



# Pope John XXIII & Peace on Earth

A Brave New Vision for International  
Cooperation

Join us Tuesday for a "Pizza with the Pope" at 7:00 PM in the Parish Hall. Thanks to the Knights of Columbus hosting.

Pope John XXIII proposed a new vision of international cooperation. His April 11, 1963 letter, *Pacem in Terris (Peace on Earth)*, broke new ground. It was addressed to "all people of goodwill," a response to the Cuban Missile Crisis when the US and USSR came close to nuclear war. The Crisis was not just about the Cold War. It was about "uneven development" among nations. Since then, the Church has engaged the world on this issue.

From 1945-1960, thirty-six former colonies became new nations. And more were coming. John XXIII proposed revamping the United Nations so that, "Every human being can find in this organization an effective safeguard of his personal rights; those rights...which derive directly from his dignity as a human person, and which are universal, inviolable and inalienable." People are increasingly "conscious of being living members of the universal family of mankind." Nation-states cannot go it alone. Peace and development require cooperation among nations. The "moral order" demands it, he said.

We need international agreements to address the "rights of nations," "the same law of nature that governs the life and conduct of individuals must also regulate the relations of political communities." Moreover, John XXIII said more-developed nations must make greater contributions to the "common cause of social progress." Peace equals social progress and development. The Pope's vision: invent a new "Statecraft."

Nations "going it alone" equals anarchy. A healthy nation hides not from the world nor pushes it away. Rather, a healthy nation seeks opportunities to collaborate and prosper. This new "Statecraft" requires tedious patience in cultivating solidarity – in prayer, thought, study, human interaction, and negotiation. It's exhausting work with setbacks. But it's a work of grace. It's worth it.

**To our young adults: Re-imagine a better world.** The faults and failures of the past are not reasons to give up. On the contrary, they are reasons to reinvent a brave new vision and pursue a brave new effort. A better world is possible. Pope John XXIII is a saint and a prophet. See you Tuesday at 7:00 PM.



## The Light is On For You *Celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation*

### Why Go To Confession?

God loves each of us. We have been created by God and placed in this world to know, love, and serve Him. Unfortunately, we do not always show our love for God in our words and actions. There are times when we turn away from God. These moments when we chose to do wrong or avoid what is good are sins. The good news is that God has given us a way to turn back to Him with our whole heart. He has given us the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

### The Steps of Confession:

1. The priest gives a blessing or greeting.
2. Make the Sign of the Cross and say, "Bless me father, for I have sinned. My last confession was..." (give weeks, months, or years).
3. Confess all your sins to the priest. (If you are unsure or uneasy, tell him and ask for help.)
4. Say, "I am sorry for these and all my sins."
5. The priest gives a penance and offers advice to help you become a better Catholic Christian.
6. Say an Act of Contrition, expressing your sorrow for your sins.
7. The priest, acting in the person of Christ, then absolves you from your sins.



## Papa Juan XXIII y Paz en la Tierra

Una nueva visión valiente para la cooperación internacional

Únete a nosotros el martes para una presentación "Pizza con el Papa" a las 7:00 pm en el Salón Parroquial. Gracias a los Caballeros de Colón por organizarla.

El Papa Juan XXIII propuso una nueva visión de cooperación internacional. Su encíclica del 11 de abril de 1963, *Pacem in Terris* (*Paz en la Tierra*), abrió nuevos caminos. Estaba dirigida a "todas las personas de buena voluntad": una respuesta a la Crisis de los Misiles en Cuba cuando Estados Unidos y la URSS estuvieron cerca de una guerra nuclear. La Crisis no fue sólo sobre la Guerra Fría. Se trataba también del "desarrollo desigual" entre naciones. Desde entonces, la Iglesia ha dialogado con el mundo sobre este tema.

Entre 1945 y 1960, treinta y seis antiguas colonias se convirtieron en nuevas naciones. Y más estaban en crearse. Juan XXIII propuso reformar las Naciones Unidas para que "todo ser humano pueda encontrar en esta organización una protección eficaz de sus derechos individuales; esos derechos... que se derivan directamente de su dignidad como persona humana, y que son universales, inviolables e inalienables". La gente está cada vez más "consciente de ser miembros vivos de la familia humana universal". Las Naciones-Estados no pueden hacerlo por sí solas. La paz y el desarrollo requieren cooperación entre naciones. El "orden moral" lo exige, decía Juan XXIII. Necesitamos acuerdos internacionales para abordar los "derechos de las naciones". "La misma ley de la naturaleza que rige la vida y conducta de los individuos debe también regular las relaciones de las comunidades políticas", afirmó. Además, Juan XXIII dijo que las naciones más desarrolladas deben hacer mayores contribuciones a la "causa común del progreso social". La paz resulta del progreso y desarrollo social. La visión del Papa: inventar una nueva "Gobernación".

Naciones que "gobiernan por su cuenta" equivale a la anarquía. Una nación sana no se esconde del mundo ni lo aleja. Más bien, una nación sana busca oportunidades para colaborar y prosperar. Esta nueva "gobernación" requiere una paciencia tediosa para cultivar la solidaridad: en la oración, el pensamiento, el estudio, la interacción humana y la negociación. Es un trabajo agotador con contratiempos. Pero es una obra de gracia. Merece la pena.

A nuestros jóvenes adultos: Reimaginen un mundo mejor. Los defectos y fracasos del pasado no son motivos para rendirse. Al contrario, son razones para reinventar una nueva visión y perseguir un nuevo esfuerzo valiente. Un mundo mejor es posible. El Papa Juan XXIII es un santo y un profeta. Nos vemos el martes a las 7:00 pm.
