- \diamond 1 bag of dry beans, 1 lbs. or two cans of beans (prefer black, pinto or small red beans)
- ♦ 1 pack of long or short pasta
- ♦ 1 jar of pasta sauce approx. 24 oz. (any flavor is great)
- ♦ 1 box of low sugar cereals (eg. Rice Krispies, Corn Flakes, Cheerios)
- ♦ 1 can of corn approx. 16 oz
- ♦ 1 can of green vegetables approx. 16 oz (eg. green beans, sweet peas)
- ♦ 1 can of fruit in light syrup or in its own juices
- 2 cans of tuna or packs of tuna in water or oil
- ♦ 1 bottle of oil, 48 oz.
- ♦ 1 bag of Tortimasa (no cornmeal)

Bishop Burbidge has granted a dispensation from the Sunday Mass obligation to all Catholics in the Arlington Diocese.
