A Funny Thing About the Trinity
Skunks and Evolution
By Fr. Frederick Edlefsen

“Until the 1960s, all of the spotted skunks found across the United States were considered to be the same species. Then Rodney Mead, a graduate student at the University of Montana, began looking at their reproductive biology and discovered something startling. Populations living in the western United States exhibited delayed implantation, breeding in late September and delaying their pregnancies so they could give birth in May. Yet spotted skunks found in states east of the Continental Divide bred in March, exhibited no delay, and gave birth in June. Thus, the eastern and western populations were reproductively isolated. With this information, Mead classified two species: ‘Spilogale gracilis’ in the west and ‘S. putorius’ in the east.” (Montana Outdoors, March-April 2016, p. 24)

New discoveries are amazing. They push back the frontiers of ignorance. Discovering that there are two skunk species, not just one, makes me wonder about the researcher. How did this affect his love life? One false move in the lab and Friday’s romance is over. Did he stock up on tomato juice? If married, did his wife understand “for better or for worse”? Nonetheless, Rodney Mead’s research advanced our knowledge about Natural Selection.

Textbooks say Natural Selection is “the process whereby organisms better adapted to their environment tend to survive and produce more offspring,” which underpins evolution. Therefore, American skunks have evolved into two species for mere survival.

This suggests something amazing: the creative dynamics of the Trinity. God – three “consubstantial” Persons – is in no hurry to make or morph anything. He just lets Mother Nature do her thing in Natural Selection. The Catechism of the Catholic Church calls this “secondary causality” (CCC 306-308), which is an aspect of Providence. Meanwhile, humans like Rodney Mead try to figure it out.

But Natural Selection doesn’t explain Rodney Mead. He went against Natural Selection to discover something new about Natural Selection. Something else must be going on in an intelligent man who studies skunks.

The Trinity is a creative trio of Eternal Persons, “consubstantial” in One Nature of love, intelligence, and freedom. Humans are embodied spirits that cannot be explained by Natural Selection. Evolution may explain something about matter, but it has nothing to say about spirits. We create because the Trinity creates. We contemplate because the Trinity contemplates. We are free, in the Trinity’s image and likeness.

A valid driver's license, proficiency in English, and the ability to lift up to 20 lbs. are required. Knowledge of food preparation, handling, and safety is essential. All employees are required to provide I-9 documentation.

- **ALTER SERVERS** are youths who ensure the liturgy flows smoothly during Masses.

- **MONEY COUNTERS** steward the offertory collections by working in teams of three or more.

- **SACRISTANS** assist before Mass to prepare the sanctuary for worship.

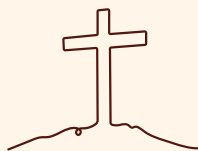

Una Cosa Curiosa Acerca de la Trinidad

Los zorrillos y la evolución
por el P. Frederick Edlefsen

"Hasta la década de 1960, todos los zorrillos manchados que se encontraban en los Estados Unidos se consideraban de la misma especie. Entonces, Rodney Mead, un estudiante de posgrado de la Universidad de Montana, comenzó a estudiar su biología reproductiva y descubrió algo sorprendente. Las poblaciones de zorrillos que viven en el oeste de los Estados Unidos mostraron un retraso en su gestación, apareándose a fines de septiembre y retrasando su gestación para poder dar a luz en mayo. Sin embargo, los zorrillos manchados que se encuentran al este de la Divisoria Continental se aparean en marzo, no mostraron demora en su gestación, y dieron a luz en junio. Por lo tanto, las poblaciones de ambas regiones quedaron aisladas reproductivamente. Con esta información, Mead clasificó dos especies: 'Spilogale gracilis' en el oeste y 'S. putorius' en el este". (Montana Outdoors, March-April 2016, p. 24)

Los nuevos descubrimientos son asombrosos. Hacen retroceder las fronteras de la ignorancia. Descubrir que hay dos especies de zorrillos, no solo una, me hace preguntarme sobre el investigador. ¿Cómo le afectó esto en su vida amorosa? Un movimiento en falso en el laboratorio, un spray fétido del zorrillo y hubiera quedadoapestoso. Su cita romántica del viernes cancelada, y si estaba casado, quién sabe si la esposa lo aceptaría en la casa con tan mal olor. Sin embargo, la investigación de Rodney Mead avanzó en nuestro conocimiento sobre la selección natural.

Los libros de texto dicen que la selección natural es "el proceso por el cual los organismos mejor adaptados a su entorno tienden a sobrevivir y producir más descendencia", lo cual es la base de la evolución. Por lo tanto, los zorrillos estadounidenses han evolucionado en dos especies por razones de supervivencia.

Esto sugiere algo sorprendente: la dinámica creativa de la Trinidad. Dios, tres Personas "consustanciales", no tiene prisa por hacer o transformar nada. Simplemente deja que la Madre Naturaleza haga lo suyo en la selección Natural. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica llama a esto "causalidad secundaria" (CIC 306-308), que es un aspecto de la Divina Providencia. Sere humanos, como Rodney Mead, Mientras, tratan de resolver este proceso.

Pero la selección natural no explica lo que hizo Rodney Mead. Su investigación para descubrir algo nuevo acerca de la selección natural fue en contra de la selección natural. Algo más tiene que estar sucediendo en el caso de un hombre inteligente que estudia a los zorrillos.

La Trinidad es un trío creativo de Personas Eternas, "consustanciales" de la misma naturaleza en amor, inteligencia y libertad. Los humanos son espíritus encarnados que no pueden ser explicados por la selección natural. La evolución puede explicar algo acerca de la materia, pero no tiene nada que decir acerca de los espíritus. Nosotros creamos porque la Trinidad crea. Contemplamos porque la Trinidad contempla. Somos libres, a imagen y semejanza de la Trinidad.
