From a letter by Saint Bernadette

I had gone down with two other girls to the river Gave when, suddenly, I heard a rustling sound. I turned toward the river's bank, but the trees were still. Then I saw a cave where I saw a lady wearing a lovely white dress with a bright belt. On top of each of her feet was a pale-yellow rose, the same color as her rosary beads.

I rubbed my eyes, thinking I was seeing things, and I put my hands into my dress' fold where my rosary was. I wanted to make the *Sign of the Cross* but, for the life of me, I couldn't manage, and my hand just fell. Then the lady made the *Sign of the Cross*. At the second attempt, I managed to do the same though my hands were trembling. I began to say the rosary as the lady's beads slipped through her fingers, without her moving her lips. When I stopped saying the Hail Mary, she vanished.

I asked my companions if they noticed anything, but they said no. They were curious. I told them I saw a lady wearing a white dress though I didn't know who she was. I told them not to say anything, and they said I was silly to have anything to do with it. I said they were wrong, and I came back next Sunday, feeling drawn to the place....

The third time I went, the lady spoke to me. She asked me to come every day for fifteen days. She wanted me to tell the priests to build a chapel there. She also told me to drink from the stream. She was not speaking of the Gave, and she indicated a little trickle of water nearby. I found a few drops, mostly mud. I cupped my hands to catch some liquid without success, and I scraped the ground. Only at the fourth attempt was there enough to drink. The lady then vanished, and I went home.

I returned daily for two weeks, and the lady told me to pray for the conversion of sinners. I asked what she meant by that, but she only smiled. Finally, with outstretched arms and eyes looking heavenward, she told me she was the Immaculate Conception.

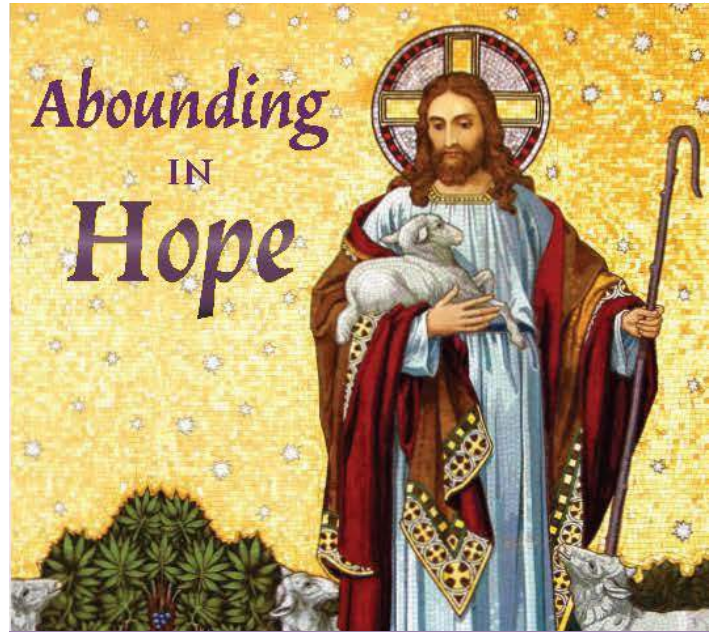

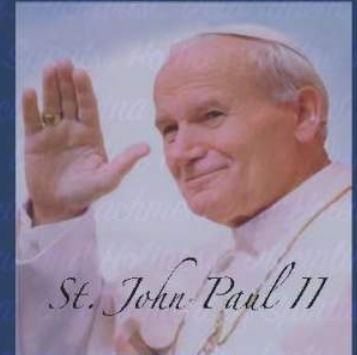
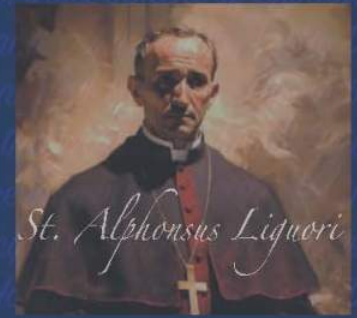

Texto de una carta de Santa Bernardita

Había bajado con otras dos chicas al río Gave cuando, de repente, escuché un crujido. Me volví hacia la orilla del río, pero los árboles estaban quietos. Entonces vi una cueva donde vi a una señora vestida en un precioso vestido blanco con un cinturón brillante. En la parte superior de cada uno de sus pies había una rosa de color amarillo pálido, del mismo color que las cuentas de su rosario.

Me froté los ojos, creyendo que estaba viendo cosas, y me froté mis manos en el pliegue de mi vestido donde estaba mi rosario. Quise hacer la *señal de la cruz* pero, por mucho que lo intentaba, no pude y mi mano simplemente se caía. Entonces la señora hizo la *señal de la cruz*. En el segundo intento, logré hacer lo mismo aunque me temblaban las manos. Comencé a rezar el rosario mientras las cuentas de la señora se deslizaban entre sus dedos, sin que ella moviera los labios. Cuando dejé de rezar el Ave María, ella desapareció.

Les pregunté a mis compañeras si habían notado algo, pero me dijeron que no. Mostraron curiosidad. Les dije que había visto a una señora con un vestido blanco, aunque no sabía quién era. Les dije que no dijeran nada, y me dijeron que era una tontería lo que estaba hablando. Les dije que estaban equivocadas, y regresé el domingo siguiente, sintiéndome atraída por el lugar....

La tercera vez que fui, la señora me habló. Me pidió que viniera todos los días durante quince días. Quería que les dijera a los sacerdotes que construyeran una capilla en ese lugar. También me dijo que bebiera del arroyo. No se refería al río Gave, sino que señaló un pequeño hilo de agua que corría en las cercanías. Encontré algunas gotas, pero más que todo era barro. Ahuequé mis manos para atrapar un poco de líquido sin éxito, y raspé el suelo. Solo en el cuarto intento recogí suficiente agua para beber. La señora desapareció y me fui a casa.

Regresé diariamente durante dos semanas, y la señora me dijo que rezara por la conversión de los pecadores. Le pregunté qué quería decir con eso, pero solo sonrió. Finalmente, con los brazos extendidos y los ojos mirando al cielo, me dijo que era la Inmaculada Concepción.
