Stewardship Reflection

"Rising very early before dawn, he left and went off to a deserted place, where he prayed...He told them, "Let us go on to the nearby villages that I may preach there also. For this purpose have I come." Mark 1:35,38

In today's Gospel reading we see a perfect example of stewardship. Jesus gives His time to do all that God wishes - healing the sick and preaching. But before He begins, Jesus takes time to be alone with God in prayer. It is through prayer, spending time with God, that we are given the graces needed to do what He wishes us to do.

Praying before acting is a great habit to develop.

WHAT IS FORTY HOURS DEVOTION?

“ Lord, teach us to pray: (Luke 11:1)

This week, Our Lady of Lourdes holds its annual Forty Hours Devotion. Forty Hours is a retreat for all parishioners and friends. It starts with Mass and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at 7:00 PM this Thursday, running through Saturday's 5:30 PM Vigil Mass. Forty Hours concludes with dinner in the Parish Hall, catered by the *Crystal City Sports Pub*, celebrating the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. Forty Hours' main feature is prayer and meditation before the Blessed Sacrament – “the source and summit of the Christian life” (*Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1324*). Forty Hours creates a continuous “sacrifice of praise” flowing from the Mass.

The Mass is our most important act of worship. Mass unites our lives to Christ's death and resurrection, known as the Paschal Mystery. Mass turns our lives into a continuous gift to the Father, through Jesus' sacrifice. All prayer flows from the sacrifice of the Mass, which is Christ's prayer. In other words, prayer, meditation, and Mass form a continuous “sacrifice of praise” that grows our relationship with God and one another. Charity is prayer's flower.

Why “forty” hours? In the Bible, “forty” signifies a sacred time. Rains fell for 40 days and nights in Noah's time. The Israelites journeyed 40 years in the desert after fleeing Egypt. Moses was twice on Mount Sinai for 40 days, receiving God's Covenant. The prophet Elijah journeyed 40 days and nights to Mount Horeb (Sinai), where he prayed until he heard God's “gentle whisper” (1 Kings 19:11-13). Jesus fasted and prayed in the wilderness for 40 days after his Baptism. There were 40 hours between Christ's burial and resurrection. There were 40 days between Christ's resurrection and ascension. Forty Hours Devotion connects us to these sacred events, forming a “continuous sacrifice of praise.”

The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed all day this Friday and Saturday. You are invited to meditate on the Bible and contemplate Christ's intimate presence in the Blessed Sacrament. Forty Hours Devotion concludes with a Solemn Vigil Mass of Our Lady of Lourdes at 5:30 PM this Saturday, followed by a procession of the Blessed Sacrament and a Dinner Celebration in the Parish Hall. CUARENTA HORAS DE DEVOCION

8-10 DE FEBRERO, 2024

“Señor, enséñanos a orar” (Lucas 11:1)

La devoción de Cuarenta Horas es un mini-retiro para toda la parroquia. Su característica principal es la oración y la meditación ante el Santísimo Sacramento, que es la “fuente y la cumbre de la vida cristiana”. Es una combinación de momentos para la oración privada (en silencio) y comunitaria. Cuarenta Horas crea un continuo “sacrificio de alabanza” que fluye de la Santa Misa. Todos están invitados a participar.



Las Cuarenta Horas, que comienza con la Misa a las 7:00 PM el jueves 8 de Febrero. El Santísimo Sacramento será expuesto esa noche, y nuevamente todo el día el viernes y el sábado entre misas.

¿Que es la Devoción de las Cuarenta Horas?

“Señor, enséñanos a orar” (Lucas 11:1)

Esta semana, Nuestra Señora de Lourdes celebra su Devoción anual de las Cuarenta Horas. Cuarenta Horas es un retiro para todos los feligreses y amigos. Comienza con la Misa y Adoración del Santísimo Sacramento a las 7:00 p.m. de este jueves, hasta la Misa de Vigilia del sábado a las 5:30 p.m. Cuarenta Horas concluye con una cena en el Salón Parroquial, preparada por la taverna *Crystal City Sports*, celebrando la Fiesta de Nuestra Señora de Lourdes. La característica principal de Cuarenta Horas es la oración y la meditación ante el Santísimo Sacramento, "la fuente y la cumbre de la vida cristiana" (*Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, 1324*). Cuarenta Horas crea un "sacrificio continuo de alabanza" que fluye de la Misa.

