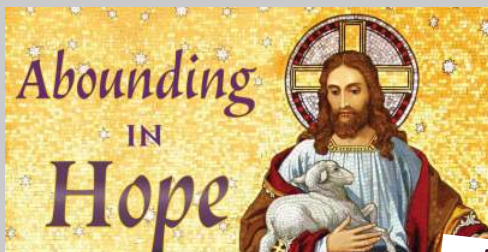

El primer día de la semana

"El primer día de la semana..." (Juan 20:1). Esta es la primera línea del Evangelio del Domingo de Pascua. Los cuatro Evangelios comienzan la historia de la resurrección con "el primer día de la semana". Por supuesto, esto nos recuerda el primer día de la Creación cuando Dios dijo: "Hágase la luz" (Génesis 1:3). En otras palabras, la resurrección de Jesús es el primer día de una Nueva Creación. Nace algo nuevo y lozano. Todas las cosas son hechas nuevas.

Pero cuando María Magdalena se acercó al sepulcro ese "primer día de la semana", era temprano en la mañana y todavía estaba oscuro. Ella estaba todavía en la oscuridad cuando se asomó a la tumba abierta. Para María Magdalena no era evidente que Cristo había resucitado y que una Nueva Creación había comenzado. De hecho, ella asumió lo peor. María les dijo a Pedro y a Juan que al Señor se lo habían llevado y "no sabemos dónde lo habían puesto".

Todos luchamos con esta experiencia todos los días. Es comprensible. Todavía vivimos en un mundo turbulento, plagado de guerras, crueldad, odio, ataques a los inocentes e injusto. Pero Dios aun así ama al mundo. Murió por este mundo, y por todas las personas y criaturas que hay en el, sin excepción. Si bien podemos estar tentados a pensar que el mal tiene la sartén por el mango, es un hecho que el Bien ya ha ganado. "Señor, los impíos son como un sueño al despertar, y se disipan como sombras al levantarte" (Salmo 73:20).

Aunque los tiempos en que vivimos parezcan oscuros, el Resucitado dice: "He aquí, yo hago nuevas todas las cosas" (Apocalipsis 21:5). Todo está predicho en los antiguos textos de las Escrituras: "Cuando el sol se puso y cayó la oscuridad, un horno ardiente y una antorcha encendida pasaron entre las partes" (Génesis 15:17). Cristo ha resucitado. Su Luz brilla sobre todos, proyectando un resplandor de juicio y paz que resuelve todo y hace nuevas todas las cosas. "Ya no existirá la noche, ni les hará falta la luz de las lámparas ni la luz de sol, porque el Señor Dios los iluminará, y ellos reinarán por los siglos de los siglos." (Apocalipsis 22:5).

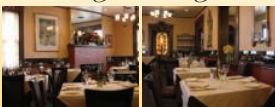
