How does the Holy Spirit work through Virtues, Gifts, and Beatitudes?

We cannot pigeonhole how God works. But spiritual masters through the centuries have identified particular Gifts of the Spirit that are likely to perfect certain virtues and produce certain Beatitudes. Here is the flow that St. Thomas Aquinas identifies:

- + **The Gift of Wisdom:** Perfects Charity (Love). **Fruit:** Blessed are the peacemakers, they shall be called children of God.
- + **The Gift of Understanding:** Perfects Faith. **Fruit:** Blessed are the pure of heart, they shall see God.
- + **The Gift of Knowledge:** Perfects Temperance. **Fruit:** Blessed are the sorrowful, they shall be consoled.
- + **The Gift of Counsel:** Perfects Prudence. **Fruit:** Blessed are the merciful, they shall receive mercy.
- + **The Gift of Piety (Gratitude):** Perfects Justice. **Fruit:** Blessed are the meek, they shall inherit the land.
- + **The Gift of Fortitude:** Perfects Courage. **Fruit:** Blessed are those who thirst for justice, they shall be satisfied.
- + **The Gift of Fear of the Lord:** Perfects Hope. **Fruit:** Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven.

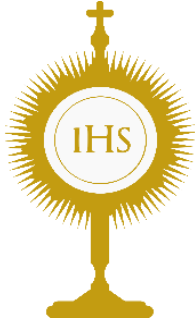
Some saints have made different connections. Some say Temperance is perfected by Fear of the Lord. Feel free to "experiment" with this in prayer. Play around with what you ask God for in the way of virtues and Gifts. Mix and match the virtues and Gifts you pray for to see if you get a new Beatitude, like a fourth grader experimenting with a chemistry kit to see what explodes. There is no need to stick to a "program." The Spirit works differently in everyone and is generally not fond of programs. He is a bag of surprises.

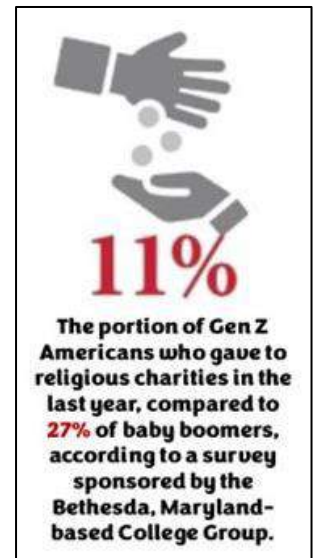


SAVE THE DATE: KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS BREAKFAST

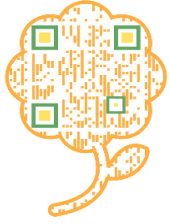

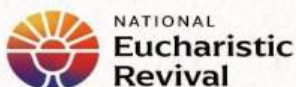

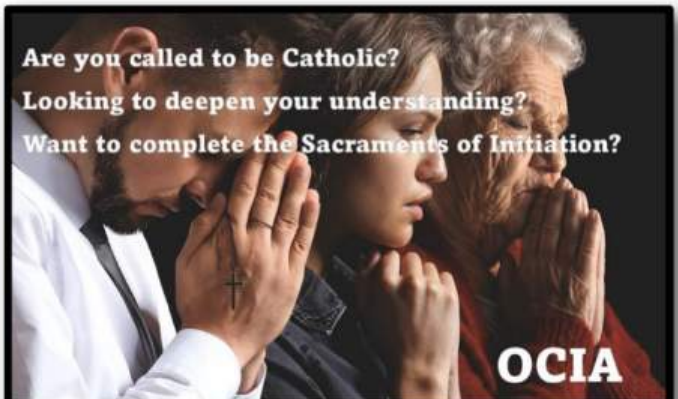

¿Cómo obra el Espíritu Santo? a través de virtudes, dones y bienaventuranzas?

No podemos encasillar cómo obra Dios. Pero a través de los siglos, los gran maestros espirituales han identificado cuales Dones del Espíritu probablemente perfeccionan ciertas virtudes y producen ciertos frutos o Bienaventuranzas. Santo Tomás de Aquino identifica las siguientes relaciones entre los Dones y sus Frutos:

- + **El Don de la Sabiduría:** perfecciona la caridad (amor). **Fruto:** Bienaventurados los pacificadores, ellos serán llamados hijos de Dios.
- + **El Don del Entendimiento:** perfecciona la fe. **Fruto:** Bienaventurados los puros de corazón, ellos verán a Dios.
- + **El Don del Conocimiento:** perfecciona la templanza. **Fruto:** Bienaventurados los afligidos, ellos serán consolados.
- + **El Don del Consejo:** perfecciona la prudencia. **Fruto:** Bienaventurados los misericordiosos, ellos recibirán misericordia.
- + **El Don de la Piedad (gratitud):** perfecciona la justicia. **Fruto:** Bienaventurados los mansos, ellos heredarán la tierra.
- + **El Don de la Fortaleza:** perfecciona el coraje. **Fruto:** Bienaventurados los que tienen sed de justicia, ellos serán satisfechos.
- + **El Don del Temor del Señor:** perfecciona la esperanza. **Fruto:** Bienaventurados los pobres de espíritu, de ellos será el Reino de los Cielos.

Otros santos han hecho conexiones diferentes. Algunos dicen que la templanza perfecciona el temor al Señor. Cuando ore, siéntase libre de "experimentar" y probar con lo que le pides a Dios en cuanto a virtudes y dones. Combina en tus oraciones las virtudes y los dones que quieras recibir para ver si obtienes una nueva Bienaventuranza, así como un niño de cuarto grado juega con su juego de química para ver qué explota. No hay necesidad de apegarse a un "programa". El Espíritu obra de manera diferente en todos y generalmente no le gustan los programas. Es una bolsa de sorpresas. ¡Deja que la Providencia te hhsorprenda!