La Misa es nuestro acto de adoración más importante. La Misa une nuestras vidas a la muerte y resurrección de Cristo, llamado Misterio Pascual. La Misa convierte nuestra vida en una ofrenda continua al Padre, a través del sacrificio de su hijo Jesús. Toda oración fluye del sacrificio de la Misa, que es la oración de Cristo. En otras palabras, la oración, la meditación y la Misa forman un "sacrificio continuo de alabanza" que hace crecer nuestra relación con Dios y con los demás. La caridad es la flor de la oración.

¿Por qué "cuarenta" horas? En la Biblia, "cuarenta" significa un tiempo sagrado. Las lluvias cayeron durante 40 días y 40 noches en el tiempo de Noé. Los israelitas viajaron 40 años en el desierto después de huir de Egipto. Moisés estuvo dos veces en el Monte Sinaí durante 40 días, recibiendo la palabra de Dios. El profeta Elías viajó 40 días y 40 noches hasta el Monte Horeb (Sinaí), donde oró hasta que escuchó el "suave susurro" de Dios (1 Reyes 19:11-13). Jesús ayunó y oró en el desierto durante 40 días después de su bautismo. Pasaron 40 horas entre el entierro y la resurrección de Cristo. Hubo 40 días entre la resurrección y la ascensión de Cristo. La Devoción de las Cuarenta Horas nos conecta con estos eventos sagrados, formando un "sacrificio continuo de alabanza".

El Santísimo Sacramento estará expuesto todo el día viernes y sábado de esta semana. Te invitamos a meditar en la Biblia y a contemplar la presencia íntima de Cristo en el Santísimo Sacramento. La Devoción de las Cuarenta Horas concluye con una Misa de Vigilia Solemne de Nuestra Señora de Lourdes a las 5:30 PM de este sábado, seguida de una procesión del Santísimo Sacramento y una Cena de Celebración en el Salón Parroquial. Confirme su asistencia para la cena en nuestro sitio web o llamando a la Oficina Parroquial.

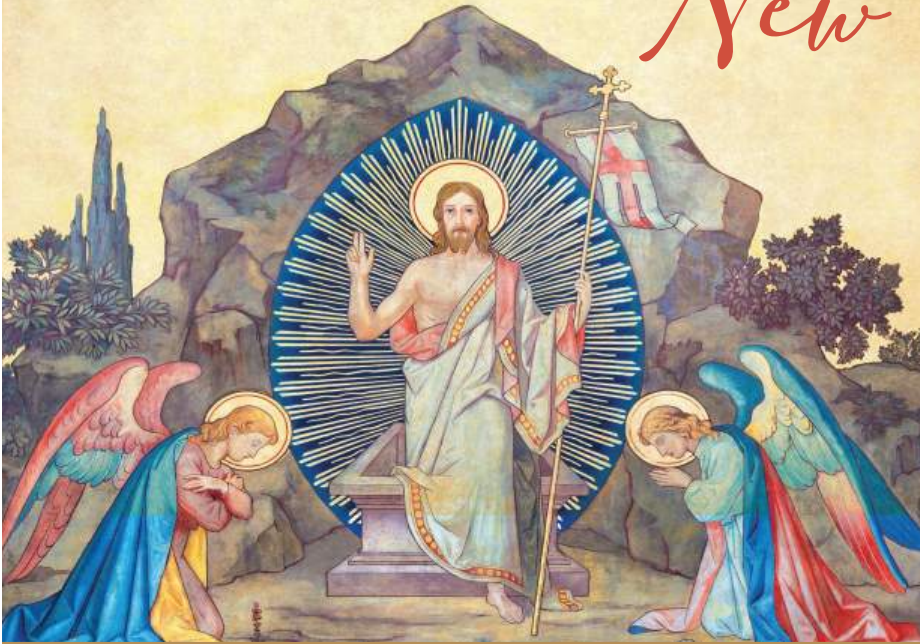
