


## February's Light

### Our Lady of Lourdes in Brief

Light broke through winter's gloom on February 11, 1858, from the cave Massabielle along the Gave River near Lourdes, France.

Bernadette Soubirous was born into poverty on January 7, 1844, in a flour mill. She cried through her baptism. "She'll be a bad one," said her godfather. She suffered from stomach and breathing ailments. As a child, she was illiterate and spoke Occitan, not French. She tended bar at her aunt's tavern, famously offering free draughts of wine to friends, "Here! Drink this!" At thirteen, she did housework and tended sheep for relatives. "I'm bored," she said. "I want to prepare for my First Communion."

Cold was the rainy morning of February 11. "There's no wood!" The firewood that Bernadette collected had been sold for bread. She and two others headed to Massabielle to collect more. Before wading across the icy river, Bernadette was taking off her stockings when she heard a gush of wind. But the poplars were still. From the cave, a serene light radiated from a smiling woman, clad in white and yellow.

Bernadette was shaken and took out her rosary. The woman made the Sign of the Cross. Fear left Bernadette. The woman passed rosary beads through her fingers... then disappeared without a word. Bernadette called her, "Aquero," which in Occitan means, "the thing." Before March 25, the woman didn't reveal her identity in her apparitions. Who was Aquero?

On the Feast of the Annunciation, Bernadette visited Massabielle at 4:00 AM and saw Aquero. After four faltering asks, Aquero slipped her rosary over her right arm, unfolded her hands, extended them downward, then folded her hands upon her breast, raised her eyes to heaven, and said in Occitan: "Que soy era Immaculada Couchetsiou." "I am the Immaculate Conception."

Bernadette had no idea what that meant. She ran full speed to her Pastor's rectory, repeating the mysterious name to herself. Bursting through the door, she yelled, "Aquero said, 'Que soy era Immaculada Couchetsiou!'" Abbe Peyramale replied, "Do you know what that means?" The priest choked back his tears.

Bernadette thought, "If Abbe Peyramale doesn't know, who does?" That evening, a local tax collector, Jean-Baptiste Estrade, broke into tears when Bernadette told him what Aquero said. He explained it to her. Bernadette then knew it was the Virgin Mary, on the Feast of the Annunciation.



## La luz de febrero

Nuestra Señora de Lourdes - Un breve Resumen  
Por el padre Frederick Edlefsen

El 11 de Febrero de 1858, La luz atravesó la penumbra invernal desde una cueva llamada Massabielle a orillas del río Givé, cerca de Lourdes, Francia.

Bernadette Soubirous nació en la pobreza el 7 de enero de 1844, en un molino harinero. Lloró durante su bautizo. "Será un problema", dijo su padrino. Sufrió problemas estomacales y respiratorios. De niña, era analfabeta y hablaba occitano, no francés. Atendía la taberna de su tía, ofreciendo famosamente vino gratis a sus amigas. "¡Aquí! ¡Bebe esto!" A los trece años, hacía las tareas domésticas y cuidaba ovejas para familiares. "Estoy aburrida", dijo. "Quiero prepararme para mi Primera Comunión."

Fría fue la lluviosa mañana del 11 de febrero. "¡No hay madera!" La que Bernadette recogía se había vendido para comprar pan. Ella y otras dos personas se dirigieron a Massabielle para recoger más leña. Antes de cruzar el río helado, Bernadette se estaba quitando las medias cuando oyó una ráfaga de viento. Pero los álamos seguían quietos. Desde la cueva, una luz serena se veía resplandecer de una mujer sonriente, vestida de blanco y amarillo.

Bernadette se conmovió y sacó su rosario. La mujer hizo la Señal de la Cruz. El miedo abandonó a Bernadette. La mujer pasó las cuentas del rosario entre sus dedos... Luego desapareció sin decir palabra. Bernadette la llamaba "Aqero", que en occitano significa "la cosa". Antes del 25 de marzo, la mujer no reveló su identidad en sus apariciones. ¿Quién era Aqero?

En la Fiesta de la Anunciación, Bernadette visitó Massabielle a las 4:00 de la mañana y vio a Acuero. Tras cuatro peticiones vacilantes, Aqero deslizó el rosario sobre su brazo derecho, descruzó las manos, las extendió hacia abajo, luego las entrelazó sobre el pecho, alzó la mirada al cielo y dijo en occitano: "Que soy era Immaculada Couchetsiou." "Soy la Immaculada Concepción."

Bernadette no tenía ni idea de lo que eso significaba. Corrió a toda velocidad hacia la rectoría de su pastor, repitiendo el misterioso nombre. Al entrar por la puerta, ella gritó: "Aqero dijo, ¡Que soy era Immaculada Couchetsiou!" El abad Peyramale respondió: "¿Sabes lo que eso significa?" El sacerdote contuvo las lágrimas.

Bernadette pensó: "Si el abad Peyramale no lo sabe, ¿quién lo sabe?" Esa noche, un recaudador de impuestos local, Jean-Baptiste Estrade, empezó a llorar cuando Bernadette le contó lo que había dicho Aqero. Se lo explicó. Bernadette supo entonces que era la Virgen María, en la Fiesta de la Anunciación.
