

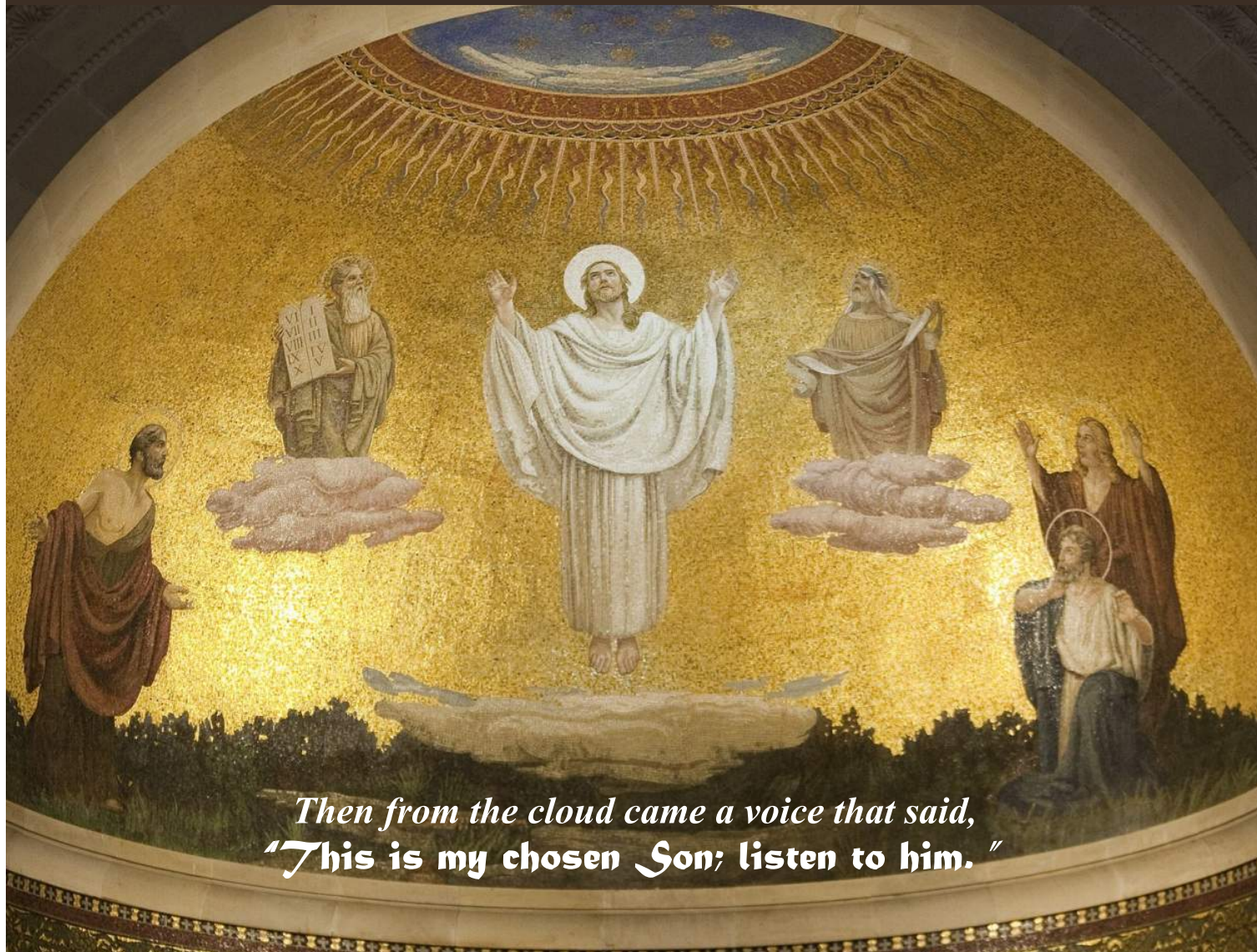

The Transfiguration

We know little about the 7th century monk Anastasius of Sinai. "Anastasius" is Greek for "Resurrection". Two Byzantine Emperors went by that name, as did four Popes, some Greek footballers, and a weight-lifter. None of them had the surname "of Sinai", the mountain where Moses received God's Law.

Anastasius of Sinai says Jesus' Transfiguration foretold his Resurrection. Why? To save the faith of Peter, James, and John, who would be in danger of losing it on Good Friday. Let's hear from Anastasius.

