# Preparing for Lent

- **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday:** Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 18. Fast and abstain from meat. Fasting is generally defined as two half-meals and one full meal. This may vary according to health and other circumstances.
- **Fridays in Lent:** No meat.
  - Fish Fry by the Knight of Columbus on February 20th and March 6 at 5:30 PM in the Parish Hall.
  - On all Fridays, we have Confessions at 7:00 PM & Stations of Cross at 7:30 PM.
- **Wednesdays in Lent (excluding Ash Wednesday):** Confessions are available every Wednesday in Lent from 6:30 - 8:00 PM at our Lady of Lourdes and at all parishes in the Diocese of Arlington and in the Archdiocese of Washington, DC.
- **Experience Lent:** Lent lasts 40 days, not counting Sundays. Moses passed 40 nights on a mount. So did Elijah. So did Jesus in the desert.
  - **Penance:** Voluntarily forego some legitimate pleasures. Be pleasant to people you dislike or disagree with. Avoid backhandedness. Grow in charity.
  - **Pray and Meditate:** Spend quiet time before the Blessed Sacrament or reading the Scriptures, especially the Gospel. Say a daily rosary. Say the Litany of Saints or a Litany of Loreto, daily.
  - **Read a Saint's Biography:** Good for Confirmation candidates.
- **Palm Sunday is on March 29:** Palm Sunday marks our entry into Holy Week.
- **The Chrism Mass is 11:00 AM at the Cathedral of St. Thomas More on Tuesday, March 31:** Celebrated by Bishop Burbidge with clergy. The bishop blesses the Oil of Catechumens (Holy Oil), Oil of the Sick, and the Sacred Chrism. Chrism will be used at baptisms, confirmations, and ordinations.
- **Mass of the Lord's Supper is on Holy Thursday, April 2, 7:00 PM:** This Mass begins the Sacred Triduum (three days) and commemorates the first Eucharist at the Last Supper. The "Washing of Feet" after the homily recalls Jesus' washing of the Apostle's feet, "For I gave you an example that you also should do as I did to you" (John 13:15). After Communion, the Eucharist is transferred to a repository in the Parish Hall so people can "stay with him" (Matthew 26:40-41). Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will be available until Midnight.
- **Good Friday, April 3:** Fasting and abstinence. Confessions from 1:30-3:00 PM. Come to the 3:00 PM Stations of the Cross and 7:00 PM Liturgy of the Lord's Passion and Death.




## Helping Hands

## Preparación para la Cuaresma

- **Miércoles de Ceniza y Viernes Santo:** La Cuaresma comienza el Miércoles de Ceniza, 18 de febrero. Ayuna y abstente de comer carne. El ayuno se define generalmente como dos comidas pequeñas y una comida completa. El contenido puede variar según la salud y otras circunstancias.
- **Viernes de Cuaresma:** No se come carne.
  - Fritura de pescado (Fish Fry) organizada por los Caballeros de Colón el 20 de febrero y el 6 de marzo a las 5:30 en el Salón Parroquial.
  - Confesiones a las 7:00 pm y Estaciones de la Cruz a las 7:30 pm.
- **Los miércoles de Cuaresma (excepto el Miércoles de Ceniza):** Las confesiones están disponibles todos los miércoles de Cuaresma de 6:30 a 8:00 pm en Nuestra Señora de Lourdes y en todas las parroquias de la Diócesis de Arlington y de la Arquidiócesis de Washington, DC.
- **Cómo vivir la Cuaresma:** La Cuaresma dura 40 días, sin contar los domingos. Moisés pasó 40 noches en un monte. Elijah también. Jesús lo hizo también en el desierto.
- **Penitencia:** Renuncia voluntariamente a aquellos placeres que disfrutas conscientemente. Sé amable con las personas que no te gustan o con las que no estás de acuerdo. Evita la revancha. Practica la caridad.
- **Ora y medita:** Pasa tiempo en silencio ante el Santísimo Sacramento o leyendo las Escrituras, especialmente el Evangelio. Reza un rosario diario. Reza la Letanía de los Santos o la Letanía de Loreto, a diario.
- **Lee la biografía de un santo:** es especialmente bueno para los candidatos a la Confirmación.
- **El Domingo de Ramos es el 29 de marzo:** este día marca nuestra entrada en la Semana Santa.
- **La Misa Crismal será a las 11:00 AM en la Catedral de Santo Tomás Moro el martes 31 de marzo:** celebrada por el obispo Burbidge junto con el clero de la Diócesis. El obispo bendice el Óleo de los Catecúmenos, el Óleo de los Enfermos y el Sagrado Crisma. El Crisma se utilizará en bautismos, confirmaciones y ordenaciones.
- **La Misa de la Cena del Señor es el Jueves Santo, 2 de abril, a las 7:00 pm:** Esta misa inicia el Sagrado Triduo (tres días) y conmemora la primera Eucaristía en la Última Cena. El "Lavado de los pies" después de la homilía recuerda el lavado de los pies de los apóstoles por parte de Jesús: "Porque les he dado el ejemplo para que hagan lo mismo que yo hice con ustedes" (Juan 13:15). Después de la Comunión, la Eucaristía se traslada al Salón Parroquial para que las personas puedan "quedarse con él" (Mateo 26:40-41). La Adoración del Santísimo Sacramento estará disponible hasta medianoche.
- **Viernes Santo, 3 de abril:** Ayuno y abstinencia. Confesiones de 1:30 a 3:00 pm. Ven al Via Crucis a las 3:00 pm y a la Liturgia de la Pasión y Muerte del Señor Jesucristo a las 7:00 PM.
