Who was Pope Leo XIII? What's in the name?

Leo XIII, our new Holy Father's predecessor in name, was Pope from 1878-1903. The name "Leo XIV" says something about Robert Prevost's outlook. What was going on in Leo XIII's time? And what did he say about it?

In the late 19th century, industrial capitalism and trade boomed among Western powers and colonies. It was a "res novae" (new thing): a system based on finance, consumption, and the division of capital and labor. Working-class misery provoked new secular ideologies – often variants of Marxism and Liberalism – proposing various social paths to the future. A conflicted but brave new world was emerging.

Leo XIII confronted the res novae – including the "labor question" – in his groundbreaking 1891 encyclical *Rerum Novarum* ("On New Things", subtitled "Rights and Duties of Capital and Labor"). Incidentally, Leo XIII also laid the groundwork for modern Catholic teaching on religious liberty in his encyclicals *Immortale Dei* (1885) and *Libertas* (1888).

But *Rerum Novarum* was his signature document, influencing some Western policy makers, including President Roosevelt, well into the 20th century. For labor, it encouraged progressive alternatives to socialism during market upheavals. Popes in the 20th century often developed Catholic social doctrine from *Rerum Novarum*.

Pope Pius XI (1931): *Quadragesimo Anno* (40th anniversary, on *Reconstruction of the Social Order*). He addressed totalitarianism and conflicts between labor and capital, proposing labor-management cooperation and family wages. He proposed regulating trade and financial flows yet affirmed the right to private property as a contingent public good. He said *subsidiarity* should characterize relations between states and the private sector.

Pope Paul VI (1971): *Octogesima Adveniens* (80th anniversary). Addressed post-industrial social problems, including urbanization, youth, women, unemployment, discrimination, emigration, population, media, and ecology.

Pope John Paul II: *Laborem Exercens*, (1981, 90th anniversary) and *Centesimus Annus* (1991, 100th anniversary). He said that work is a fundamental human good and key to the "social question", and he highlighted the continuity in Catholic social doctrine since 1891. What Leo XIII called "friendship", Pius XI called "social charity", and Paul VI called "a civilization of love." John Paul II called it "solidarity", foreshadowing Pope Francis' 2020 encyclical *Fratelli Tutti* (*On Fraternity and Social Friendship*).

Recently, Pope Leo XIV suggested that artificial intelligence and social media raise new questions for labor, human dignity, and international relations. For Leo XIV, these comprise a "res novae" of our time

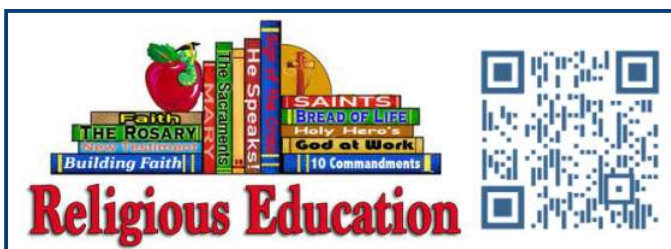

¿Quien fue el Papa León XIII? Que hay en un nombre?

León XIII, el nombre del predecesor de nuestro nuevo Santo Padre, fue Papa de 1878 a 1903. El nombre "León XIV" dice algo sobre el enfoque de Robert Prevost. ¿Qué paso en la época de León XIII? ¿Y qué dijo al respecto?

A finales del siglo XIX, el capitalismo industrial y el comercio florecieron entre las potencias y colonias occidentales. Era una *"res novae"* (cosa nueva): un sistema basado en las finanzas, el consumo y la división del capital y el trabajo. La pobreza de la clase obrera provocó nuevas ideologías seculares, a menudo variantes del marxismo y el liberalismo, que proponían varios caminos sociales hacia el futuro. Un nuevo mundo conflictivo pero valiente estaba emergiendo.

León XIII enfrentó al *res novae* -incluyendo "el tema del trabajo"- en su innovadora encíclica de 1891 *Rerum Novarum* ("Sobre las cosas nuevas", titulada "Derechos y deberes del capital y del trabajo"). Por cierto, León XIII también sentó las bases de la enseñanza católica moderna sobre la libertad religiosa en sus encíclicas *Immortale Dei* (1885) y *Libertas* (1888). Sin embargo, la *Rerum Novarum* fue su documento distintivo, que influenció a algunos políticos occidentales de mediados del siglo XX, incluyendo el presidente Roosevelt. En relación a los temas laborales, fomentó alternativas progresistas al socialismo durante las turbulencias del mercado. Los Papas del siglo XX a menudo planteaban la doctrina social católica a partir de la *Rerum Novarum*.

Papa Pío XI (1931): *"Quadragesimo Anno"* (40° aniversario, sobre la reconstrucción del orden social). Abordó el totalitarismo y los conflictos entre el trabajo y el capital, proponiendo la cooperación obrero-patronal y los salarios justos. Propuso regular el comercio y los flujos financieros, pero aseveró el derecho a la propiedad privada como un bien público natural. Dijo que el principio de la *subsidiariedad* debe caracterizar las relaciones entre el estado y el sector privado.

Papa Pablo VI (1971): *Octogesima Adveniens* (80 aniversario). Abordó los problemas sociales postindustriales, como la urbanización, la juventud, las mujeres, el desempleo, la discriminación, la emigración, la población, los medios de comunicación y la ecología.

Papa Juan Pablo II: *Laborem Exercens* (1981, 90° aniversario) y *Centesimus Annus* (1991, 100° aniversario). Dijo que el trabajo es un bien humano fundamental y clave para "el orden social", y destacó la continuidad en la doctrina católica social desde 1891. Lo que León XIII llamaba "fraternidad", Pío XI lo llamaba "caridad social" y Pablo VI lo llamaba "una civilización del amor". Juan Pablo II lo llamó "solidaridad", presagiando la encíclica *Fratelli Tutti* (Sobre la fraternidad y la amistad social) del Papa Francisco de 2020.

Recientemente, el Papa León XIV sugirió que la inteligencia artificial y las redes sociales plantean nuevas preguntas para el trabajo, la dignidad humana y las relaciones internacionales. Para León XIV, esto es el *"res novae"* de nuestro tiempo.
