BAPTISM

CHURCH & PARISH HALL PROFESSIONALLY SANITIZED

For the health and safety of our parishioners, Our Lady of Lourdes has contracted Jani-King to provide professional sanitization of our church, parish hall, and rectory. Their service uses an EPA Registered Chemical that kills 99% of all bacteria and viruses, including COVID-19. In addition to these professional disinfections, our parish staff are regularly cleaning and sanitizing the church. While we still recommend the use of personal protection equipment and vigilant hand washing, we hope that these precautions will help bring our parishioners some peace of mind as we resume our services.

NEW PUBLIC MASS & CONFESSION SCHEDULE!

As Arlington County enters Phase One of Virginia's reopening plan, Our Lady of Lourdes will begin celebrating public Masses and providing the Sacrament of Reconciliation!

Parishioners are asked to take the following precautions in church:

- ◆ Church capacity must remain under 50%, or below 350 people
- ◆ A social distance of 6 feet must be maintained at all times, including while seated in pews and while in line for Communion
- ◆ Receiving Communion via the hands is recommended
- ◆ Confessions must be heard behind the screen
- ◆ Face masks should be worn inside the church

We have revised our schedule to allow for thorough cleaning between all services. Our new schedule is as follows:

We have suspended weekday 6:45 AM Masses, Saturday 9:00 AM Masses, and Sunday 8:00 AM Masses. Private Masses will continue to be celebrated for Mass intentions arranged prior to the COVID-19 pandemic. These private Masses are NOT open to the public.

Bishop Burbidge has granted a dispensation from the Sunday Mass obligation to all Catholics in the Arlington Diocese. This dispensation continues through our reopening and is extended until further notice. Bishop Burbidge respectfully suggests that the following individuals continue to stay home on Sundays:

- ◆ those above the age of 65
- ◆ those with an increased risk due to health conditions
- ◆ anyone experiencing flu-like symptoms or who may have been exposed to COVID-19

While unable to attend Mass, observing the Sabbath with prayer or another devotion, such as a holy hour or rosary, demonstrates good will and sincerity. A sample prayer of Spiritual Communion follows:

My Jesus,

I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.

I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul.

Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.

I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You.

Never permit me to be separated from You.

Amen.