From a Sermon on the Transfiguration of the Lord by Anastasius of Sinai

Upon Mount Tabor, Jesus revealed to his disciples a heavenly mystery. While living among them he had spoken of the kingdom and of his second coming in glory, but to banish from their hearts any possible doubt concerning the kingdom and to confirm their faith in what lay in the future by its prefiguration in the present, he gave them on Mount Tabor a wonderful vision of his glory, a foreshadowing of the kingdom of heaven. It was as if he said to them: "As time goes by you may be in danger of losing your faith. To save you from this, I tell you now that some standing here listening to me will not taste death until they have seen the Son of Man coming in the glory of his Father." Moreover, in order to assure us that Christ could command such power when he wished, the evangelist continues: Six days later, Jesus took with him Peter, James and John, and led them up a high mountain where they were alone. There, before their eyes, he was transfigured. His face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as light. Then the disciples saw Moses and Elijah appear, and they were talking to Jesus...

Let us run with confidence and joy to enter the cloud like Moses and Elijah, or like James and John. Let us be caught up like Peter to behold the divine vision and to be transfigured by that glorious transfiguration. Let us retire from the world, stand aloof from the earth, rise above the body, detach ourselves from creatures and turn to the creator, to whom Peter in ecstasy exclaimed: "Lord, it is good for us to be here..."

What Is Reconciliation?

When we sin, we hurt ourselves by wounding our relationships with God and our neighbors. In the Sacrament of Reconciliation (also known as Confession or Penance), God offers us forgiveness of our sins, and we accept and receive God's forgiveness by sincerely expressing our sorrow, by acknowledging and making reparation for our sins, and by resolving to do better in the future.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation has four parts:

- ♦ **Contrition:** A sincere sorrow for having offended God, and the most important act of the person confessing. There can be no forgiveness of sin if we do not have sorrow and a firm resolve not to repeat our sin.
- ♦ **Confession:** Naming our sins - aloud - to the priest, who represents Christ and the Church.
- ♦ **Penance:** The prayers - or sometimes, the good deeds - the priest gives, for our healing and the healing of those we have hurt by our sins.
- ♦ **Absolution:** The words the priest speaks by which "God, the Father of mercies" reconciles us to himself through his death and resurrection.



Going to Confession



1. The priest gives a blessing or greeting.
2. Make the Sign of the Cross and say,
"Bless me father, for I have sinned.
My last confession was..." (give weeks, months, or years).
3. Confess all your sins to the priest.
(If you are unsure or uneasy, tell him and ask for help.)
4. Say, "I am sorry for these and all my sins."
5. The priest gives a penance and offers advice to help you become a better Catholic.
6. Say an Act of Contrition, expressing your sorrow for your sins.
7. The priest, acting in the person of Christ, then absolves you from your sins.

Act of Contrition



My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin.

Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us.

In his name, my God, have mercy.

Examination of Conscience

*Ask God to help you make a good confession.
In quiet reflection ask yourself: Since my last confession...*

- ♦ Did I pray to God, daily and from my heart?
- ♦ Did I live and witness to my Catholic faith, joyfully & courageously? Did I take God's name in vain? Did I curse anyone or make false oaths? Did I engage in superstitious or occult practices?
- ♦ Did I attend and participate actively at Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation? Did I fast & abstain on prescribed days?
- ♦ Did I respect people in authority? My employer? Did I honor my parents?
- ♦ Was I violent or unnecessarily aggressive (e.g., physically, verbally, psychologically, etc.) with anyone?
- ♦ Was I prideful, stubborn, or rude with anyone? Did I hold a grudge?
- ♦ Did I abuse alcohol, prescription medications, or illegal drugs? Did I overindulge in food?
- ♦ Did I consent to, recommend, advise, or actively take part in an abortion? Did I use abortifacient drugs?
- ♦ Did I view pornography, entertain lustful thoughts, conversations or actions?
- ♦ Was I unloving to my spouse? Did I engage in adulterous activity (e.g., sexual, emotional, virtual, etc.)? Did I use contraceptives?
- ♦ Was I neglectful of the spiritual, intellectual, emotional, or physical needs of my spouse, children, or family?
- ♦ Did I steal or damage another's property? Was I honest and just in my business relations? Did I waste time at work?
- ♦ Did I contribute to the needs of the spiritually and materially poor with my time and resources?
- ♦ Did I engage in gossip? Did I lie? Did I speak poorly of others? Did I judge anyone unfairly?
- ♦ Did I envy anyone? Was I jealous of others or covet another's belongings?

