

### BECOMING CATHOLIC & ADULT CONFIRMATION

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) is for adults age 18+ seeking the Sacraments of initiation: Baptism, Holy Communion, and Confirmation. Classes begin each fall, and Sacraments are received at the Easter Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday of the following year. ### SPONSORSHIP REQUIREMENTS

### **Baptism Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors**

- 1. Must be age 16 or older
- 2. Must not be the mother or father of the candidate
- Must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Communion, and Confirmation
- 4. If Married, must be sacramentally Married in (or with the permission of) the Catholic church
- 5. Must lead a life in keeping with the Catholic faith
