Ozark Airlines
A Boy's Lesson on Christ's Ascension

In the 1970s, we occasionally went to New Orleans airport for travel or meeting Grandma. With a boy's eye, I inspected the logos and names on the planes. Most suggested destinations, like Eastern, Southern, Texas International, Delta, Piedmont, and United (I assumed United just meant it went everywhere).

My fifth-grade imagination took off. Where did that DC-9 called Ozark go? I looked up "Ozark" at the end of the "O" section in our World Book Encyclopedia. I learned of a new world. Ozark was a mountain range, about 500 miles north-northwest of homebase, in exotic frontier lands called Arkansas and Missouri. At dinner, I asked Dad how the Ozark Mountains got their name. Always a comedian, he said their first explorer was a guy named Zark, whose helper cried out "Oh Zark!" when he first laid eyes on the mountains. Fact check: Hernando de Soto first explored the Ozarks in 1540s. His Iberian pigs were razorback progenitors. "Ozark" derives from the French "aux Arcs" ("to Arkansas"), an old trading post. What lies beyond horizons fearfully invites discovery. It's like birth. We're launched into the Uncertain. When we pass from Mom's womb, we cry and scream, "What's out there?" Every child confronts an unknown world. Our final birth, a passage from the womb of a familiar Earth into the world of an unfamiliar Heaven, is what we call death.

Inevitable facts provoke questions. What's beyond death? Christian faith says there's "a new heaven and new earth." What's that? Our reassurance is Christ's Ascension.

"Christ did not enter a sanctuary made with human hands that was only a copy of the true one; he entered heaven itself, now to appear for us in God's presence" (Hebrews 9:24). "He was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight" (Acts 1:9). What's the "cloud"? The "cloud" through which Christ ascends and returns is a veil through which human knowledge, exploration, and conquest cannot pass. Human achievement cannot penetrate it. No one can claim what lies beyond it. Only Christ does that, on our behalf. All who are "in Christ" by way of Grace may pass through this "cloud" into the New World.

I once watched a DC-9 named Ozark pass into a cloud. I was a boy, watching a mystery go to a mystery. And it would return.



Aerolíneas Ozark

Una lección de niño sobre la ascensión de Cristo

En la década de 1970, ocasionalmente íbamos al aeropuerto de Nueva Orleans para viajar o ir a visitar a la abuela. Con ojos de niño, inspeccionaba los logotipos y los nombres de las aerolíneas. La mayoría de estos nombres daban una idea de su destino, cómo Eastern, Southern, Texas International, Delta, Piedmont y United (yo asumía que United quería decir que esta aerolínea iba a todas partes).

Mi imaginación de quinto grado se ponía a trabajar. ¿A dónde irá ese aeroplano tipo DC-9 llamado Ozark? Me puse a buscar la palabra "Ozark" al final de la sección "O" en nuestra Enciclopedia Mundial y aprendí de un mundo nuevo. Ozark era una cadena montañosa, a unas 500 millas al norte-noroeste de donde yo vivía, en tierras lejanas y exóticas llamadas Arkansas y Missouri. En la cena, le pregunté a papá cómo las montañas Ozark obtuvieron su nombre. Mi padre, siempre comediante, me dijo que el primer explorador de estas montañas se llamaba Zark, y su ayudante, cuando vio por primera vez las montañas, le gritó "¡Oh, Zark!"

Hechos históricos: Hernando de Soto exploró por primera vez las montañas Ozarks en la década de 1540. Los cerdos ibéricos que trajo en sus viajes fueron los progenitores de los cerdos que habitan en Norteamérica. La palabra "Ozark" se deriva del francés "aux Arcs" ("a Arkansas"), que se refería a un antiguo centro comercial.

Lo que hay más allá de los horizontes invita temerosamente, al descubrimiento. Es igual que el nacer. Nos lanzamos a lo incierto. Cuando salimos del vientre de nuestras madres, lloramos como si gritáramos: "¿Qué hay ahí fuera?" Cada niño se enfrenta a un mundo desconocido. Nuestro nacer final, el paso desde el vientre del mundo terrenal al mundo de un Cielo desconocido, es lo que llamamos la muerte.

Los hechos inevitables provocan preguntas. ¿Qué hay más allá de la muerte? La fe cristiana dice que hay "un cielo nuevo y una tierra nueva". ¿Qué es eso? Nuestra certeza es la Ascensión de Cristo.

"Cristo no entró en un santuario hecho por manos humanas que no era más que una figura del auténtico Santuario; sino que entró en el cielo mismo, para presentarse delante de Dios en favor nuestro" (Hebreos 9:24). "Lo vieron elevarse; y una nube lo ocultó de la vista de ellos" (Hechos 1:9). ¿Qué es la "nube"?

La "nube" a través de la cual Cristo asciende y regresa al Cielo es un velo a través del cual el conocimiento, la exploración y la conquista humanas no pueden pasar. Los logros humanos no pueden penetrarlo. Nadie puede reclamar lo que hay más allá de él. Solo Cristo lo puede hacer, en nuestro nombre. Todos los que viven "en Cristo" por medio de Su gracia, podrán pasar a través de esta "nube" hacia el Nuevo Mundo.

Una vez vi a un aeroplano llamado Ozark pasar por una nube. Yo era un niño, viendo cómo un misterio pasaba por otro misterio. Y volverá a pasar nuevamente,
