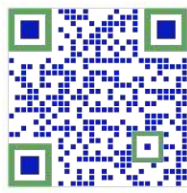

What is the Holy Spirit's Gift of Wisdom?

The Holy Spirit's Gifts are supernatural yet subtle "depositions" given at Baptism and more deeply at Confirmation, along with the "theological virtues" of faith, hope, and love. Wisdom is usually the first Gift mentioned among seven (Isaiah 11:2-3). The Gifts are not to be confused with virtues or good habits. Rather, like sails on a ship, the Gifts make us available and open to the breath of the Holy Spirit. "The Spirit blows where he wills..." (John 3:8).

Wisdom is the Gift by which we become intimate with Christ. When the Holy Spirit works through Wisdom, we are bonded more deeply in Jesus' friendship. This gives us supernatural insight because Jesus is the Word of the Father through whom everything is created. Pray for this Gift if you if you feel far from God, or when life gets anxious, confusing, or sad. Through Wisdom, the Spirit helps us deal with anxiety or fear. It awakens a supernatural outlook that can only come from God. When the Holy Spirit works through Wisdom, we may sense brief moments of God's closeness or peace. The experience may be like "savoring" God's presence: "Taste and see the goodness of the Lord" (Psalm 34:8).

Wisdom perfects love. It's a contemplative Gift that helps us pray. Wisdom blossoms in the Beatitude, "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called children of God."

"Dear Lord, grant me Wisdom, the attendant at your throne" (Book of Wisdom 9:4).

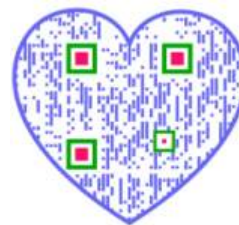

¿Cuál es el don de sabiduría del Espíritu Santo?

Los Dones del Espíritu Santo son "deposiciones" sobrenaturales pero sutiles dadas en el Bautismo y más profundamente en la Confirmación, junto con las "virtudes teologales" de la fe, la esperanza y el amor. La sabiduría es generalmente el primer don mencionado entre los siete (Isaías 11: 2-3). Los Dones no deben confundirse con virtudes o buenos hábitos. Más bien, como las velas en un barco, los Dones nos hacen disponibles y abiertos al aliento del Espíritu Santo. "El Espíritu sopla donde quiere..." (Juan 3:8).

La Sabiduría es el don por el cual nos volvemos íntimos con Cristo. Cuando el Espíritu Santo obra a través de la Sabiduría, estamos unidos más profundamente en la amistad de Jesús. Esto nos da una visión sobrenatural porque Jesús es la Palabra del Padre a través de la cual todo es creado. Ora para recibir el don de la Sabiduría si te sientes lejos de Dios, o cuando la vida se pone ansiosa, confusa o triste. Por medio de la Sabiduría, el Espíritu nos ayuda a lidiar con la ansiedad o el miedo. Este despierta una actitud sobrenatural que sólo puede venir de Dios. Cuando el Espíritu Santo obra a través de la Sabiduría, podemos sentir breves momentos de cercanía con Dios y paz. Esta experiencia puede parecer como "saborear" la presencia de Dios: "Prueben y vean la bondad del Señor" (Salmo 34: 8).

La sabiduría perfecciona el amor. Es un don contemplativo que nos ayuda a orar. La sabiduría florece en la Bienaventuranza: "Bienaventurados los pacificadores, porque serán llamados hijos de Dios".
"Amado Señor, concédeme la Sabiduría, que comparte tu trono" (Libro de Sabiduría 9:4).

Zeal□

Zeal, which St. Vincent once described as "the soul of all the virtues," is a passion for the full flourishing and eternal happiness of every person. We must be careful not to ever separate our zeal from our love of the neighbor, lest it become scolding, or what Bl. Frederic called "the proud pharisaism of an indiscreet zeal."
