Baptism makes a child.

Boys try dog food at ages eight or nine. Girls might try it too. Seven-year-olds are too interested in dogs. Ten-year-olds don't like gross experiments. Ages eight and nine are innocent, dirty, stinky, and unscientific. Unseriousness is key.

In my golden age, we had two dogs: Braniff and Woodstock. Braniff was half German Shepherd and half Something Else. Woodstock was an Australian Frump, said Dad. Dad bought fifty-pound sacks of *Field Trial* from Winn-Dixie to cheap-feed the dogs. Cornmeal wafts floated from the bag. Braniff downed it. Woodstock crunched it like her skull might crack. Woodstock begged at dinner, sitting upright to earn a sliver of *real meat*. When tossed meat, she snatched it like a catcher for the Yankees.

Timmy and I tried dog food in 3rd grade. *Field Trial* was cheap southern grit chunks, flavored with meat by-product. Crunching a chunk, doubts sank in. Timmy stared at me, crunching his chunk and concealing doubts. This was my first round, but not Timmy's. In his telling, he ate it all the time, though he spurned USDA surplus hot lunches at the school cafeteria.

Kids don't try cat food. It stinks. Dry cat food is boring, like Alpha Bits. Canned cat food smells toxic – like rotten fish, chicken, and liver. Alpo dog food, on the other hand, looked delicious like deviled ham. I felt hungry watching TV dogs wolfing down Alpo. I never felt that way watching TV cats apprehensively eating Fancy Feast. TV dogs reminded me of me at Burger King.

I ate a Milk Bone once. No witnesses. Woodstock didn't like them. She loved Liv-a-Snaps, "made with real liver." When darting around the backyard, she didn't return when called "Woodstock!!!" If I yelled "Liv-a-Snap!", she beelined home. Why was she ravenous about these little crackers? I tried one. Tasted like cardboard.

What does this have to do with the 5th Sunday of Easter? Nothing. Save for innocence. Baptism makes a child.

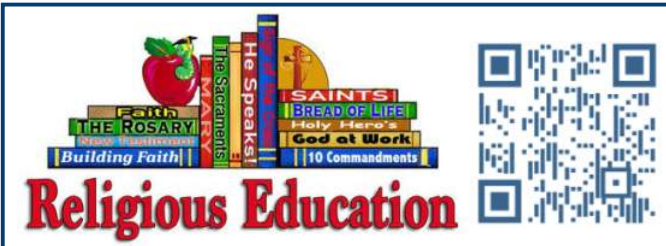

DID YOU KNOW?