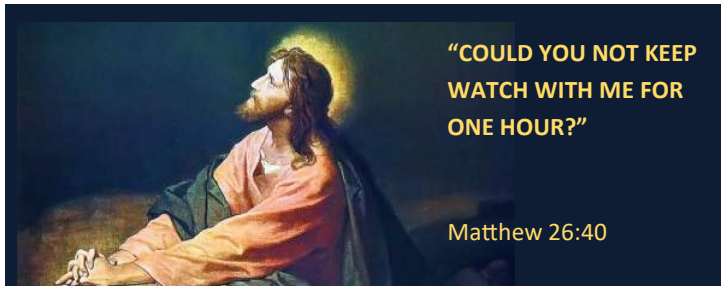

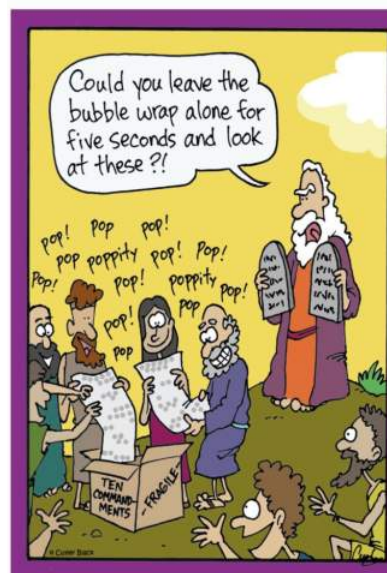

La Transfiguración

por el P. Frederick Edlefsen

Poco sabemos sobre el monje Anastasio del Sinaí, quien vivió en el siglo VII. "Anastasius" significa "resurrección" en griego. Dos emperadores bizantinos se hicieron llamar así, al igual que cuatro papas, algunos futbolistas griegos y un levantador de pesas. Ninguno de ellos tenía el título "del Sinaí", la montaña donde Moisés recibió la Ley de Dios.

Anastasio del Sinaí decía que la Transfiguración de Jesús fue una profecía de su propia resurrección, para salvar la fe de Pedro, Santiago y Juan, que estarían en peligro de perderla el Viernes Santo. Leamos a continuación las palabras de Anastasio...

Extracto de un sermón sobre la Transfiguración del Señor por Anastasio del Sinaí:

En el Monte Tabor, Jesús reveló a sus discípulos un misterio celestial. Mientras vivía entre ellos, les había hablado del reino y de su segunda venida gloriosa, pero para desterrar de sus corazones cualquier posible duda sobre el reino y afirmar su fe en lo que el futuro les esperaba, les dio una visión maravillosa de su gloria en el monte Tabor: una prefiguración del reino de los cielos. Con ella, es como si Jesús les dijera: "Pueden estar en peligro de perder la fe a medida que pasa el tiempo. Para salvarlos de esto, les digo ahora que algunos de los que están aquí escuchándome, no conocerán la muerte hasta que hayan visto al Hijo del Hombre venir en la gloria de su Padre". Y para asegurarnos de que Cristo podía ejercer tal poder cuando quisiera, el evangelio nos cuenta que seis días después, Jesús tomó consigo a Pedro, Santiago y Juan, y los llevó a la cima de una montaña donde estaban solos. Allí, ante sus ojos, se transfiguró. Su rostro brillaba como el sol, y sus ropas se volvieron blancas como la luz. Entonces los discípulos vieron aparecer a Moisés y a Elías hablando con Jesús...

Corramos con confianza y gozo para entrar en la nube como Moisés y Elías, o como Santiago y Juan. Dejémonos llevar, como Pedro, para contemplar la visión divina y ser transfigurados por esa gloriosa transfiguración. Alejémonos del mundo, alejémonos de lo terrenal, elevémonos por encima de nuestros deseos de la carne, liberémonos del pecado y volvámonos al Creador, a quien Pedro en éxtasis le dice: "Señor, es bueno que estemos aquí..."
