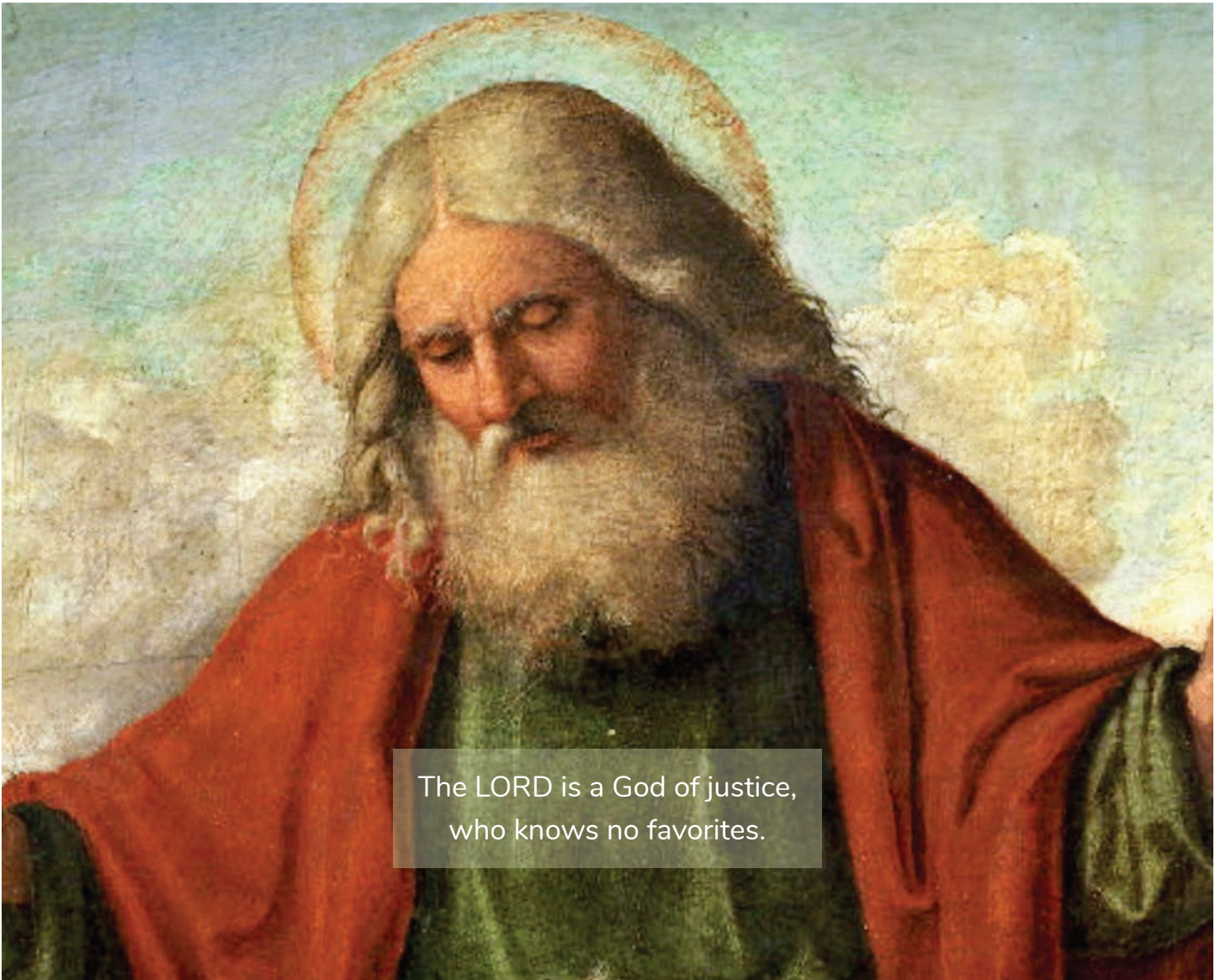

4. If Married, must be sacramentally Married in (or with the permission of) the Catholic church
5. Must lead a life in keeping with the Catholic faith

Saint Padre Pio was an Italian priest who bore the wounds of Christ, which is still something that cannot be explained. Beginning in 1918, at the age of 30, he reported bleeding from his hands, feet and side—the stigmata wounds of Christ's crucifixion. The wounds were said to have lasted 50 years, until his death. Saint James will be hosting the Padre Pio Relics Tour on Sunday-Monday, October 23-24. The public veneration of the relics will be on Sunday, October 23, from 4:00 PM – 7:00 PM, and Monday, October 24, from 10:30 AM – 12:00 PM and from 1:00 PM – 7:00 PM. The noon Mass on Monday will be a Votive Mass. The event will end Monday evening with guest speaker Fr. Jerome Fasano in the church at 7:00 PM. The presentation will be on Padre Pio's life and the influence Padre Pio had on his own life.
