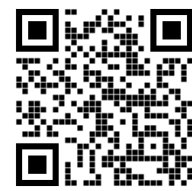

**What is the Holy Spirit's Gift of Understanding?**

Last week, I said that the Spirit's Gifts are subtle, supernatural "dispositions" given to us at Baptism. The Spirit's Gifts are like a ship's sails. They "catch the wind" of the Spirit's breath. "The Spirit blows where he wills..." (John 3:8). While Wisdom is the first Gift of the Spirit mentioned among seven, the Gift of Understanding is the second (see Isaiah 11:2-3).

Wisdom perfects *love*. Understanding perfects *faith*. When the Holy Spirit works through Understanding, we take to heart our Catholic faith. This includes the meaning of the narratives and letters of the Bible, the spiritual insights of sacred Tradition, and the teachings of the Creed and the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*. Understanding enlivens our "sense of the faith" (*sensus fidelium*), and it makes faith personal. For us, faith becomes more than lots of dry information in a catechism book or obscure Bible stories. Through Understanding, our Catholic faith become a life-giving fact of life.

Pray for Understanding before reading the Bible or the Catechism, and before attending Mass. Students should pray for Understanding before studying religion and even secular subjects. It helps us see all things through a living, real, and practical faith in Jesus Christ.

Through Understanding, the Holy Spirit enlightens our mind with intuitive insights into life's toughest issues. But watch out! Understanding powerfully impacts memory. It purifies our imagination. This can be a painful experience, at least for a while. Through Understanding, the Holy Spirit digs up "old bones," but with a twist. Old memories – good and bad – surface so we can see our lives through the serene and healing light of the risen Christ. Fear dissipates. Understanding teams up with Wisdom to resolve things. Understanding has healing properties that deepen our knowledge of life's experience and God's Word. Understanding blossoms in the Beatitude, "Blessed are the pure of heart, for they shall see God."

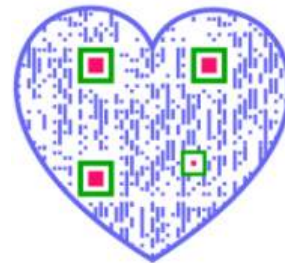

### ¿Cuál es el don de entendimiento del Espíritu Santo?

La semana pasada dije que los dones del Espíritu son "disposiciones" sutiles y sobrenaturales que se nos dan en el Bautismo. Los Dones del Espíritu son como las velas de un barco. Ellas "atrapan el viento" del aliento del Espíritu. "El Espíritu sopla donde quiere..." (Juan 3:8). Mientras que la Sabiduría es el primer Don del Espíritu entre los siete, el Don de Entendimiento es el segundo (ver Isaías 11:2-3).

La sabiduría perfecciona el *amor*. El entendimiento perfecciona la *fe*. Cuando el Espíritu Santo obra a través del entendimiento, tomamos en serio nuestra fe católica. Esto incluye el significado de las narraciones y epístolas de la Biblia, las perspectivas espirituales de la Sagrada Tradición y las enseñanzas del Credo y el *Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica*. El entendimiento aviva nuestro "sentido de la fe" (*sensus fidelium*), y hace que la fe sea personal. Para nosotros, la fe se convierte en algo más que mucha información insípida en un libro de catecismo o historias bíblicas aburridas. A través del entendimiento, nuestra fe católica se convierte en un hecho de vida que da vida.

Ore por entendimiento antes de empezar a leer la Biblia o el Catecismo, y antes de asistir a Misa. Los estudiantes también deben orar por entendimiento antes de estudiar religión e incluso temas seculares. El entendimiento nos ayuda a ver todas las cosas a través de una fe viva, real y práctica en Jesucristo.

A través del entendimiento, el Espíritu Santo ilumina nuestra mente con conocimientos intuitivos sobre los problemas más difíciles de la vida. ¡Pero cuidado! El entendimiento afecta poderosamente la memoria. Purifica nuestra imaginación. Esta puede ser una experiencia dolorosa, al menos por un tiempo. A través del entendimiento, el Espíritu Santo desentierra "huesos viejos", de una manera peculiar. Los viejos recuerdos, buenos y malos, surgen para que podamos ver nuestras vidas a través de la luz serena y sanadora de Cristo resucitado. El miedo se disipa. El entendimiento se une con la sabiduría para resolver cosas. El entendimiento tiene propiedades sanadoras que profundizan nuestro conocimiento de la vida y la Palabra de Dios. El entendimiento florece en la Bienaventuranza: "Bienaventurados los puros de corazón, porque ellos verán a Dios".
