How do you want to live? Do you want a family? Do you want a mission as a single person? In Aristotle's words, "What is a good life?" The Church asks the same question but with a twist, "What's your vocation?" "What's your *calling*?"

Young adults often ponder *careers*, as they should. College students ask, "What do I want to do after college?" Graduates ask, "What do I do now?" Good questions.

Take it to another level. What do you *have the grace to do*? "What I want to do" is a good question. But "what I have the grace to do" is a deeper question, potentially in agreement with "what I want to do". What "I want for me" is about your *career*. What "gift I have to give" is about your *vocation*. To be sure, "what you want" and "what you can give" are not necessarily opposites. Grace purifies "what you want" and turns it into generosity. You get back from what you give. That's how love works. Welcome to the wonderful world of being human!

There's no sharp dividing-line between *career* and *vocation*. But there's a difference. A vocation flows into a career, like a river into a desert. A career receives new life when you reflect and meditate in silence, making yourself available to the *grace of your Confirmation*. Confirmation turns Baptism into a vocation – Christ's mission.

A vocation transforms a career into a labor of love, a life-giving gift to the world. Without a vocation, a career becomes a lonely pit of "me and myself." A vocation transforms a career into act of love for God, family, neighbor, and the world. Vocations purge careers of selfishness. Vocations bless careers with generosity.

"What does it profit a man to gain the whole world and yet lose his soul" (Matthew 16:26)? Christ suggests vocation in the Greatest Commandment, "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind" and its sequel, "Love your neighbor as yourself" (Matthew 22:37-39). Our world needs *careers formed by vocations*.

Vocations create friendships and solidarity. Vocations are love in real time. Vocations are Christ in action, here and now, through your life. ***What's your calling?***

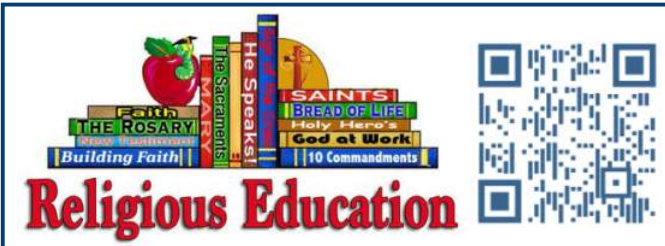

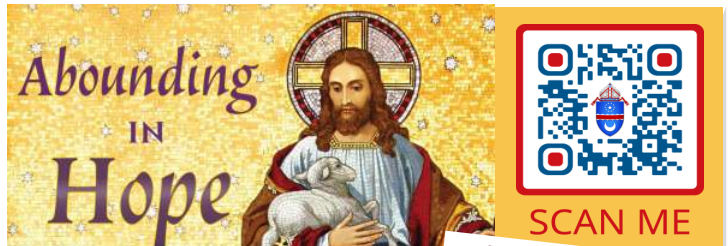
Our CCD catechism program for youth (grades pre-K to 8) seeks volunteer religion teachers for this upcoming school year.

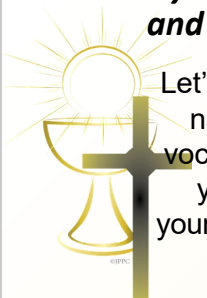

¿Que es una Buena Vida?

Algunas palabras para los graduados del 2025

¿Cómo quieres vivir? ¿Quieres una familia? ¿Quieres vivir tu misión como persona soltera? En las palabras de Aristóteles: "¿Qué es una buena vida?" La Iglesia hace la misma pregunta pero con un giro: "¿Cuál es tu vocación?" —¿Cuál es tu llamada?

Los adultos jóvenes reflexionan a menudo sobre *las carreras que quisieran seguir*. Los estudiantes universitarios, se preguntan: "¿Qué quiero hacer al salir de la universidad?" Cuando ya están graduados, se preguntan: "¿Qué hago ahora?" Ambas son buenas preguntas.

Toma esta reflexión a otro nivel. ¿Qué tienes *la gracia de hacer*? "Lo que quiero hacer" es una buena pregunta. Pero "lo que tengo la gracia de hacer" es una pregunta más profunda, que muy bien puede estar de acuerdo con "lo que quiero hacer". Lo que "quiero para mí" tiene que ver sobre tu *carrera*. El "don que tengo para dar" tiene que ver con tu *vocación*. "Lo que quieres" y "lo que puedes dar" no son necesariamente opuestos. La gracia purifica "lo que quieres" y lo convierte en un acto de generosidad. Lo que das a los otros, tu también lo recibirás. Así es como funciona el amor. ¡Bienvenidos al maravilloso mundo del ser humano!

No hay una línea divisoria nítida entre la *carrera* y la *vocación*. Pero si hay una diferencia. La vocación fluye en una carrera, como un río en un desierto. Una carrera se reaviva cuando reflexionas y meditas acerca de ella, haciéndote disponible a la *gracia de tu Confirmación*. La Confirmación convierte el Bautismo en una vocación— la misión de Cristo.

Una vocación transforma una carrera en una obra de amor, un regalo vivificante para el mundo. Sin vocación, una carrera se convierte en una fosa solitaria de "yo y yo mismo". La vocación transforma una carrera en un acto de amor a Dios, a la familia, al prójimo y al mundo. Las vocaciones purgan las carreras de egoísmo. Las vocaciones bendicen las carreras con generosidad.

"¿De qué le sirve al hombre ganar el mundo entero y perder su alma" (Mateo 16:26)? Cristo nos enseña que es vocación en el Mandamiento Más Grande que nos dio: "Amarás al Señor, tu Dios, con todo tu corazón, con toda tu alma y con toda tu mente" y su secuela, "Ama a tu prójimo como a ti mismo" (Mateo 22:37-39). Nuestro mundo necesita *carreras formadas por vocaciones*.

Las vocaciones crean amistades y solidaridad. Las vocaciones son actos de amor en tiempo real. Las vocaciones son Cristo en acción a través de tu vida, aquí y ahora. Reflexiona y pregunta **¿Cuál es tu vocación?**

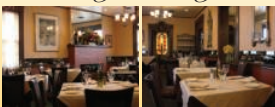