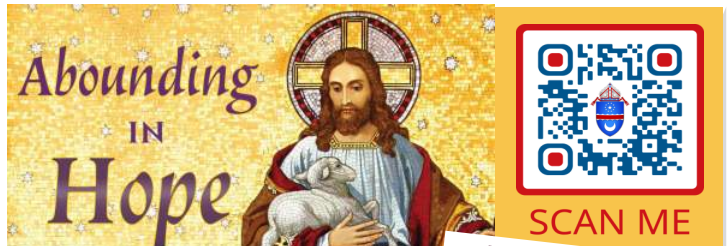

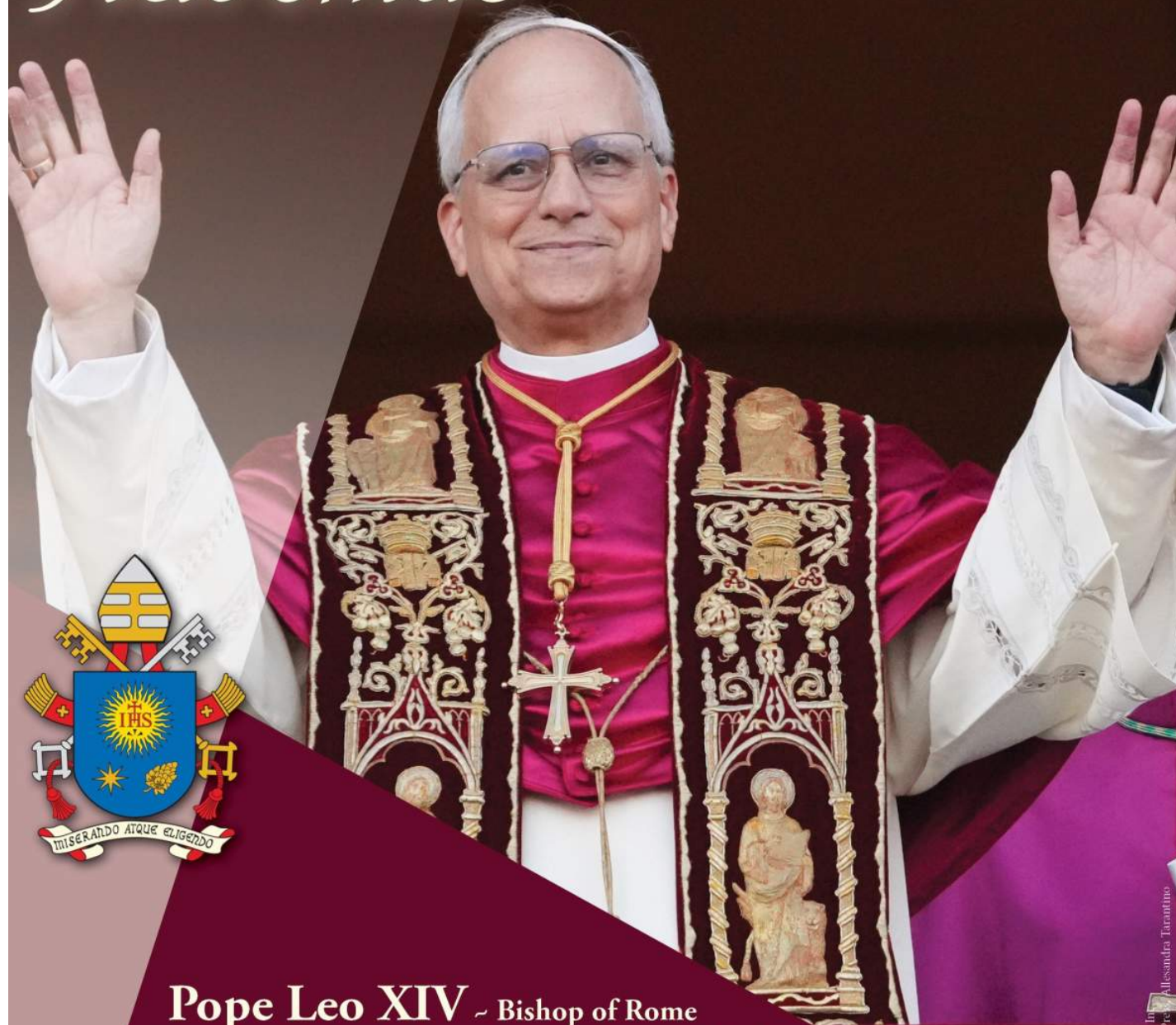

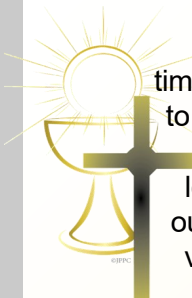

Reflexión: “Prueba la Comida para Perros”

“¿Cuándo aprenderemos que la infancia, en un gran sentido, no es simplemente una preparación para la vida adulta, sino algo único y completo en sí mismo, una obra maestra de Dios?”

(Carl Schmitt, artista estadounidense)

De niño, uno hace cosas muy intrépidas. A los 8 años, los niños prueban la comida para perros. Las niñas podrían intentarlo también. Los niños y niñas de 7 años tienen un interés desmedido en los perros. A los diez años, no hay interés por experimentos asquerosos. Entre los ocho y nueve años es una edad inocente, sucia, maloliente y poca científica. La informalidad es lo que predomina.

En mi época dorada, teníamos dos perros: Braniff y Woodstock. Braniff era mitad pastor alemán y mitad algo más. Mi papa decía que Woodstock era un Australiano Frump. Mi papa compraba bolsas baratas de comida de perro de cincuenta en la tienda Winn-Dixie para alimentar a los perros a bajo precio. Bocanadas de harina de maíz salían al abrir las bolsas. Braniff devoraba esta comida. Woodstock la masticaba de tal manera que parecía que su cráneo se iba a quebrar. Woodstock suplicaba por comida durante la cena, sentándose erguida para recibir un pedazo de carne de verdad. Cuando le tiraban la carne, la arrebatava como si fuera un catcher de los Yankees.

En 3er grado Timmy y yo probamos la comida para perros. Consistía en trozos de sémola de maíz, aromatizados con sub-productos de carne de bajo precio. Las dudas comenzaron cuando masticamos un pedazo. Timmy me miró fijamente, masticando su trozo y ocultando sus dudas. Esta era la primera vez para mí, pero no la de Timmy. Timmy contaba que él la comía todo el tiempo, pero rechazaba los almuerzos calientes excedentes que servía la cafetería de la escuela.

Los niños no prueban la comida para gatos. Huele mal. La comida seca para gatos no es interesante, como la de perros. La comida enlatada para gatos tiene un olor tóxico, como de pescado, pollo e hígado podrido. La comida para perros, por otro lado, se veía deliciosa como si fuera jamón del diablo. Yo sentía hambre viendo en la tele a los perros devorando su comida. Nunca sentía lo mismo viendo a los gatos en la televisión comiendo tímidamente su Fancy Feast. Los perros en la tele me recordaban a mí en Burger King.

Una vez comí un Milk bone. Sin testigos. A Woodstock no le gustaban. A ella le encantaban los Liv-a-Snaps, “hechos con auténtico hígado”. Cuando corría por el patio trasero, Woodstock no respondía cuando se le llamaba por su nombre, pero si uno gritaba “Liv-a-Snap!!”, ella regresaba directamente a la casa. Porque le gustaban tanto estas galletas? No lo sé. Yo probé una. Sabía a cartón.

Que tiene que ver todo esto con el quinto Domingo de Pascua? Nada. Salvo la inocencia. El bautismo hace al niño.
